**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House, at Wellington, this seventh day of November, 1872.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

**WHEREAS** by "The Mining Companies Limited Liability Act Amendment Act, 1869," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appoint one or more persons, to be called Official Auditors, to audit the accounts of all Official Agents heretofore appointed or hereafter to be appointed under "The Mining Companies Limited Liability Act, 1865:"

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,  
GREETING:

WHEREAS by "The Regulation of Elections Act, 1870," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor, by Warrant under his hand, from time to time to appoint Polling Places for each Electoral District, within or within one mile of the limits thereof, and to appoint any one of such Polling Places to be the Principal Polling Place for the District, and all or any of such Polling Places from time to time to abolish, and, if he think fit, to appoint other Polling Places in lieu of those abolished, and that every such Warrant shall be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*: Provided always that no Polling Place shall be appointed by the Governor under the said Act, unless he shall be first satisfied that the place to be appointed is more convenient than any other for at least twenty electors to record their votes thereat:

And whereas, by Warrant under the hand of the Governor, certain places were appointed Polling Places in the Province of Nelson for the election of Members of the Provincial Council thereof, for the Districts of Buller and Charleston:

And whereas it is expedient to abolish the same:

Now know ye that I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said Act, do hereby abolish all existing Polling Places for the above-named Districts in the Province of Nelson, for the election of Members of the Provincial Council, and do appoint in lieu thereof—

*For the District of Buller.*

The Court House, Westport;  
Mr. Isaac Chapman's Store, Giles' Terrace;  
Mr. McEurol's Store, Addisons;  
Mr. Leslie's Store, Lyell.

*For the District of Charleston.*

The Court House, Charleston;

And I do further appoint the Polling Places at Westport and Charleston to be the Principal Polling Places in the said Districts respectively.
