Extending Time for holding First Elections of South Waimakariri River District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation bearing date the eleventh day of November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, I did, among other things, appoint Tuesday, the thirtieth day of this current month of November, for the election of members of the Board of Conservators of the South Waimakariri River District, and Tuesday, the fourteenth day of December next, for the first meeting of the said

And whereas it is expedient to extend the times for holding the said election and for the first meeting of the said Board:

Now, therefore, I, James Prendergast, Chief Justice of the Colony of New Zealand, and Administrator of the Government thereof, do hereby proclaim and declare that the election of members of the Board of Conservators of the South Waimakariri River District shall be held on Tuesday, the twenty-first day of December next, and that the first meeting of the said Board shall be held on Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of December next.
