*Rehearing of Native Claims.*

NORMANBY, Governor.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At Wellington, this sixth day of July, 1875.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the eighth section of "The Native Land Act Amendment Act, 1874," it is enacted that in any case where an application for a rehearing of any matter heard and decided under the repealed Acts in the Act now in recital mentioned shall have been made subsequently to the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, the Governor in Council may, in the manner provided by the fifty-eighth section of "The Native Land Act, 1873," hereinafter called "the said Act," order a rehearing of any such matter so heard and decided as aforesaid, and all the provisions of the said Act respecting rehearings, as far as applicable, shall extend to any rehearing ordered under the Act now in recital: Provided that such application shall in each case have been made within six months from the date of the decision of the Court in such case: And whereas by the fifty-eighth section of the said Act it is enacted that, upon the application of any persons interested in any Native land who may feel themselves aggrieved by the decision of the Court in respect thereof, the Governor in Council may order a rehearing of any matter heard and decided under the provisions of the Act now in recital within such a period of time from the publication of the decision and memorial of ownership in manner in the Act now in recital thereinbefore required as may be limited in such order; and upon such order being made, all proceedings theretofore taken by the Court in such matter shall be annulled, and the case shall commence *de novo*, and shall proceed in manner provided by the Act now in recital: And whereas at a sitting of the Native Land Court of New Zealand at Shortland, in the District of Hauraki, in the Province of Auckland, held on the tenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, the claim of Reweti Rangikaiwhiria, Hiria Reweti, Monikaera, Mereana

Reweti, Matiu Poono, Ema Reweti, Mere Watana, Pare Watana, and Arani Wanata, to a piece of land at Tararu District called Ipu o Moehau, was heard and decided, and a certain order thereupon made by the said Court: And whereas on or about the seventeenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, an application was made by and on behalf of Renata Kitahi and other aboriginal natives claiming to have an interest in the said land, and who felt themselves aggrieved by the decision of the Court in respect thereof; and it is expedient that the said claim should be reheard before the said Court:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise and pursuance of the above recited power, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, doth hereby order and direct that the said claim of Reweti Rangikaiwhiria, and the other Natives hereinbefore mentioned, shall be reheard as and in the manner provided by "The Native Land Act, 1873," and "The Native Land Act Amendment Act, 1874," provided; and doth also order that such rehearing shall take place within two years from the said tenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

*Taking and Laying off a Road in Tangonoa Block.*

NORMANBY, Governor.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The Native Land Act, 1873," it is enacted that, from and out of any land which may have heretofore been or may be granted under the provisions of any of the Acts thereby repealed, or of that Act, it shall be lawful for the Governor at any time thereafter to take and lay off for public purposes one or more line or lines of road or railway through the said lands: Provided that the total quantity of land which may be taken for such line or lines of road shall not be more than after the rate of five acres in every one hundred acres: Provided always that this power shall cease and determine at the

expiration of ten years from the date of the Crown grant: And whereas it is expedient that a fit and proper person should be authorized to take and lay down the road described in the Schedule hereto on the lands specified in the Crown grant mentioned in the said Schedule:

Now therefore, I, the Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of all powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf, do hereby authorize Edward Walter Puckey, officer of the Native Department, Thames, Auckland, to take and lay down the road specified in the Schedule hereto on the lands specified in the Crown grant mentioned in the Schedule, and for that purpose to exercise all such powers as by the said Act may be exercised by a person legally authorized in that behalf under the said Act.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Most Honorable George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Earl of Mulgrave, Viscount Normanby, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross, in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland; a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; at the Government House at Wellington, this sixth day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five.

## SOUTH ENTRANCE, MORETON BAY.

In consequence of changes which have taken place

in the south entrance to Moreton Bay, the following alterations are made in the sailing directions for entering by that channel:—

To carry the deepest water over the bar, near the crossing now in use, keep the westernmost rocky knoll just open to the eastward of the centre hummock of the triple hill at the back. When over the outer bar, haul up, and gradually bring the rocky knoll in a line with the centre hummock, passing the western spit of the detached break at a short cable's distance, and keeping those marks on until the beacons at the south end of Moreton Island are well open of the north-east end of the south break.

The beacons in line lead in, over the Bar, to the northward of the detached break, in 14 feet 6 inches low-water springs—past the south break and up the main channel as formerly.

There is also a channel over the bar on the south side of, and at a short cable's distance from, the detached break, with about 13 feet 6 inches at low water.

As it cannot be expected that so many channels will long remain open to their present depth, due precaution must be observed in taking the bar.

## PROCLAMATION.

*Delegation of Powers by His Honor James Macandrew, Superintendent of the Province of Otago.*

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Harbour Boards Act, 1870," it is, among other things, enacted that the Superintendent and Provincial Council of any province may from time to time make laws for providing for the constitution of a Harbour Board for any port or ports within such province, for giving a name to any such Board, for providing for the number of members of which any such Board shall consist, for providing for the election or appointment of members, or for the election of a certain number and appointment of a certain number of such members, and for other purposes in the third section of the said Act mentioned: And whereas by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Otago, passed in the thirty-third session of the said Council, No. 423, intituled "The Oamaru Harbour Ordinance, 1874," a Harbour Board was constituted for the Port of Oamaru, in the Province of Otago, and was named "The Oamaru Harbour Board:" And whereas by the said Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Harbour Boards Act, 1870," it is provided that the Superintendent of the province within which any port for which a Harbour Board might be constituted thereunder is situate may from time to time, by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, delegate to such Harbour Board all or any of the powers and authorities vested in him by "The Marine Act, 1867," subject to any regulations, restrictions, or stipulations which might be specified in such Proclamation, provided that such delegation

should be limited to the port or harbour for which such Board was constituted: And whereas it is expedient that all the powers and authorities vested in me as Superintendent of the Province of Otago, under "The Marine Act, 1867," so far as such powers and authorities are applicable to and may be exercised in the Port of Oamaru, should be delegated to "The Oamaru Harbour Board:"

Now therefore, I, James Macandrew, Superintendent of the Province of Otago, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said province, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by "The Harbour Boards Act, 1870," and of any and every power in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby delegate to "The Oamaru Harbour Board" all the powers and authorities vested in me under "The Marine Act, 1867," or any amendment thereof, so far as such powers and authorities can be exercised in the Port of Oamaru, and so as the same be exercised only at and for the said port, but subject always to the following restrictions or stipulations, that is to say,—

1. That nothing herein contained shall give or be construed to give to the said Board power to levy dues on any goods passing over any railway pier which may hereafter be erected by or for Her Majesty the Queen, within the Port of Oamaru.
2. That nothing herein contained shall give or be construed to give to the said Board power to interfere with or prevent the Proclamation, by the Superintendent of the Province of Otago, of any land within the Port of Oamaru, which is now or hereafter may be vested in the Superintendent of the Province of Otago.
3. That after the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, the said Board shall, out of their own funds, pay and provide for the salaries of the Harbour Master and other persons for the time being employed by the Board at the Port of Oamaru.
