PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council, dated the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, on the twenty-seventh day of the same month, the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers in that behalf vested in him under and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly entitled the "New Provinces Act, 1858," did establish, on and after the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty one, a New Province to be called and known by the name of Southland: And whereas by the said Act it is amongst other things enacted that the Provincial Council of any Province established under the said Act shall in the first instance consist of such number of Members, not less than nine, as the Governor shall by Proclamation direct and appoint; And it is further enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor by Proclamation to constitute within any Province established under the said Act, convenient Electoral Districts for the election of Members of the Provincial Council, and to appoint and declare the number of Members to be elected for each such District, and to make provision for the formation of the first Electoral Rolls for the election of such Members:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in pursuance and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, do hereby proclaim, declare, direct, appoint, and provide as follows:—

1. The Provincial Council of the said Province of Southland shall consist of Eleven Members.

2. The said Province for the election of the Members of the Provincial Council thereof, shall be divided into six Electoral Districts as follows—that is to say, Mataura, Campbelltown, Waihopai, Invercargill, Riverton, and New River: the boundaries whereof respectively are described and set forth in the Schedule to this Proclamation, and are delineated on the Map or Plan hereunto annexed.

3. The number of Members to be elected to serve in the Provincial Council for the said several Districts shall be as follows, viz:—for Mataura, One Member; Campbelltown, One Member; Waihopai, Three Members; Invercargill, Three Members; Riverton, One Member; and New River, Two Members.

4. Francis Dart Fenton, Esquire, shall, within twenty-one days from the date hereof, form the first Electoral Rolls for the election of such Members, by placing the name of every person who is at this present time registered as an elector, entitled to vote in the election of Members of the House of Representatives on account of any tenements or hereditaments comprised within the limits of the said Province, on the Electoral Roll of that one of the said Districts within which such tenements and hereditaments are situate. And within twenty-eight days from the date hereof, the Electoral Rolls so to be formed as aforesaid

shall be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, and from and after the day of such publication the said several Rolls shall be the Electoral Rolls to be used respectively for the said Districts for the election of Members of the said Provincial Council, until new Electoral Rolls shall be made for the same under the provisions of the law for the time being in force for the Registration of Electors.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Colony of New Zealand, at Government House, at Auckland, the fifth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-one.

SCHEDULE ABOVE REFERRED TO.

MATAURA DISTRICT

Comprises that portion of the Province situate to the North and East of a line commencing on the Sea Coast at the South Eastern boundary of the Campbelltown Hundred, thence proceeding along the Eastern boundary line of that Hundred to its termination, and thence produced till it strikes the Northern boundary line of the Land Sales and Leases Ordinance Block; thence running Westerly along the last named boundary line to its termination, and thence produced till it strikes the Waiau River.

CAMPBELLTOWN DISTRICT

Comprises that portion of the Province now included within the limits of the Campbelltown Hundred.

WAIHOPAI DISTRICT

Comprises that portion of the Province bounded on the North by a line running East from the mouth of the Waimatuku Creek to the junction of the Oreti and Makarewa Rivers, thence by the Makarewa and Hedgehope Rivers to the boundary of the Mataura district; on the East by the Mataura district; on the West by the Sea; and on the South by the New River Estuary and the Campbelltown district:—Excepting the Town of Invercargill.

INVERCARGILL DISTRICT

Comprises the Town of Invercargill as included within the limits of the Town Reserve of that name.

RIVERTON DISTRICT

Comprises the Town of Riverton as included within the limits of the Town Reserve of that name.

NEW RIVER DISTRICT

Comprises that portion of the Province bounded towards the North and East by the Mataura District; towards the South East

and South by the Waihopai District and the Sea; and towards the West by the Waiau River and the Sea:—Excepting the Town of Riverton.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Regulation of Elections Act, 1858," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor by Warrant under his hand, from time to time, to appoint Polling Places for each Electoral District within or without the limits thereof, and to appoint any one of such places to be the Principal Polling Place for the District, and all or any of such Polling Places at any time to abolish, and to appoint other Polling Places in lieu thereof. And whereas by another Act of the General Assembly, intituled, "The Provincial Elections Act, 1858," it is enacted that, subject to certain provisions therein contained, every Election of a Member of the Provincial Council of a Province shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by "The Regulation of Elections Act, 1858," aforesaid, and all the provisions of the said last mentioned Act shall apply to the Elections of Members of Provincial Council;

Now know Ye, that I, Thomas Gore Browne, the Governor of the Colony, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said Acts, do hereby appoint the following places to be Polling Places for the respective Districts hereinafter specified in the Province of Southland, for the Election of Members of the Provincial Council of the said Province, namely,—

1. *Mataura*,—The home station of Mr. R. Stuart, Run No. 91.—The house of Mr. Gunn, Run 119.—The home station of Mr. Freeman Jackson, Run 143.
2. *Campbelltown*,—The Custom House, Campbelltown.
3. *Waihopai*,—The house of Mr. Coup-land, Puni Bush, Invercargill Hundreds.
4. *Invercargill*,—The School House, Invercargill.
5. *Riverton*,—The store of Messrs. Surman & Crerar, Riverton.
6. *New River*,—The house of Mr. R. Grieve, Brampholme Bush, New River Hundred.—The house of Mr. Young, Gummy's Bush, Jacob's River Hundred.

And I do further appoint the Polling Places severally hereinafter specified to be the principal Places for their respective Districts, namely,—

- Mataura*,—The home station of Mr. R. Stuart, Run No. 91.

New River.—The house of Mr. Grieve, Brampholme Bush.
