## G. GREY, Governor. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by "The District Courts Act, 1858," V it is enacted that there shall be within the Colony of New Zealand, Courts of Record, possessing Civil and Criminal Jurisdiction, to be called District Courts, and the Governor is empowered from time to Courts, and the Governor is empowered from time to time, as he shall think fit, by proclamation in the New Zealand Gazette, to constitute throughout the Colony, or in any part thereof, districts within which such Courts shall be respectively held and such districts to abolish, and the boundaries thereof to define or alter, and also to declare by what local news such Courts shall be designated.

name such Courts shall be designated:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of the said Colony, in pursuance and exercise of the aforesaid power and authority do hereby constitute and proclaim the district of the said Colony hereinafter described or referred to, to be a district within which a District Court shall be held under the said Act and under "The District Courts Amendment Act, 1865:

And in further pursuance and exercise of the authority aforesaid, I do hereby declare that the said Court shall be designated by the name hereunder specified, that is to say

Designation of Court:
"The District Court of Hawke's Bay."

Description of District:
"The Hawke's Bay District;" which shall comprise the whole of the Province of Hawke's Bay

day respectively.
