A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by "The District Courts Act, 1858," it is enacted that there shall be within the Colony of New Zealand Courts of Record possessing civil and criminal jurisdiction, to be called District Courts, and the Governor is empowered from time to time, as he shall think fit, by Proclamation in the *New Zealand Gazette*, to constitute throughout the Colony, or in any part thereof, districts within which such Courts shall be respectively held, and such districts to abolish, and the boundaries thereof to define or alter, and also to declare by what local name such Courts shall be designated:

And whereas by Proclamation dated the fourteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the sixteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the said Colony, did, in pursuance and exercise of the aforesaid power and authority, constitute and proclaim the district of the Colony therein described to be a district within which a District Court designated "The District Court of Timaru," should be held under the said Act, and under "The District Courts Act Amendment Act, 1865:"

And whereas it is expedient that the boundaries of the said district should be altered:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor as aforesaid, in pursuance and exercise of the aforesaid power and authority, do hereby proclaim and declare that, from and after the date hereof, the boundaries of the said district shall be altered, and that thenceforth the boundaries thereof shall be as hereinafter described, and that the designation of the said Court shall be

THE DISTRICT COURT OF TIMARU AND OAMARU.

Description of District.

The Timaru and Oamaru District comprises all that area bounded towards the North-east by the southern bank of the Ashburton River from its mouth to the source of its main branch, and by a right line north-west true bearing to the summit of the main range of the Southern Alps; thence towards the North-west by the said main range of the

Southern Alps to Mount Aspiring; thence towards the South by the northern boundary of the Province of Otago to a point due north of Mount St. Bathans; thence towards the West by the boundary of the Otago Gold Field to Little Domett Peak; thence by a line over Kyeburn Hill to and along the Kakanui Mountains and the Horse Ranges to the Ocean; thence towards the East and South-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Ashburton River.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at Wellington, this twenty-third day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by "The District Courts Act, 1858," it is enacted that there shall be within the Colony of New Zealand Courts of Record, possessing civil and criminal jurisdiction, to be called District Courts, and the Governor is empowered from time to time, as he shall think fit, by Proclamation in the *New Zealand Gazette*, to constitute throughout the Colony, or in any part thereof, districts within which such Courts shall be respectively held, and such districts to abolish, and the boundaries thereof to define or alter, and also to declare by what local name such Courts shall be designated:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the said Colony, in pursuance and exercise of the aforesaid power and authority, do hereby constitute and proclaim the districts of the said Colony hereinafter described or referred to, to be districts within which District Courts shall be severally held under the said Act, and under "The District Courts Act Amendment Act, 1865:"

And in further pursuance and exercise of the authority aforesaid, I do hereby declare that the said Courts shall be severally designated by the names which are hereunder specified and set above the description of each such district respectively, that is to say,—

Designation of Court.

THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN OTAGO.

Description of District.

The Western Otago District shall comprise all that area bounded towards the North by Milford Sound and the Cleddan River to its source; thence by a direct line to Mount Christina; thence by a line due east to the Otago Gold Field; thence towards the East by the Otago Gold Field and the Mataura River to the Tuturau Hundred; thence by the northern and eastern boundaries of the said hundred, and the meridian of 169° East longitude to the ocean; thence towards the South and West by the ocean to Milford Sound.

Designation of Court.

THE DISTRICT COURT OF TOKOMAIRO AND CLUTHA.

Description of District.

The Tokomairo and Clutha District shall comprise all that area bounded towards the North by the southern bank of the Taieri River, and branch to the Waipori Lake; thence by the Waipori Lake, the Meggat Burn, and the southern boundary of the Otago Gold Field, to the Mataura River; thence towards the West by the Mataura River to the Tuturau Hundred; thence by the boundary of the said Tuturau Hundred, and the meridian of 169° East longitude, to the ocean; and thence towards the South and East by the ocean to the mouth of the Taieri River.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at Wellington, this twenty-third day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.

as defined in and by certain Proclamations, dated the twenty-third day of January instant, to be districts within which the powers conferred by the twenty-fifth, twenty-sixth, and twenty-seventh sections of "The District Courts Act, 1858," may be exercised.

THE DISTRICT COURT OF TOKOMAIRIRO AND CLUTHA,

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-fourth day of January, 1872.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Public Stores Act, 1871," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time to make Regulations, not inconsistent with the said Act, for the guidance of the Inspector of Stores, Storekeepers, and Sub-Storekeepers, and for the receipt, issue, and inspection of stores, and for the rendering of accounts relating thereto, and for the audit of all such accounts:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, in pursuance and in exercise of the power and authority vested in him by the said Act, doth hereby make the Regulations contained in the Schedule hereto for the guidance of the Inspector of Stores, Storekeepers, and Sub-Storekeepers, and for other the purposes hereinbefore specified.

SCHEDULE.
REGULATIONS.

I.—As to the Receipt, Custody, and Issue of Public Stores.

1. In compliance with the provisions of "The Public Stores Act, 1871," (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act,") Storekeepers or Sub-Storekeepers will be appointed for Departments of the Government, in which stores are kept for the Public Service.

2. Every person in the Public Service in whose custody any public stores shall be placed, is constituted a Sub-Storekeeper by and within the meaning of the said Act, and becomes thereby charged with all the duties, and subject to all the liabilities, imposed upon Storekeepers by the said Act.

3. Whenever stores are purchased for the Public Service, they must be entered on expense vouchers for payment distinct from any other service; and the officer certifying to the account must specify on the face of the voucher on what store account or return the articles will be found credited.

4. Public stores are on no account to be either lent or taken into private use by Storekeepers, Sub-Storekeepers, or any person in whose charge they may be placed.

5. Public stores obtained for the use of Government must, where practicable, be marked N. A. Z., and when condemned, if sold, the letter S, where possible, must be marked below the Government brand before sale.

II.—As to the Accounts to be kept by Storekeepers and Sub-Storekeepers.

6. As the form of the account to be kept, and the periods for which returns are to be rendered, must differ with the nature of the stores in each Department, such form and period, together with any instructions which may be necessary relating thereto will be furnished to the Storekeepers and Sub-Storekeepers by the Inspector of Stores.

7. Storekeepers and Sub-Storekeepers must as soon as possible, and not later than thirty days after

the date fixed by the Inspector of Stores for rendering of returns under the last preceding clause of these Regulations, send in their accounts to the Inspector of Stores accompanied by vouchers to support the same.

8. Storekeepers and Sub-Storekeepers, when rendering accounts in accordance with clause 7 of these Regulations, must be careful to include all articles issued on payment, or surcharged, during the quarter in a "Return of Moneys recovered by Storekeeper," or "Return of Moneys recoverable through a Paymaster," for the period in which the transactions occur.

III.—As to the Inspection of Public Stores.

9. In accordance with the provisions of the said Act, it is the duty of the Inspector of Stores to inspect or cause to be inspected by Inspecting Officers, all Public Stores at least once during the year.

10. Inspecting Officers, when directed to inspect any Public Stores, shall render returns and reports to the Inspector of Stores in such form as he may from time to time direct; and where Inspecting Officers find any stores to be missing, they must enter the same in their Inspection Return, under the heading of Deficiencies, reporting as to the cause of such deficiency, and direct the Storekeeper or Sub-Storekeeper to write the articles off their Store Account or Return, and bring them on strength of a "Missing Stores Account," or Return. Copies of these accounts or returns must be sent by all Storekeepers or Sub-Storekeepers to the Inspector of Stores, at the same time as other returns furnished under these Regulations, and continue to be rendered in that manner until the decision of the Minister of the Department to which the stores belong is made known to them by the Inspector of Stores.

11. If the Inspecting Officer finds any stores to be "unserviceable," he must enter them under that heading in his Inspection Return, reporting if they became so by the wilful fault or neglect of the Storekeeper or Sub-Storekeeper in whose custody they are, or of any other person; in latter case specifying the name of the person in whose possession or custody they were, and the manner in which they have become unserviceable, as nearly as he may be able to ascertain the facts.

IV.—As to the Audit of Public Store Accounts.

12. If the Inspector of Stores shall find the accounts of any Storekeeper or Sub-Storekeeper are not supported by vouchers, or that any issue or expenditure of stores has been made without due authority, he will take the steps provided by the sixteenth and seventeenth clauses of the said Act to recover the value of all missing or unlawfully issued stores.

All forms of returns or accounts required under or necessary to give effect to the provisions of the said Act or to these Regulations, will be furnished to Inspecting Officers, Storekeepers, or Sub-Storekeepers, by the Inspector of Stores, as occasion shall require.

WHEREAS by "The Immigration and Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1871," it is, among other things, enacted that the Court Fees to be paid in respect of the inquiries therein mentioned (and the purposes of which inquiries are set forth in Part VI. of the said Act), shall be fixed by the Governor by regulations to be by him from time to time made: And whereas it is expedient to fix a scale of Court Fees to be paid in respect of the inquiries in the said Act mentioned:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act for that purpose, and subject to the provisions thereof, do, by the Regulations set forth in the Schedule hereto, fix the Court Fees to be paid in respect of the inquiries in the said Act mentioned.

SCHEDULE.

1. Upon proceedings taken under Part VI. of "The Immigration and Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1871," where the amount claimed by the owner does not exceed £100, and a sum less than that claimed is offered by the Minister, or where a sum less than £100 shall be offered by the Minister and refused by the owner, then the Court fees to be paid, whether in a District Court or in a Resident Magistrate's Court, shall be those set forth in the second column of this Schedule.

2. In cases in like circumstances to those set forth in the preceding regulation, but where the amount offered or refused, as the case may be, exceeds £100, then the Court fees to be paid in the said Courts shall be those set forth in the third column of the said Schedule.

3. In enforcing payment of costs under section 37 of the said Act, the like Court fees shall be charged on process thereon as in civil proceedings in a District Court or a Resident Magistrate's Court, as the case may be, and in accordance with the scale

for the time being in force in those Courts in like cases.

4. In the construction of these Regulations the word "owner" shall mean the person claiming or to whom compensation shall be offered, whatever may be his estate or interest; and the word "Minister" shall mean the Minister for Public Works for the time being, or any person acting for him under the said Act.

AUCKLAND HARBOUR.

Light on Bean Rocks, and Beacon on Bastion Reefs.

NOTICE is hereby given, that since the 1st December last, a fixed Red, White, and Green Light, of the 5th Order Dioptric, has been exhibited between sunset and sunrise from a Lighthouse erected on the Bean Rocks.

The Lighthouse is an open-framed structure, surmounted by keeper's dwelling and lantern, painted White, and elevated 50 feet above high water level. The Light will be seen in clear weather a distance of ten nautical miles, allowing ten feet for the height of the observer's eye, and will show Red, White, and Green, respectively, between the following bearings, all of which are given *towards* the light, viz. :—

Red—Between the bearings of $W. \frac{1}{2} S.$, and $S. W.$ by $W. \frac{1}{4} W.$; that is, red in the Tehmaki Strait, and on the south side of Koreho Channel, covering the reef north of Koreho Island.

White.—Between the bearings of $S. W.$ by $W. \frac{1}{4} W.$, and $S. W. \frac{1}{4} W.$; *i.e.*, white in the fairway of Koreho Channel and the south-eastern side of the Hieh Channel.

Green.—Between the bearings of $S. W. \frac{1}{4} W.$, and $S. S. E. \frac{1}{2} E.$; *i.e.*, green on the north-western side of the Koreho and Hieh Channels, and on the eastern side of Rangitoto Channel, covering Rangitoto Reef.

White.—Between the bearings of $S. S. E. \frac{1}{2} E.$, and $S. E. \frac{3}{4} S.$; *i.e.*, white in the fairway of Rangitoto Channel.

Red.—Between the bearings of $S. E. \frac{3}{4} S.$, and $E.$ by $N. \frac{1}{4} N.$; *i.e.*, red on the western shore of Rangitoto Channel covering the Rough Rock, and on the northern shore of the Harbour covering the Sandspit Buoy and Dépôt Point.

White.—Between the bearings of $E.$ by $N. \frac{1}{4} N.$, and $N. E. \frac{1}{2} E.$; *i.e.*, white in the fairway of the Harbour, and over its southern shore above Oraki or Hobson's Bay.

There will be no light visible south of the Lighthouse, between the bearings of N.E. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. and W. $\frac{1}{2}$ S.; *i.e.*, southward of a line drawn from Resolution Point to the Lighthouse, and thence to East Tehmaki Head.

Vessels entering Auckland Harbour by the North or Rangitoto Channel should make the white or fairway light, steering in on this line of light until the summit of the North Head bears S.W., then keep away south across the red into the white (harbour) fairway light, bringing the three white lights (in a triangle) on Queen Street Wharf to bear S.W. by W. $\frac{3}{4}$ W., which will lead up the Harbour to the usual anchorage ground below the Wharf.

Vessels having to work in should not enter on the green light when near Rangitoto Reef, *i.e.*, when the peak of Rangitoto bears E. $\frac{1}{4}$ N., nor on the red when the Flagstaff on the summit of Mount Victoria bears S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ W., as they will on this latter bearing be in vicinity of the Rough Rock; they must also keep well in the white light when passing the Sandspit Buoy and Depôt Point.

Vessels entering by the Tehmaki Strait will see the red light over the low southern part of Koreho Island, and, taking care not to approach within one mile of the Island, pass through the red into the white fairway light of Koreho Channel; then steer so as to pass about two cables length N.W. of the Lighthouse, crossing the coloured lights of the Rangitoto Channel into the white harbour fairway light, and for the anchorage as before described.

Vessels entering by the Hieh Channel will keep on the line (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ W.) intersecting the green and white lights, edging away into the white in passing the N.W. extreme of Hieh Island, and thence up the Koreho Channel and into the Harbour as before described.

Beacon on Bastion Reefs.

Notice is hereby given, that the Beacon hitherto marking the position of the Bean Rocks is now erected on the north-eastern extreme of the Bastion Reefs, and from it the Lighthouse bears N.W., distant three cables.

Note.

All Bearings are Magnetic, and are given *towards* the light.

Mongonui.—Observer remarks that this was the driest month on record for this district; the greatest fall was on 5th, 0.40 inch for twenty-four hours; light winds during month, chiefly from N.W. Maximum temperature on 15th and 17th, 78.0.

Auckland.—Unusually warm and dry, with occasional cold nights. Maximum rainfall on 19th, only 0.154; severe S.W. gale on 12th and 13th, causing great damage to vegetation; force of wind during this storm unusually even, from 40 to 45 miles per hour; barometer rather high; otherwise winds moderate, prevailed from S.W. Maximum temperature on 29th, 79.3.

Taranaki.—Generally fine during month, small rainfall. Maximum on 18th, 0.570 inch. Stormy and squally on 11th, 12th, and 13th, from S.E., but little rain; stormy on 18th from N.E. with rain; otherwise winds moderate, and prevailed from S.W.; four days of fog. Maximum temperature on 15th, 72.0.

Napier.—Showery, unsettled; rainfall considerably over average; maximum on 12th, for twenty-four hours, 2.12 inches; stormy on 4th from N.; thunder on 11th; sixteen days of N.E. wind, generally moderate. Maximum temperature on 23th, 86.0.

Wellington.—Early part of the month wet and stormy, wind from N.W. and S.E.; on the 6th very strong from N.W., with heavy rain; 1.150 inch recorded on the 7th, when the wind changed to S.E., and still heavy rain though light wind; 1.600 inch up to morning of the 8th, maximum for month; stormy on night of 10th from S.E., and heavy rain, 1.400 inch, measured on the 11th; severe S.E. gale during the 11th and 12th, with rain, doing much damage, very cold and severe; cleared up on the 13th; stormy on the 15th, from N.W.; wet during the 17th, 18th, and 19th, from N.W.; otherwise the weather for the remainder of the month was bright and pleasant, wind chiefly from N.W., and moderate. Twenty-one days of N.W. wind. Maximum temperature on 1st, 67.0.

Nelson.—Fine weather generally, but heavy rain recorded on 4th, with strong S.E. wind (1.10 inch), and 19th (1.27 inch), barometer 29.4, and wind N.E.; on 11th and 12th rather stormy from S.E., little rain, wind changeable. Maximum temperature on 29th, 76.0.

Christchurch.—Showery throughout month, with occasional fine bright weather; rainfall above average; maximum for month on 11th, 0.582 inch; winds moderate, and prevailed from E. and S.W. Maximum temperature on 23th, 78.8.

Bealey.—On 1st, 5th, 6th, and 9th, stormy from N.W. and showery; gale on 16th, from N.W.; also strong winds from same quarter on 21st, 23rd, 25th, and 29th. Altogether, weather squally, showery, and unpleasant, with only occasionally bright days;—four days of snow; twenty-three days of N.W. wind; greatest rainfall on 17th, 2.270 inches. Maximum temperature on 15th, 73.5.

Hokitika.—Wet and unpleasant during early and latter part, but finer during middle of month; on 19th stormy from S.W., with heavy rain and hail; barometer 29.372; thunder also on 19th; about average rainfall for this month; fog on 28th; maximum rainfall on 7th, 1.94 inch, and highest temperature on 5th, 68.9; prevailing wind, S.W.

Dunedin.—Pleasant weather, with gentle showers; winds very light except on 19th, which was very stormy from W.; snow and hail on 19th; greatest rain recorded on 10th, .450; prevailing winds from S. and W. Maximum temperature on 27th, 75.0.

Southland.—Cold, showery, and unfavourable weather; frequent rain but small amount; four days of hail, and snow on 19th; thunder on 10th; very light winds, which prevailed from W.

GENERAL REMARKS.

Weather excessively dry in extreme north; otherwise rainfall has been generally in excess of average for this month. Aurora at Hokitika on 16th and 20th; at Dunedin and Bealey on 19th; and at Southland on 4th and 7th.
