WHEREAS I have thought fit to dissolve the General Assembly of New Zealand, which stands prorogued to the twentieth day of February proximo : Now KNOW YE, that I do for that end publish this Proclamation, and do hereby dissolve the said General Assembly accordingly ; and the Legislative Councillors, and the Members elected to serve in the House of Representatives, are discharged from their meeting and attendance on the said twentieth day of February proximo.
