A PROCLAMATION

For the Naturalization of CHARLES LEWIS,
and ANTON SEUFERT.

By His Excellency COLONEL THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by "The Naturalization Act, 1860," it is enacted that every person who shall be declared to come within the operation of that Act by any Proclamation to be issued in that behalf by His Excellency the Governor, shall as from the time in such Proclamation specified, be deemed and taken until the termination of the next Session of the General Assembly, to be, and to have been from such specified time, a Natural-born subject of Her Majesty within the Colony of New Zealand, as fully to all intents and purposes as if his name had been inserted in the Schedule to that Act annexed. Provided always that every such Proclamation shall contain the description, occupation or calling, of every person therein named, and his place of residence at the date of such Proclamation.

Now therefore I, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the persons hereinafter mentioned shall come within the operation of the said Act from the dates herein-after specified, viz. :—

CHARLES LEWIS,

—From the First day of September, One Thousand eight-hundred and fifty-nine, native of Prussia, Storekeeper,—residence Waipu, in the Province of Auckland.

ANTON SEUFERT,

—From the First day of January, One Thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, native of Bohemia, Cabinet Maker,—residence Auckland, in the Province of Auckland.

Given under my hand at the Government House at Auckland, and issued under the Seal of the Colony of New Zealand, this 23rd day of January, in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight-hundred and sixty-one.
