RATIONS TO ROAD PARTIES.

Colonial Secretary's Office,
Auckland, October 3, 1849.

TENDERS will be received at this Office at half noon, on Tuesday, the 9th instant, for the supply of Rations on the undermentioned work, for Natives employed on the public Roads, for the period commencing on the 10th instant, and ending 31st March, 1850. The daily Ration for each man to consist of—
1lb Fresh Pork
1lb Flour or Bread, and
16 oz. Rice, or 2lbs. Potatoes.
The Flour or Bread to be of the best quality. The Rations must be delivered by the Contractor at such places as may be indicated by the Superintendent of Roads, before the hour of noon, on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday in each week.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of New Ulster, at Auckland, this fourth day of October, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.
