in each week.

The number of Natives employed is fifty. Any additional information which may be required respecting terms of the Contract, &c., together with forms of Tender, may be obtained on application to the Superintendent of Roads, at the Office of the Superintendent neral.

Security will be required for the due performance of the Contract, and the Tenders must be accompanied by a notification of consent of the parties proposed as Sureties.
