# PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commanderin-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

W HEREAS by an Act of the General As-sembly of New Zealand, initialed "The Naturalization Act, 1858," it is enacted that "all and singular the Persons who shall be declared to come within the operation of this Act by any Proclamation to be issued in that behalf by His Excellency the Governor or Offi-cer administering the Government, shall, as from the time to be in the respective cases in that behalf specified by such Proclamation, be deemed and taken, until the termination of the next Session of the General Assembly, to be and to have been, as from such specified time, natural-born Subjects of Her Majesty within the Islands of New Zealand, as fully to all intents and purposes as if their names had respectively been inserted in the Schedule hereunto annexed. Provided always, that every such Proclamation shall contain the description, occupation, or calling of the Person or Persons therein named, and of his or their residence at the date of such Proclamation."

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Person hereinafter mentioned, shall come within the operation of the said Act, from the date hereinafter specified, viz.,

PIERRE DARMANDARITZ,

From the Thirtieth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty, Native of France, Master-Mariner, residence Auckland, in the Province of Auckland.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of the Colony of New Zealand, at Government House, at Auckland, this twenty-second day of June, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine.
