Setting apart Land in Westland for Agricultural Leases.

(L.S.) **A**ETHUE GOBDON, GOVERNOR. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the fifty-fourth section of "The Mines Act, 1877," it is, amongst other things, enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to cause Crown lands situate within a gold field to be selected and set apart for the purpose of granting agricultural leases thereon and therefor:

And whereas the lands described in the Schedule hereto are Crown lands subject to be dealt with under the provisions of the said Act, and it is deemed expedient to set the same apart for the purpose of granting agricultural leases thereon and therefor;

Now, therefore, I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby select and set apart, for the purpose of granting agricultural leases thereon and therefor; the lands described in the Schedule hereto; and do fix Tuesday, the first day of March next ensuing, at the Warden's Office at Okarito, as the day and place on which the said land shall be open for application in allotments, as surveyed and marked on the official map in the office of the Commissioner of Crown Lands at Hokitika.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement 60 acres, more or less, situated in Block XIV. on the map of the Mount One One Survey District. Bounded towards the North-west by the road along the sea-coast; towards the South by a straight line, and by a road along the salt-water lagoon; towards the South-east by a line parallel with the western boundary; and towards the Northeast by a line to include the quantity, and to cover improvements known as "Adamson's." THE HONORABLE THE PREMIER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Rating Act, 1876," it is enacted that if the local body or the Assessment Court fails through misadventure or accident to do anything which by that Act is required to be done in a fixed time, the Governor may, by an Order in Council, published in the Government Gazette

and publicly notified, extend the time for doing such thing, and may by any such order validate anything which may have been irregularly done in matter of form, so that the intent and purpose of the said Act may have effect: And whereas the Portobello Road Board, being the local body of the Portobello Road District, constituted under an Act of the Province of Otago intituled "The Otago Roads Ordinance, 1871," have failed by misadventure to appoint a valuer or valuers as provided by the sixth section of "The Rating Act, 1876," and no valuation list for that district as by that Act prescribed has been prepared, signed, and transmitted:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by "The Rating Act, 1876," and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, extend the time for the appeintment of a valuer or valuers, and for preparing, signing, and transmitting the valuation lists for the said district, until not later than the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one; and, with the like advice and consent, do hereby order that such valuation list shall be deposited, lie open for inspection, public notice bè given, ratepayers and others may inspect such valuation list and take copies thereof, and make objections thereto, as provided by the said Act, from the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, to the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one; and I do hereby, with the like advice and consent, extend the time accordingly.

THE HONOBABLE THE PREMIER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the eleventh section of "The Public Reserves Act, 1877," I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, do hereby order and declare that the reserve made for public recreation in the Provincial District of Taranaki, and known as the Manutabi Recreation-ground, and described in the Schedule hereto, shall be and the same is hereby brought under the operation of and declared to be subject to the provisions of "The Public Domains Act, 1860," and its amending Acts; and such domain shall hereafter be managed, administered, and dealt with in manner directed by the said Acts.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement 3 acres 3 roods 2 perches, more or less, being part of southwestern portion of Section No. 9 on the map of the Manutahi Settlement, Hawera Survey District. Powers delegated to the Manutahi Domain Board under "The Public Domains Act, 1860."

ARTHUR GORDON, Governor. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this thirteenth day of January, 1881.

Present:

THE HONORABLE THE PREMIER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the eleventh section of "The Public Domains Act, 1860," it is enacted that the Governor, by Order in Council, may from time to time delegate all or any of the powers by the said Act conferred upon any person for any period, and subject to such stipulations as may be specified in such order, and that every such delegation may from time to time in like manner be altered or revoked: And whereas it is enacted by "The Public Domains Act, 1865," that the word "person" in the herein-before recited section of "The Public Domains Act, 1860," shall be deemed to include more persons than one: And whereas pursuant to "The Public Re-serves Act, 1877," by an Order in Council of even date herewith, the land described in the Schedule thereto is declared to be brought under and to be subject to the said "Public Domains Act, 1860:"

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony of New Zealand, doth, by this present order, delegate all the powers conferred by the Act first above mentioned, except the powers under or conferred by subsections five and ten of section five, and section eleven, to the under-mentioned persons, who shall be known as the Manutahi Domain Board :-

JOHN GEORGE GINGER, DUNCAN MCGREGOR, WILLIAM BALMFORTH, GEORGE BALMFORTH, and RICHARD WHITE FOREMAN

(herein referred to as "the Board"), subject to the

stipulations hereinafter contained, that is to say,— 1. The Board shall meet for the transaction of business on the first Monday in each month, at halfpast seven o'clock p.m., at the Blockhouse, Manutahi, or at such other time or place as may from time to time be fixed by the Board. The first meeting shall be held on Tuesday, the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one.

2. Special meetings may be convened by the Chairman, or by any two members of the Board, provided that two days' notice of such meeting be given to each member, specifying the business to be transacted at such special meeting, and no other business than that so specified shall be transacted at such meeting.

3. Any three of the said Board shall form a Any meeting may be adjourned from time quorum. to time.

4. The members of the Board shall, at their first meeting, and thereafter at an annual meeting to be held on the first Monday in January in every succeeding year thereafter, elect one of themselves to be Chairman, who may join in the discussion, and shall have an original as well as a casting vote. The Chairman shall hold office until the election of his successor.

5. If at any meeting the Chairman is not present at the time appointed for holding the same, the members present shall choose some one of their number to be Chairman of such meeting.

6. If, by resignation, death, or incapacity, or other-wise, the office of Chairman shall be or become vacant, the members may at any monthly or special meeting appoint a Chairman,

7. All questions shall be determined by the majority of votes of the members of the Board present at a meeting.

Altering Times of Meeting of the Land Board of the Land District of Wellington.

ARTHUR GORDON, Governor.

WHEREAS by the first subsection of section twenty-five of "The Land Act, 1877," it is provided that the Land Boards of the respective land districts shall sit at the Land Office in the principal town of the land district, at certain times to be determined by the Board and approved of by the Governor, and published in the New Zealand Gazette:

And whereas by a warrant under the hand of His Excellency the Governor, dated the twenty-eighth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, it was appointed that the Land Board of Wellington should sit on the fifteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and on every alternate Thursday thereafter, at eleven o'clock a.m.

And whereas the Land Board of Wellington did, on the thirtieth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, pass a resolution recommending that the time of sitting should be altered, and it is expedient to give effect to the said recommendation:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise of the power and authority vested in me in that behalf, do hereby fix and determine that the ordinary meetings of the Land Board of the Land District of Wellington shall be held every alternate Thursday, at half-past ten o'clock a.m., commencing on Thurs-day, the tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, instead of at eleven o'clock a.m., as heretofore appointed.

WHEREAS by the one hundred and forty-fourth section of "The Land Act, 1877," it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, either by general or particular description, and whether the same has been surveyed or not, reserve from sale temporarily, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which, in his opinion, are required for any of the purposes in the said section mentioned :

Now, therefore, I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Act, do hereby temporarily reserve from sale the land in the Land Districts of Auckland and Westland described in the Schedule hereunder written, for the purposes in the said Schedule specified.

RULES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE FEILDING GEMETEBY, COUNTY OF MANAWATU.

1. A portion of the cemetery reserve shall be divided into two classes, viz., Class A and Class B. Class A will be ground of which the perpetual and

Class A will be ground of which the perpetual and exclusive right may be acquired, with the privilege of enclosing it and erecting headstones or other monuments thereon. A portion of the ground of this class, when purchased, will be marked off into lots of $10 \ge 5$ feet, which will be sold for 10s. each; or, if four or more adjoining lots be bought, for 7s. 6d. each.

Class B will be ground set aside for the interment of such persons as are not purchasers of, and have not acquired a right to, private ground. The lots in this class will be $8 \ge 4\frac{1}{2}$ feet, and cannot be selected, but must be taken as they come, under the direction and written authority of the Trustees. These lots may be fenced subject to the approval of the Trustees, provided that all fences are kept within the pegs and not over 3 feet 6 inches high.

2. Any purchaser of private ground in which no interment has taken place may transfer his or her interest in it to any other person upon payment of a transfer fee of 2s. 6d. to the Treasurer of the Board.

3. All graves must be 6 feet deep, and a charge of 2s. 6d. per foot shall be made for every foot more than 6 feet.

4. No grave shall be opened for any new interment sooner than after the expiry of seven years from the last interment.

5. All monuments, graves, and gravestones must be kept in proper order by and at the expense of the owners.

6. The Treasurer shall keep a book in which he shall enter from time to time the number of the lot sold, name of purchaser, and date of sale. He shall also receive the purchase-money and give a receipt for it of the following form:—"Feilding Cemetery.— Received from A.B., of , the sum of

for Lot No. , Class , on the plan of the cemetery in the custody of the Trustees, which lot is to be held for the purposes of burial only, and subject to the rules for the management of the cemetery."

7. In all cases of intended interment the person having the management or control of it shall apply to the Treasurer for a warrant for such interment, which will be issued on payment of the following fees:—

8. Orders for interment must be given to the sexton at least twenty-four hours before the hour fixed for the funeral, otherwise an extra charge of 5s. will be made.

9. No one but the person authorized by the Trustees will be permitted to dig graves in the cemetery, and then only on receipt of the warrant referred to in rule 7.

10. Funerals will be allowed only between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

11. The sexton will prevent the entrance into the cemetery of any horse, cattle, sheep, or swine, and

turn out or impound any that may be found trespassing therein.

12. The Treasurer shall keep a record of all burials, which shall be open for inspection on paying a fee of 1s. 6d. for each inspection. A copy of the register shall be 1s.

13. The Trustees reserve the right of altering or amending the preceding charges and regulations.

Alterations and Additions to the Rates for the Conveyance, Delivery, and Storage of Goods, Parcels, &c., on the New Zealand Railways.

GENERAL REGULATIONS.

Class E.—Agricultural Produce.

MINIMUM quantity 2 tons; any less quantity will be charged as such minimum or as Class D.

At all stations except at Auckland, Onehunga, Spit, Wellington, Foxton, Wanganui, Waitara, Grey-mouth, Westport, Nelson Port, Picton, Blenheim, Lyttelton, Christchurch, Timaru, Oamaru, Port Chalmers, Dunedin, Invercargill, and the Bluff, the load-ing and unloading into and from the trucks may be done by the owners. When so done, or when loaded into the shed owing to trucks not being available after reasonable notice is given, the classified rates only will be charged. When loading or unloading is only will be charged. When loading or unloading is done by the Railway Department at stations, 6d. per ton in addition to the classified rates will be charged for each operation.

At all private stores and sidings the loading or unloading shall be done by the owners. Class E, ex ship, will be charged as class D.
