Regulations under the "Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876."

(L.S.) **NORMANBY, Governor.**
A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that in any district now or from time to time hereafter constituted under the provisions of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," and in which "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876," has or shall be brought into force, the following regulations and none other shall have effect: Provided always that any regulations heretofore in force shall remain in force, so far as relates to anything done or commenced, and the same may be continued and completed thereunder.

REGULATIONS.

1. In the construction of these regulations, the following terms and expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them respectively, unless the context requires a different construction:—

"The Act," means "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876."

"Landowner" has the same meaning as is assigned to it by "the Act."

"Returning Officer" means any person appointed or empowered to preside at or to conduct the elections of the Trustees or Trustee of a district.

"Trustees" mean the Trustees or Trustee for a district.

"District" has the same meaning as is assigned to it in the Act.

"Resident Magistrate" means the Resident Magistrate having jurisdiction in the district, or if there is no such Resident Magistrate, or more than one, then such Resident Magistrate as the Governor may from time to time appoint to perform the duties and exercise the functions imposed on the Resident Magistrate by these regulations, and shall include any person acting as or fulfilling the duties of such Resident Magistrate.

2. As soon as conveniently may be after a new district is constituted, the voters' roll for first elections of Trustees shall be prepared by the Resident Magistrate. Such roll shall be in force until the 1st day of March in the next following year.

3. In every district the Resident Magistrate shall, in every year, prepare a fresh roll, which roll shall be the voters' roll for such district for all elections between the last day of February in the year wherein such roll shall have been made and the first day of March in the next succeeding year.

4. Such rolls shall be formed by placing thereon the name of every landowner who, under the provisions of the Act, is entitled to vote at an election of Trustees.

5. The rolls so to be formed may be partly written and partly printed, or wholly written or printed, as may be most convenient, and shall be published by the Resident Magistrate during the first fourteen days of the month of February in every year, by affixing the same to the outer door of the Resident Magistrate's Courthouse, if there be one in the district, or, if there be no such Courthouse, then in or on some other public or conspicuous place in such district; but publication shall not be necessary in the case of the roll prepared for the first election pursuant to the Act.

6. During such fourteen days it shall be lawful for the Resident Magistrate, if it be established that the name of any person entitled to vote in the election of Trustees has been omitted from or erroneously inserted on such roll, to place on such roll the name so omitted, or to strike out the name so erroneously inserted on such roll.

7. The Resident Magistrate shall sign the roll for the first elections, and every subsequent roll when so amended. When so signed such roll shall be conclusive evidence that the persons whose names are on such roll, and no others, are the persons entitled to vote in the election of Trustees for the district.

8. If the Resident Magistrate is absent from the district, then the roll shall be signed by the Clerk to such Resident Magistrate; and such rolls so signed as aforesaid shall be the voters' rolls to be used respectively at the election of the Trustees.

9. The Resident Magistrate shall, on the request of the Returning Officer, cause such officer to be supplied with a sufficient number of copies of the voters' roll as may be necessary for the purposes of the elections in the district.

10. All the proceedings in any election of the first Trustees of a district shall, as far as possible, be the same as is provided by "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876," for filling an ordinary vacancy.

A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the seventh section of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1877," I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that, from and after the day of the date hereof, "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876," shall come into force in the Aparima Rabbit District, as constituted by Order in Council of the twentieth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight:

And I do hereby further proclaim and declare that the first election of Trustees of the said district shall be held on the twenty-second day of May next, at the hour of noon, at the Schoolhouse at Gummie's Bush; and I appoint

JOHN ROBERTS MILLS,

to be Returning Officer to conduct the first elections of Trustees for the said district.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Auckland, this twentieth day of April, 1878.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Rabbit Nuisance Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1877," it is enacted that, in addition to the power of proclaiming districts given by the third section of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," the Governor might from time to time, by Order in Council, direct that any part of the colony to be defined therein should be a rabbit district for the purposes of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876:"

Now, therefore, I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, and in exercise of the powers vested in me by the firstly hereinbefore recited Act, do hereby order and direct that that part of the colony described in the Schedule hereto shall, from and after the date hereof, be and the same is hereby constituted a district for the purposes of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," and shall be named and known as the Aparima Rabbit District, and the boundaries of such district shall be those defined in the Schedule hereto. And with the like advice and consent, I do hereby order that the first election of Trustees for the said district shall be held on the twenty-second day of May next, at the hour of noon, at the Schoolhouse, at Gummie's Bush.

SCHEDULE.

BOUNDED towards the North by the Wairio and part of the Taringatura Districts; towards the East by Southland County; towards the South by the ocean to Kolac's Bay; towards the West by a line running due north over Mount Ferndunlaw to Wairio District, the starting point.

LAI D before His Excellency the Governor by the Minister for Public Works, pursuant to the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1876," containing an accurate description of the lands proposed to be taken for a certain public work—to wit, the construction of a portion of the railway from Kaipara through Riverhead to Auckland—(Auckland contract).

COUNTY OF EDEN.

PARISH OF WAITEMATA, NEWMARKET HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

COMMENCING at a point which is situated on the Auckland and Mercer Railway, as described in the Proclamation dated the 8th August, 1872, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 40, of the 12th August, 1872, within Lot 23, Section 4, Suburbs

of Auckland, containing 7 perches, being the eastern portion of F. G. Clayton's land, joining the Wai-kato Railway. Bounded towards the North by H. Keane's land, thirty-four links; towards the East by the Railway Reserve, one hundred and ninety links; towards the South by Lot 24, fifteen links; and towards the West by F. G. Clayton's property, one hundred and eighty-nine links respectively.

Also all that other portion north of the last-described land, in the above district, containing 6 perches. Bounded towards the North by a private road, thirty-four links; towards the East by a Railway Reserve, one hundred and twelve links; towards the South by F. G. Bounded towards the North by other portion of Lot 34, three hundred links; towards the West by Lot 33, one hundred and sixteen links; towards the South by other portion of Lot 34, three hundred links; and towards the East by Lot 35, one hundred and twelve links respectively.

Also all that other parcel of land being portion of Lot 33, in the above district, containing 1 rood 16 perches. Bounded towards the North by other portion of Lot 33, eighty-eight links and two hundred and twelve links; towards the West by Lot 32, one hundred and nineteen links; towards the South by other portion of Lot 33, two hundred and ten links and ninety links; and towards the East by Lot 34, one hundred and sixteen links respectively.

Also all that other parcel of land being portion of Lot 32, in the above district, containing 1 rood 22 perches. Bounded towards the North by other portion of Lot 32, three hundred and fourteen links; towards the West by Lot 31, one hundred and twenty-eight links; towards the South by other portion of Lot 32, three hundred and sixteen links; and towards the East by other portion of Lot 33, one hundred and nineteen links respectively.

Also all that other parcel of land being portion of Lot 31, in the above district, containing 1 rood 26 perches. Bounded towards the North by other portion of Lot 31, one hundred and eight links and two hundred and thirty-three links; towards the West by a public road, one hundred and forty-one links; towards the South by other portion of Lot 31, one hundred and eighty-nine and one hundred and sixty-two links; towards the East by Lot 32, one hundred and twenty-eight links respectively.

Also all that other parcel of land being portion of Lot 1, in the above district, containing 2 roods 3 perches. Bounded towards the North-west by other portion of Lot 1, two hundred and ninety-one and one hundred and ninety-four links; towards the West by Lot 2, seventy-two links; towards the South by the Great South Road, seventy-three links; towards the South-east by other portion of Lot 1, three hundred and ninety-three links; and towards the East by a public road, one hundred and forty-one links respectively.

Also all that other parcel of land being the south-east corner of Lot 2, in the above district, containing 6 perches. Bounded towards the South by the Great South Road, one hundred and five links; towards the East by Lot 1, seventy-two links; and towards the North-west by other portion of Lot 2, one hundred and twenty-seven links respectively.

EPSOM HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by "The Public Works Act, 1876," it is enacted that, whenever lands are required to be taken for public works, the Minister for Public Works shall cause a survey to be made and plans to be prepared showing generally the nature of the works proposed to be executed and the lands required to be taken for the same, together with the names of the owners and occupiers of such lands so far as they can be ascertained, and shall cause a copy of such plans to be deposited in some place in the road district in which such lands are:

And it is further enacted that the said Minister shall cause a notice to be gazetted, and to be twice publicly notified, stating the place where such plans are open for inspection, with a general description of the works proposed to be executed and of the lands required to be taken; and if after due consideration the said Minister is of opinion that it is expedient that the proposed works should be executed, and that no private injury will be done thereby for which due compensation is not provided by the Act now in recital, the land proposed to be taken shall be taken in the following manner—that is to say: The said Minister shall lay before the Governor a memorial containing an accurate description of the lands proposed to be taken, together with a map thereof, signed by the Surveyor-General or some certificated surveyor as evidence of the accuracy thereof; and the Governor in Council may thereupon, if he think fit, by Proclamation gazetted and publicly notified, declare that the said lands are taken for the use of a railway, road, or other public work, as the case may be; and from and after a date to be named in the said Proclamation the lands therein specified shall become absolutely vested in fee-simple in Her Majesty, discharged from all mortgages, charges, claims, estates, or interests of what kind soever, for the public use named in the said Proclamation:

And whereas the lands described in the memorial above written are required to be taken under the authority of the said "Public Works Act, 1876," for a certain public work—to wit, the construction of a portion of the railway from Kaipara through Riverhead to Auckland—(Auckland contract):

And whereas all the requirements and conditions prescribed by the said Act prior to the taking of such lands have been duly performed and fulfilled:

Now, therefore, I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Governor of New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of the power and authority in

me vested by the said Act, and of any other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the lands described in the memorial above written, and shown on the plan thereto attached, are hereby taken for the purposes of a railway; and that from and after the day of the date hereof the said lands shall become absolutely vested in fee-simple in Her Majesty, discharged from all mortgages, charges, claims, estates, and interests of what kind soever, for use as a railway.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Most Honorable George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Earl of Mulgrave, Viscount Normanby, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross, in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland; a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at the Government House, at Auckland, this eighteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight.
