Postage on Correspondence on Public Service.

General Post Office, Wellington, 49th January, 1865.

In consequence of the abolition of the system of franking correspondence on the public service to go free by post, Notice is hereby given that from and after the 1st proximo, Postmasters will be authorized to receive such correspondence without prepayment, and prefer quarterly accounts for the postage against the Department posting the same. It will be requisite that all letters, &c., should bear the designation of the Department transmitting them.
