By His Excellency Major-General

Rough Dan 1111,

Knight of the Royal Hanoverian
Guelphic Order, LieutenantGovernor of the Province of
New Ulster, &c., &c.

HEREAS His Excellency Sir George Grey, K. C. B., Governor-in-Chief in and over the Islands of New Zealand, hath this day quitted the Province of New Ulster:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE DEAN PITT, do hereby proclaim and declare that I have assumed the Administration of the Government of the said Province during the absence therefrom of the Governor-in-Chief, and I hereby call upon the inhabitants of the said Province to be aiding and assisting me therein.

Given under my Hand and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of New Ulster, at Auckland, this 29th day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
