PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Major-General,  
GEORGE DEAN PITT,  
Knight of the Royal Hanoverian  
Guelphic Order, Lieutenant-  
Governor of the Province of  
New Ulster, &c., &c.,

WHEREAS, His Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, K. C. B., Governor-in-Chief in and over the Islands of New Zealand, hath this day quitted the Province of New Ulster.

Now therefore I, GEORGE DEAN PITT, do hereby proclaim and declare that I have assumed the Administration of the Government of the said Province during the absence therefrom of the Governor-in-Chief, and I hereby call upon the inhabitants of the said Province to be aiding and assisting me therein.

Auckland, in the Province aforesaid, this twenty-first day of November, in the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.
