*Notice under the Native Land Acts, 1873-74, of Times and Places for Investigating Claims.*

NOTICE is hereby given, that the claims, on behalf of themselves and others, of the several persons whose names are mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereunder written to the several blocks of land of which the names and localities are mentioned in the second column, the boundaries of which are published in the Schedule hereunder, will be investigated at Carlyle, Patea, on the 14th of September next, and following days.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council, made on the 12th day of December, 1876, it was ordered by His Excellency the Governor in Council, under "The Native Land Act, 1873," and "The Native Land Act, 1874," that the claim of Mangu and others, to a piece of land called Mangaotuku, situate at Patea, in the District of Taranaki, heard and determined by the Native Land Court of New Zealand, on the 8th day of November, 1875, at Patea, in the district aforesaid, should be reheard before the said Court, and that such rehearing shall take place before the 8th day of November next.

Now, I hereby give notice that a sitting of the Native Land Court will be held at Carlyle, Patea, in the district aforesaid, on the 14th day of September next, for the rehearing of the afore-mentioned claim.
