WHEREAS by "The Militia Act, 1858," it is enacted that on the occasions therein mentioned it shall be lawful for the Governor, or such person as he shall from time to time, by warrant under his hand, appoint as his deputy for that purpose, to direct the Officer Commanding the Militia of any District, with all convenient speed, to draw out such Militia Force, and that such Militia shall continue on actual service so long as, in the opinion of the Governor, the danger shall render their services necessary:

And whereas, by a warrant under my hand bearing date the sixth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, I directed the Officer Commanding the Wellington Militia District to draw out, for actual service, the men of the Militia Force in the said district:

Now therefore I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony, do hereby proclaim and declare that the said Force shall henceforth cease to be on actual service.

Province of Wellington, District of Manawatu.

Rangitikei-Manawatu Block; estimated to contain 220,000 Acres.

BOUNDARIES.

Bounded on the North by the Rangitikei River, from its mouth to the Waitapu Creek; thence on the East by a direct line from the mouth of the Waitapu Creek to Te Umutoi, the north-western point of the Ohuaturanga, Upper Manawatu Block; thence on the East and South-east by the Oroua River to its junction with the Manawatu River; thence by the Manawatu River to Pakengahau; and thence by the northern boundary of the Auahou Block to Kai-Iwi; and thence by the Sea Coast to the mouth of the Rangitikei River, the commencing point.
