Regulations under "The Land-Tax Act, 1878."

NORMANBY, Governor.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this seventeenth day of December, 1878.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the seventeenth section of "The Land-Tax Act, 1878," (in the regulations hereafter referred to styled "the said Act,") it is enacted among other things, that the Governor, by Order in Council, may from time to time make, alter, and revoke regulations not inconsistent with the said Act, for the purposes in the said section mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, do hereby make the following regulations for the purposes of the said Act: And, with the like advice and consent, do hereby order and declare that the said regulations shall come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine.

REGULATIONS.

1. The valuation list referred to in section 20 of the said Act shall be kept in the form (No. 3) in the Schedule A hereto.
2. The form of public notice of the deposit of valuation lists, to be given pursuant to section 24 of the said Act, shall be given in the form in the Schedule B hereto.
3. The notice of valuation to be given by the Deputy Commissioner to every person whose name appears in the valuation list, as provided by section 25 of the said Act, shall be in the form in the Schedule C hereto.
4. The form of objection to be given by any person who considers himself aggrieved by reason of the unfairness or incorrectness of any valuation, or by the insertion or incorrectness of any matter therein, as provided by sections 26 and 27 of the said Act, shall be that set forth in the Schedule D hereto.
5. The Commissioner may, by the form in the Schedule E hereto, request the Judge of the Assess-

ment Court to appoint a time and place for hearing objections to, and claims for exemptions from, land-tax.

6. The notification in the *Gazette*, pursuant to section 32 of the said Act, shall be in the form in the Schedule F hereto.

7. The Land-Tax Register referred to in sections 36 and 37 of the said Act shall be kept in the form (No. 5) of the Schedule G hereto.

8. The form of oath, pursuant to section 38 of the said Act, verifying the Land-Tax Register or duplicate shall be that in the Schedule H hereto.

9. When any person whose name is on the Land-Tax Register applies, under section 39, to have his name removed therefrom, the application shall be in the form in the Schedule I hereto.

10. The notice of the Deputy Commissioner's decision, pursuant to section 40 of the said Act, shall be in the form in the Schedule J hereto.

11. If the Deputy Commissioner declines to remove the applicant's name, the applicant shall, if he desires to obtain a summons, pursuant to section 41 of the said Act, file an affidavit setting forth the facts on which he relies as entitling him to have his name removed from the Land-Tax Register. The Judge to whom the application is made may either grant or refuse to issue a summons, as he thinks just. If he determines to issue a summons, the same shall be in the form in the Schedule K hereto, and shall name a time and place for showing cause, which any Judge of the Supreme Court may by order enlarge from time to time. Every such summons, and every order enlarging the same, shall be served on the Deputy Commissioner of the Land-Tax District, by delivering at his office a copy of the same. If the party taking out the summons do not attend at the time and place appointed, he will be deemed to have abandoned his application, and the summons will be dismissed with costs. If the Deputy Commissioner does not appear, the application may, upon an affidavit of service of the summons, be granted or refused, with or without costs. If the Deputy Commissioner appears, the application may be granted or refused, with or without costs, as may be just. Upon the hearing of any such summons, the parties shall be at liberty to verify their respective cases in whole or in part by affidavit, but so that the deponent in every such affidavit shall, on the application of the opposite party, be subject to

be cross-examined by or on behalf of such opposite party orally, and after such cross-examination may be re-examined orally by or on behalf of the party by whom such affidavit was filed.

12. The monthly return by the District Land Registrars and Registrars of Deeds under section 43 of the said Act shall be in the form (No. 7) in the Schedule L hereto.

13. The form of notice and acknowledgment forwarded under section 44 of the said Act shall be that in the Schedule M hereto.

14. The form of public notice to be given under section 45 of the said Act shall be that in the Schedule N hereto.

15. Before any land is sold under sections 57 and 58 of the said Act for arrears of land-tax, a notice, in the form in the Schedule O hereto, shall be given to the owner thereof, as appearing on the Land-Tax Register, personally, or sent by messenger or post to his last known place of business or abode. If such owner is absent from the colony the notice may be sent to his agent. If such person is not known, and has no known agent in the colony, the notice shall be published in some newspaper circulating in the county or borough in which the land is situated.

16. When any sale is made for arrears of land-tax under section 58 of the said Act, the form of transfer to the purchaser shall be that in Schedule P hereto.

17. The form of notice of lien under section 59 of the said Act shall be that in the Schedule Q hereto.

18. The several forms set forth in Schedule R hereto are hereby prescribed as forms (Nos. 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) to be used to give effect to the said Act.

Notice must be given of claims for exemption from land-tax, and every such notice must be included in a notice of objection to the valuation; and in such notice the claimant shall state the particulars of the property or properties in respect of which such exemption is claimed, and the district in which he desires that such exemption shall take effect.

If two or more claims for exemption relating to the same land be put in, the same shall be treated as one such claim.

Any person knowingly and wilfully making a false claim for exemption from land-tax is declared by the said Act to be deemed guilty of a misdemeanour.
