SCHEDULE.

PROVINCE OF AUCKLAND.

District of Mongonui.

Ahipara Block, 9,470 acres.

Boundaries:

The boundary commences on the West Coast at Waimoho, the South boundary of the Government Block, from thence along the line to Te Karamu, from thence to Manga Korohara, from thence to Tangonge, Te Manoao Parapara, Waiomapauroa, Perekekotihī, Takapuahia, following the survey line to the

Sea Coast, following (the coast Reserve excepted) until it joins the point where the boundary commenced.

County of Marsden.

Waikeri-a-wera Block.

Containing 12,758 Acres.

Boundaries:

The boundary commences at Te Arai and follows along the Southern boundary line of Mangawai Block until it meets the Oruawhoro boundary line, thence along the Eastern boundary of Oruawhoro Block to Pukemiro and on to Ngamotu, thence by a line bearing 75° , five thousand four hundred and forty-seven links to Te Whanau Kanariki, thence by a line bearing $30^{\circ} 30'$ forty nine thousand six hundred and seventy-seven links, crossing Wai-te-whanga and Waikowhara on to Opuawhanga hill, thence by a line bearing 45° fourteen thousand four hundred links passing Putakaka crossing a native path at Waikeri-a-wera and on to the Sea Coast, thence along the sea coast to Te Arai, where the boundary closes.

PROVINCE OF HAWKES' BAY.

Okawa Block.

Estimated Area 10,577 Acres.

Boundaries :

Commencing at the lake called Oreore, and following the Eastern branch to the end ; from thence to a point on the shoulder of the hill called Ngamahanga ; which line bears by compass $356^{\circ} 30'$ from thence to a point at the foot of a ridge of hills near the bank of the Tutaekuri river, and thence to the Tutaekuri. The boundary then follows the course of the Tutaekuri upwards, to the mouth of a creek which rises near the head of Mangatarata, and up said creek to a point near its source ; it then strikes across to the Mangatarata, and down that stream to its junction with the Okawa river, and down the Okawa to the Oreore lake.

CEYLON. THE COLOMBO LIGHT will be under repairs from the 1st of February to the 1st of April 1860, during which time there will be a temporary Light upon the Clock Tower, upon which much dependence cannot be placed. Ships approaching Colombo by night should therefore be very cautious, and keep their Deep Sea lead going. It is worthy of remark, that if soundings off Ceylon be got between Thirty and Forty fathoms, the Ship is within Five or Six leagues of the land, and had better not near till daylight.
