WHEREAS at a sitting of the Native Land Court holden at Tauranga on the 3rd day of January, 1871, a block of land called Pukaingataru, was by order of T. H. Smith, Esquire, the then presiding Judge, awarded to the Tapuika and Ngatimoko tribes, who were themselves to nominate to the Court the names of the persons to be inserted in the Certificate of Title as owners of the said block:
