"Wallabi" on the 25th day of February last, which Report declares that the engineer was in fault, and recommends that his certificate be forfeited; and by virtue of the powers delegated to me by the Postmaster-General of New Zealand, I hereby suspend the engineer's certificate, No. 144 of New Zealand, in favour of Alexander Milne, for a period of three months from the first day of June next.
