hereby proclaim and declare that I have as-  
sumed the Administration of the Government of  
the said Province during the absence there-  
from of the Governor-in-Chief, and I hereby  
call upon the inhabitants of the said Province  
to be aiding and assisting me therein.

New Ulster, at Auckland, this 29th  
day of October, in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
fifty.
