A PROCLAMATION

Summoning the General Assembly for despatch of business.

(L.S.)

By His Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of New Zealand now stands prorogued to the Twenty-seventh day of August instant; And it is expedient further to prorogue the same:

Now, therefore I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the authority in me vestel in that behalf, do hereby further prorogue the said General Assembly to MONDAY, the Nineteenth day of October next; And I do hereby further announce and proclaim that the said General Assembly shall assemble for the despatch of business on the Nineteenth day of October, at Two o'clock, p.m., at Auckland, and the Honourable Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the House of Representatives respectively are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.
