G. F. Bowen, Governor. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by "The Militia Act, 1858," it is enacted that on the occasions therein mentioned it shall be lawful for the Governor, or such person as he shall from time to time by warrant under his hand appoint as his deputy for that pur-pose, to direct the Officer Commanding the Militia of any district, with all convenient speed, to draw out such Militia Force, and that such Militia shall continue on actual service so long as, in the opinion of the Governor, the danger shall render their services necessary:

And whereas, by a warrant under my hand bearing date the third day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, I directed the Officer Com-manding the Napier Militia District to draw out, for actual service, the men of the Militia Force in the said district :

Now therefore I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony, do hereby proclaim and declare that the said Force shall henceforth cease to be on actual service.
