Sheep District of Waiau amended.—Notice No. 22.

(L.S.) HERCULES ROBINSON, Governor.
A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in me by the eighth section of "The Sheep Act, 1878," and of all other powers and authorities enabling me in that behalf, I, Hercules George Robert Robinson, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that so much of the Proclamation of the twenty-third day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, as describes the Waiau Sheep District is hereby rescinded:

And I hereby proclaim and declare that the Waiau Sheep District shall, for the purposes of the said Act, hereafter be as the same is described in the Schedule hereto, and that such district and subdivisions shall be known respectively by the names set forth in the said Schedule; and that all boroughs in such district shall be deemed to be included in the counties wherein they are situate.

SCHEDULE.

WAIAU SHEEP DISTRICT.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Nelson, bounded towards the North by the Henry River, from its source at Travers Peak to its confluence with the Waiauua or Dillon River; thence towards the East by the right bank of that river to the boundary fence between St. Leonard's Run and Culverden and Balmoral Runs, thence by that fence to the Hurunui River at a point at or near the confluence of the Pahau River, thence due south to the right bank of the Hurunui; towards the South by the right bank of the Hurunui River to its source at the saddle between the Hurunui and Teremakau Rivers; and towards the West by the summit of the watershed to Travers Peak, the starting point; and shall comprise the following subdivisions:—

The Glen Wye Subdivision.

Comprising the runs and farms owned by Messrs. T. Holmes, W. A. Low, and E. Jones.

The Waiau Subdivision.

Comprising all that portion of the Waiau Sheep District which is not comprised in the Glen Wye Subdivision.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this fourth day of February, 1880.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Rabbit Nuisance Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1877," it is enacted that, in addition to the power of proclaiming districts given by the third section of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," the Governor might from time to time, by Order in Council, direct that any part of the colony to be defined therein should be a rabbit district for the purposes of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876:"

Now, therefore, I, Hercules George Robert Robinson, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, and in exercise of the powers vested in me by the firstly hereinbefore recited Act, do hereby order and direct that that

part of the colony described in the Schedule hereto shall, from and after the date hereof, be and the same is hereby constituted a district for the purposes of "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1876," and shall be named and known as the Castlepoint Rabbit District, and the boundaries of such district shall be those defined in the Schedule hereto: And, with the like advice and consent, I do hereby order that the first election of Trustees for the said district shall be held on the sixth day of March next, at the Public Hall, Tinui.

Appointing Rangimotumotu and Tawhio te Kani Trustees under "The Maori Real Estate Management Act, 1878."

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-seventh day of January, 1880.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Maori Real Estate Management Act, 1867" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), it is enacted that, if any title to or interest in any hereditaments shall accrue to any Maoris, who or any of whom shall be infants, lunatics, or under legal disability, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, if he think fit, to order that such hereditaments, or any part thereof or interest therein, as shall to the Governor in Council be shown to belong to such infant, or lunatic, or other person under legal disability, shall be vested in trustees, as the Governor in Council shall think fit:

And whereas by virtue of a Crown grant bearing date the thirteenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, the parcel of land and hereditaments described in the Schedule hereto became vested in Urupene (Urupene Whareauahi), of the District of Bay of Plenty, in the Province of Auckland, an aboriginal native of New Zealand:

And whereas the said Urupene (Urupene Whareauahi) died intestate:

And whereas at a sitting of the Native Land Court held at Matata, in the Provincial District of Auckland, on the sixth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, Tawhio te Kani claimed to succeed to the said Urupene (Urupene Whareauahi) in the parcel of land described in the said Schedule, and it was ordered by the said Court that Te Ratana, Te Teri, Ngarara, Ngahau, and Urupene, infants under the age of twenty-one years, should succeed to the interest and share of the said Urupene (Urupene Whareauahi) in the hereditaments aforesaid; and it is expedient that Rangimotumotu and Tawhio te Kani be appointed trustees under the said Act, on behalf of the said Te Ratana, male (a minor, twelve years old), Te Teri, male (a minor, eleven years old), Ngarara, male (a minor, nine years old), Ngahau, male (a minor, seven years old), and Urupene, male (a minor, four years old):

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the colony, in exercise and in pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in him by the said Act, doth hereby order that the interests and shares of the said Te Ratana, Te Teri, Ngarara, Ngahau, and Urupene in the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be and remain vested in

RANGIMOTUMOTU and
TAWHIO TE KANI,

as Trustees, within the meaning and for the purposes of the said Act, for the said Te Ratana, Te Teri, Ngarara, Ngahau, and Urupene during their minority.

ALL that parcel of land in the Province of Auckland, in the Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement 2 roods, more or less, situate at Matata, in the District of Bay of Plenty, being called or known by the name of Lot 17, Township of Matata.
