HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

IN exercise of the powers vested in me by "The Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1881," I, Arthur Hamilton Gordon, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, do hereby abolish the Aparima, Hokanui, Kaiwera, Lake, Lammerlaw, Oware, Tapanui, Tutarau, Vincent, Waikouaiti, Wallace, West Oreti, and Wyndham Rabbit Districts, and do hereby constitute and declare the part of the colony named in the Schedule hereto, and comprised within the counties as defined by "The Counties Act, 1876," to be rabbit districts under the said "Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1881," by the names set forth in the said Schedule.
