WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The New Zealand Settlements Acts Amendment Act, 1866," power is given to the Governor to reserve portions of any of the land taken under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," for the several purposes for which reserves may be made under the twelfth section of "The Waste Lands Act, 1858," and may make grants thereof under "The Public Reserves Act, 1854," or otherwise, as the case may require. And whereas the purposes for which such reserves may be made under the said twelfth section of the said Waste Lands Act, 1858, are for the construction of trunk lines of road, or as sites for public buildings for the use of the General Government, or for other purposes of public utility or convenience. And whereas the several pieces of land described or mentioned in the second, third, and fourth columns of the Schedule hereto have been respectively taken under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," and it is expedient that they should be reserved for the purposes respectively set opposite thereto in the first column of the said Schedule :

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers so vested in me, do hereby except from sale and reserve to Her Majesty, her heirs and successors, for the several purposes mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, the several allotments or parcels of land situated in the Waikato District, in the Province of Auckland, and respectively mentioned or referred to in the said Schedule, and which several allotments are respectively numbered in the said Schedule, and the boundaries thereof set out in the official maps or plans in the Survey Office for the Province of Auckland, showing the sections or allotments of the several townships or parishes in the Waikato District aforesaid.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twelfth day of August, 1868.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The County of Westland Act, 1867," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to constitute and define Road Districts in the County of Westland, and such districts from time to time to alter or abolish, and to provide for the constitution of boards for the management of the business of such districts, and from time to time to make regulations for the election of such boards, and for defining the number of members thereof, and such regulations from time to time to alter and repeal. And whereas by an Order in Council, bearing date the eighth day of January, 1868, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by the said Act did, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony, constitute and define the districts therein mentioned (including amongst other districts the Grey Road District), and did provide for the constitution of boards for the management of the business of such districts, and did make regulations for the election of members thereof, and for defining the number of members thereof, as in the said Order in Council mentioned. And whereas it is expedient to alter the boundaries of the Grey Road District, as defined in the said Order in Council, in manner hereafter appearing:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the power vested in him as aforesaid, doth hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony, alter the boundaries of the Grey Road District, so that the boundaries thereof shall be the boundaries defined in the Schedule hereto. And His Excellency the Governor, in further exercise of the power aforesaid, and with the like advice and consent as aforesaid, doth hereby further order and declare that the board of members elected for the Grey Road District as heretofore constituted, shall remain and be the board of members for the Grey Road District as altered and defined by this present Order in Council. That WILLIAM HORTON REVELL, Esq., the person named as Returning Officer for the Grey Road District in the said Order in Council of the eighth day of January, 1868, shall remain and be the Returning Officer for the election

of members for the Grey Road District, as the same is altered and defined by the present Order in Council; and that the provisions for the constitution of boards, the regulations for election of members, and all other the provisions and regulations of the said Order in Council of the eighth day of January, 1868, not inconsistent herewith, shall be applicable to the Grey Road District, as defined in the Schedule hereto, in the same manner as if that district had been so defined and constituted in the said Order in Council of the eighth day of January, 1868.

## SCHEDULE.

*The Grey Road District.*

Commencing at a point on the sea coast one hundred and sixty chains and eighty links to the southward of the South Spit at the mouth of the River Grey; thence Easterly along the southern boundary of the town of Greymouth one hundred and fifteen chains and fifty links; thence Northerly along the eastern boundary of the town of Greymouth to the River Grey; thence Easterly along that river to the junction with it of the Arnold River; thence along the Arnold River to Lake Brunner and along the boundary of the Province of Nelson to the source of the Teremakau; thence following down the northern bank of the Teremakau to the coast, and along the coast to the commencing point.
