WHEREAS by "The Intestate Estates Act, 1865," it is enacted that the said Act shall come into force in each Province of the Colony respectively, on such day as the Governor may fix by Proclamation in the New Zealand Gazette: Now therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor as aforesaid, in pursuance and exercise of the said power and authority in me vested, do hereby appoint and fix the first day of June next to be the day on and from which the said "Intestate Estates Act, 1865," shall come into force within the following Province, viz.:—

The Province of Hawke's Bay, in the said Colony.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Grey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at Wellington, this fourteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

Approved in Council this twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

Present:

THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Militia Act, 1858," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time to constitute throughout the Colony, or in any part thereof, Militia Districts, and such districts from time to abolish, and the boundaries thereof to vary:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the above recited power, doth by this present Order constitute a Militia District in the Province of Auckland, to be called by the name following, namely—

THE MIDDLE WAIKATO DISTRICT, and doth define the said district to be all the territory comprised within the circumference of a circle having a radius of fifteen miles from a point on the Opuatia River one mile from its junction with the River Waikato.

WHEREAS by "The Auckland Militia Acts Amendment Act, 1862," the Governor is empowered to call out the whole or any part or number of any Regiment, Battalion, Corps, or Company of Militia, in any district, as he shall think fit; and it appears to me expedient to call out for training and exercise part of the Militia of the Province of Auckland hereinafter specified:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance of the said recited power, do hereby call out for training and exercise such portions of the 3rd and 4th Regiments of Auckland Militia, in the Middle Waikato District, as by Proclamation dated fifth day December, 1865, have been dismissed from actual service; and I order Lieutenant-Colonel William Moule, the officer commanding the said district, to carry into effect this direction.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Grey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and dated at Wellington, this twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

WHEREAS it is provided by "The Militia Acts Amendment Act, 1862," that the number of days and hours for the meeting of the Militia for any district for training and exercise shall be from time to time fixed by the Governnor; And whereas it is deemed expedient to call out for training and exercise certain portions of the Auckland Militia in the Middle Waikato District:

other Acts, or Government Gazette notices to be in brevier.

The Index of Titles to be in small pica; Titles of repealed or obsolète Acts to be in italics; references to amending or repealing Acts following the title to be in brevier

The Alphabetical Index of reprinted Acts to be in

small pica.

The tenders to state the rate per hour for alterations and corrections; also for press work, the rate per token per half sheet.

It is supposed the work will extend to about five

hundred pages.
Revised proofs to be delivered at the rate of two sheets per week to the person at Wellington whom the Government shall appoint to approve of the same, and copies are not to be struck off till he shall have signed the proof in token of its accuracy.

The price stated is to include the cost of drying

and cold pressing.

No contract will be entered into till the work shall have been sanctioned by the General Assembly.

Security will be required to be given to the extent of five hundred pounds sterling, with two sureties to be approved by the Government. Each tender shall state the names of two persons willing to become
