PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a writ directed to the Returning Officer for the election of a Member of the House of Representatives for the Electoral District of Westland South, the time limited for the return of such writ was the fifteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight. And whereas the sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, was duly appointed and notified as the day on which a poll would be taken, but unforeseen difficulties and delays have arisen in taking the said poll at Okarita, one of the duly appointed polling places within and for the said electoral district. And whereas by the thirty-second section of an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Regulation of Elections Act, 1858," after reciting that unforeseen difficulties and delays may arise in carrying into effect the several provisions in the said Act contained, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to extend the time allowed for the holding of any election or for the return of the writ issued for the same, notwithstanding the day may have passed on which such writ shall be returnable, and to adopt or cause to be adopted such measures as may be necessary to remove any obstacle of a technical or formal nature by which the due course of any such election may be impeded, and to supply any deficiency that may otherwise affect the same:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, doth hereby extend the time allowed for holding the election of a Member of the House of Representatives for the Electoral District of Westland South until the twenty-eighth day of May next; and with the like advice and consent, doth hereby extend the time allowed for the return of the writ issued for such election until the twenty-eighth day of May next; and with the like advice and consent doth order and direct that a poll shall be taken at the duly appointed polling place at Okarita, in the manner and form provided by the said Act, on such day as shall be appointed by the Returning Officer of the said district, and which day he shall give notice of not less than five days nor more than fifty days; and with the like advice and consent, doth order and direct that all proceedings subsequent to the taking of the said poll, shall be taken in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, in like

manner as if the said writ had been originally made returnable on the twenty-eighth day of May next.

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, doth hereby extend the time allowed for the return of the writ issued for the election of a Member of the House of Representatives

for the said district, until the twenty-eighth day of May next; and with the like advice and consent, doth order and direct that all proceedings subsequent to the taking of the poll at such election, and not taken before the return day of the said writ, shall be taken in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, in like manner as if the said writ had been originally made returnable on the twenty-eighth day of May next.

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The County of Westland Act, 1867," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, from time to time, as he may think fit, by proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, to make regulations for the sale, letting, disposal, occupation, and management of any waste lands of the Crown within the County of Westland, and to sell, let, and dispose thereof at such prices, and in such allotments, and generally in such manner as he shall deem expedient, and in like manner to alter, vary, or annul any such regulations, and to make others.

And whereas by a proclamation issued on the twentieth day of March last by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the twenty-first day of March last, certain regulations were made for the sale, letting, disposal, occupation, and management of the waste lands of the Crown in the County of Westland.

And whereas by a certain other Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," it is enacted that any district proclaimed or to be proclaimed a gold field, shall not be subject to any provisions of any law for the time being in force regulating the sale, disposal, and occupation of Crown Lands within the Province in which such gold field is situate, except (amongst other exceptions) so far as the provisions of such law may specially authorize the sale or leasing of land within a gold field.

And whereas it is expedient that provision should be made, specially authorizing the sale and lease of the waste lands of the Crown within any gold field proclaimed or to be proclaimed within the County of Westland:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred on me by the hereinbefore first recited Act, do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, make and proclaim the regulations contained in the Schedule hereto, to be read with and as forming part of the said regulations made on the twentieth day of March last, for the sale, letting,

disposal, occupation, and management of the waste lands of the Crown in the County of Westland.

SCHEDULE.

Lands within Gold Fields.

1. The term "the regulation" shall be construed to mean the regulation for the time being in force for the sale, letting, disposal, occupation, and management of the waste lands of the Crown in the County of Westland.

2. Lands situate within any gold field, now or hereafter proclaimed, shall be sold, leased or otherwise dealt with under these regulations, in the same manner, by the same persons, and subject to the same conditions as if such land were not situate within a gold field, and the regulations shall be deemed to specially authorize such sale, lease, or other disposal.

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the third section of an Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time by proclamation to constitute and appoint any portion of the Colony to be a gold field under the provisions of the said Act, and the limits of such gold field from time to time to alter as occasion may require, and also, if he shall see fit, to revoke the proclamation by which such gold field shall be constituted. And whereas by the one hundred and ninth section of the said Act it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, under his hand and the public seal of the Colony, from time to time to delegate to such person as the Governor may deem fit all or any of the powers vested in the Governor or the Governor in Council by the said Act, except the powers conferred by sections twenty-two, forty, forty-eight, sixty, ninety-six, and one hundred and seven thereof, subject or not to any limitations or restrictions as he may think fit. And whereas by an instrument in writing, dated the twentieth day of January last and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the same day, His Excellency the Governor did, under his hand and the public seal of the Colony, delegate to me, John Hall, one of Her Majesty's Executive Council in New Zealand, all the powers vested in the Governor under or by virtue of "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," except the powers conferred by sections twenty-two, forty, forty-eight, sixty, ninety-six, and one hundred and seven, to have, hold, and exercise within the County of Westland the said powers thereby given to me, the said John Hall, so long as I shall continue and remain a Member of the said Executive Council. And whereas it is expedient that all that portion of the Colony of New Zealand which is contained within the County of Westland, the limits whereof are defined in the Schedule to an Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The County of Westland Act, 1867," should be constituted one gold field under the name of "The Westland Gold Field:"

Now therefore I, John Hall, one of Her Majesty's Executive Council in New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of all powers and authorities vested in and delegated to me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim, constitute, and appoint all that portion of New Zealand which is contained within the said County of Westland to be a gold field under "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," to be called and known as

"The WESTLAND GOLD FIELD:"

And, in further exercise and pursuance of such powers aforesaid, I do revoke all proclamations heretofore made whereby such portion of New Zealand aforesaid or any part thereof may have been constituted a gold field.
