Now, therefore, I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare the following house or building to be a Public Prison:—

# NORMANBY, Governor. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-eighth day of August, 1877.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

THEREAS by "The Volunteer Act, 1865," the

Whereas by "The Volunteer Act, 1865," the Governor in Council is authorized from time to time to make and alter regulations respecting the enrolment, discipline, training, exercise, and accourrements, clothing, equipment, conveyance, pay, rations, lodging, and pensions of the Volunteer Force, or any part thereof, and to declare what is requisite to entitle a Volunteer to be deemed an efficient Volunteer for the purposes of the said Act, and generally for the more effectual carrying out of the said Act; and to appoint penalties, not exceeding five pounds for each offence, for any breach of the provisions of the said Act or of such Regulations:

And whereas by an Order in Council, dated the tenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, certain rules and regulations were so made: And whereas it is expedient now to alter

the same:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance of the said recited power and authority, doth by this present Order, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, alter the aforesaid rules and regulations, and doth make the rules and regulations specified in the Schedule hereinafter written.

#### SCHEDULE.

REGULATIONS FOR THE NEW ZEALAND VOLUNTEER FORCE.

That portion of Rule 34, relating to Cavalry Volunteers, is hereby altered as follows:—

1. Cavalry Volunteers shall parade twice a day for six (6) consecutive days, at such time as may be appointed by the Officer Commanding the District, and parade half-yearly for inspection; or twice a day for three (3) consecutive days, and one (1) inspection; or

2. Shall attend six (6) monthly inspection and six (6) company parades, or three (3) monthly inspec-

tions, and three (3) company parades.

Every Volunteer Corps shall on or before the 30th June in each year elect under which of the above provisions it intends to hold parades for the then current year.

Volunteers who attend six (6) consecutive days' drill and (2) two half-yearly inspections, or six (6) monthly inspections and six (6) company parades, shall be entitled to the full rate of capitation voted.

Volunteers who attend three (3) consecutive days' drill, and one (1) half-yearly inspection, or three (3) monthly inspections and three (3) company parades, shall be entitled to half the rate of capitation.

No Volunteer shall be entitled to any capitation unless he has received a certificate of efficiency for the then current year.
