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## PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, passed in the session holden in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty, No. 22, intituled "The Waste Lands Act, 1856," it is enacted that no land acquired from the aboriginal inhabitants, after the passing thereof, shall be open for sale or disposal until the Governor shall have notified, by Proclamation in the *New Zealand Government Gazette*, that the Native Title has been extinguished over such land.

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, do hereby proclaim and notify that the Native Title has been extinguished over the Block of Land the boundaries whereof are mentioned or described in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

## SCHEDULE.

PROVINCE OF AUCKLAND.  
DISTRICT OF WHANGAROA.

*Wharaurua Block.*

About 8,000 Acres.

The boundaries commence at Pakoka Creek adjoining the land which was given for School purposes some time since, at Maramatae Ahoaho; and on to Manukariki; and on to a Stony Point,—thence turning and crossing to Whainui, and on to Wahakihaki, and crossing to Ngutu Pungarehu and Manga-whereo, Ngapuhi, Kainamunamu, and on to Te Kiri, thence it goes inland to Pakaraka, Te Whataipu thence on through the forest to Te Ohe at the Pakihi Creek, and thence on to the Tuporotangiroa Mountain,—according to compass 50° 0'; thence on by the side of Wahatane to the land sold by Hemi Matini; and on to Te Waiwherowhero at Waitetuna; thence on in the Waitetuna river to Tawatacaka; thence turning, and going on to Whaurimu to the dead rimu (tree); thence along the survey line to Patoa, Pukeruru, Tukuwaru and on to Tutaenui, thence on in the Tutaenui Creek to the boundary of Mr. Ligar's purchase; thence along the inland boundary of Mr. Ligar's purchase to the Awhea; thence descending to the Pakoka river; thence going along the inland boundary of the School land and on to Maramatae Ahoaho—where the boundaries join.

**WHEREAS** by an Act made and enacted in the Imperial Parliament holden in the fifteenth and sixteenth years of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled "An Act to grant a Representative Constitution to the Colony of New Zealand," it is amongst other things enacted that whenever any Bill shall have been assented to by the Superintendent as in the said recited Act provided, the Superintendent shall forthwith transmit to the Governor an authentic copy thereof, and it shall be lawful for the Governor at any time within three months after any such Bill shall have been received by him to declare, by Proclamation, his disallowance of such Bill, and that any such disallowance shall make void and annul the same from and after the day of the date of such Proclamation, or any subsequent day to be named therein.

And whereas the Ordinances hereinafter specified have been enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, and the said Ordinances were received by the Governor on the fourth day of January, 1857.

And whereas it is expedient that the said recited Ordinances should be disallowed,

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the authority vested in me in that behalf by the said recited Act of Parliament, do hereby proclaim and declare my disallowance of the following Ordinances passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Canterbury, viz:—

The "Diversion of Roads Ordinance," Session VIII, No. 14, and

The "Governor's Bay Road Ordinance," Session VIII, No. 15.

#### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's

**WHEREAS** by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand passed in the Session holden in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty, No. 19, intituled "The Counties Act, 1856," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor on the recommendation of the Superintendent of any Province of the said Colony, from time to time by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette* of the Colony to constitute any portion of such Province or County, Hundred or Parish, and that all such Counties, Hundreds, and Parishes shall have such designation and limits as in and by the Proclamation constituting the same shall be prescribed.

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of New Zealand, on the recommendation of the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do proclaim and declare, and I do hereby constitute that portion of the Province of Wellington, bounded as follows, viz:—North, by a line commencing at the north-east corner of Section No. 71, and running to a point 60 chains from the Waipona river at the Pa-kai-ko-kiri-kiri,—and from thence in a straight line till it strikes the Waipona river. East, by the Rua-mahunga river. South, by the Waingarua river. West, by the Tararua Range—to be the Hundred of Masterton.
