A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of all powers and authorities enabling me in that behalf, I, Hercules George Robert Robinson, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that, by an Order in Council made under the provisions of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1873," and "The Bank Holidays Amendment Act, 1878," and bearing date the nineteenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, I have appointed Wednesday, the tenth day of March next, and Thursday, the eleventh day of March next, to be observed as bank half-holidays, and Friday, the twelfth day of March next, to be observed as a bank holiday within the Borough of Wanganui, under and for the purposes of the said Acts.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir Hercules George Robert Robinson, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at Dunedin, this twenty-sixth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty.

IN pursuance and exercise of all powers and authorities enabling me in that behalf, I, Hercules George Robert Robinson, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that, by an Order in Council made under the provisions of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1873," and bearing date the second day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, I have declared that Thursday, the eleventh day of March instant, and Friday, the twelfth day of March instant, shall be bank holidays within the Borough of Marton and Counties of Wanganui, Rangitikei, and Patea, under and for the purposes of the said Act.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir Hercules George Robert Robinson, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony this second day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty.
