In pursuance and exercise of the power and authority in me vested in this benalf by "The Resident Magistrates Act, 1867," I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that, from and after the first day of September next, the invidicition of the Resident Magistrates' Counts for jurisdiction of the Resident Magistrates' Courts for

PAPAKURA DISTRICT, and WAIUKU DISTRICT,

respectively, as the same are defined by Proclamation bearing date the twenty-ninth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, shall be extended to Fifty Pounds.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, at the Government House, at Wellington; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, this sixth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one.
