I, WILLIAM GIBBORNE, a Commissioner, appointed under the Colonial Ordinance No. 2, Session 1, to examine and report on claims to Grants of Land in the Province of New Ulster, within the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby give notice that I shall proceed to investigate the following claims, at the Waikato, on Wednesday, the 19th day of February next, and following days.

All parties interested are hereby summoned to be in attendance, with their witnesses and original deeds and documents and copies thereof (with translations, if in Maori), the latter to remain with the Commissioner.

The fee of five pounds must be paid to the Commissioner before the investigation of any claim, or of any opposition thereto.

CHARLES MARSHALL, of Waikato, claimant.

1. Paparauma—containing about six hundred (600) acres, on the Waikato; bounded north by a kaikatea tree marked C. M., on the west by the Waikato, on the east by Maunga Paru paru.

Consideration—Goods of the value of £75.

Conveyance—a deed, 26th Dec., 1839.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Tetataha and others.

2. Honepoto—containing about two hundred (200) acres, on the Waikato; bounded on the north by that river, and on the south by the old Pah of Putataka, on the east by a

large stone called Potuturangi, and on the west by a ridge.

Consideration—Goods, value £85 10s.

Conveyance—Deed, 1st Jan., 1840.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Tunui and others.

3. Pauhatahanui—containing about fifty (50) acres, on the Waikato, bounded by a ridge running from Tuterangi to the old Putataka Pah, and on the other sides by holes dug in the ground.

Consideration—Goods, value £30.

Conveyance—Deed, 8th January, 1840.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Taraiti and others.

4. Pahaomango—containing about thirty (30) acres, on the Wangapae Lake.

Consideration—Goods, value £15.

Conveyance—Deed, dated 8th January, 1840.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Taraiti and others.

5. Nanawhei—containing about four hundred (400) acres, on the Waikato, at Namawautoutou, thence to Teringanui, and to a bush called Waipapa, and to a bush called Kakariki.

Consideration—Goods, value £35.

Conveyance—Deed, dated 10th January, 1840.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Tarahaia and others.

6. Koeroa—containing about three thousand (3,000) acres on the Waikato, extending from

the Wangamarino creek to the Mangatawhiri creek.

Consideration—Goods, value £232.

Conveyance—Deed, dated 12th January, 1840.

Alleged to have been purchased from Native Chiefs Te Atua and others.

WITH reference to the preceding notice of this date, from this office, publishing the names of Persons to whom Depasturing Licenses have been issued within the several Hundreds of Auckland, Onehunga, Panmure, Otahuhu, Howick, and Pupuke, for the year 1851, I hereby call Meetings to be held in conformity with the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (No. 1, Sess. 10), at the places and times specified below, of such Holders of Depasturing Licenses, for the purpose of electing from among themselves three Wardens, within the said Hundreds respectively, who shall have the regulation and apportionment, for the current year, of the right of Pasturage upon the Waste Crown Lands within the said Hundreds, and also be entrusted with the other powers specified in the said Ordinance.

For the Hundred of Auckland—at the Supreme Court House, on Saturday, the 25th instant, at two o'clock, p.m.

For the Hundred of Onehunga,—at the Village, on Monday, the 27th instant, at two o'clock, p.m.

For the Hundred of Panmure,—opposite St. John's College, on Tuesday, the 28th inst., at two o'clock, p.m.

For the Hundred of Otahuhu,—at the Village on Saturday, the 1st February, at two o'clock, p.m.

For the Hundred of Howick,—at the Village, on Thursday, the 30th instant, at two o'clock, p.m.

For the Hundred of Pupuke,—at Mr. Mellivins, near the Roman Catholic College, on Monday, the 3rd February, at two o'clock, p.m.

None but personal attendants (being License-holders) at these Meetings will be allowed to vote.

Every such voter will be entitled to one vote for each of the three Wardens, and is requested to bring his License with him, for production, if required.
