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Boundaries of Road Districts in Middle Island defined under "The Road Boards Act, 1882."

Colonial Secretary's Office,
Wellington, 30th April, 1883.

IN pursuance of the provisions of subsection 9 of section 3 of "The Road Boards Act, 1882," I hereby define the boundaries of all road districts in existence in the Middle Island of New Zealand on the coming into operation of the said Act, and of the subdivisions of such road districts at the date hereof, as follows.

THOMAS DICK.

MIDDLE ISLAND.
MARLBOROUGH COUNTY.
Awatere Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North-east by the ocean, from Cape Campbell to the mouth of the Awatere River; thence towards the North and North-west by the Awatere River aforesaid to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 30, Clifford Bay Survey District; thence again towards the North-east by a right line across the Awatere River aforesaid to and thence by Section No. 30 aforesaid; thence again towards the North-west by a road fronting Section No. 31, aforesaid survey district; thence again towards the North-east generally by a road, and Sections Nos. 29, 28, and 4 of Block I., 6 of Block II., 15 of Block II., and 14 of Block II., Clifford Bay Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the North-west by Section No. 14 of Block II. aforesaid, and Section No. 27 to the Maxwell Pass Stream; thence again towards the North-east by that stream to the watershed; thence to and by a tributary of the Taylor River to the Taylor River, at the base of the hill called the Maori; thence again towards the North-west generally by the western side of the Taylor Pass Road to the confluence of the Taylor Pass Creek with the Taylor River aforesaid, and by that river to a place near to the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 44 of Block I., Taylor Pass Survey District; thence by a line to the saddle and by the summit of the dividing range between the Wairau and the Awatere Valleys to Barefell Pass; thence by the Guide River and the Acheron River to the confluence of the latter with the Clarence River; thence towards the South-east by the boundary-line between

the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson to the Clarence River aforesaid; thence again towards the South-east and towards the South-west by that river to the ocean; and thence again towards the South-east by the ocean to Cape Campbell aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Flaxbourne Subdivision.

Bounded towards the West, South-west, and South-east by the Clarence River, from its mouth to its confluence with Elliott River; thence towards the West and North-west by Elliott River aforesaid and the summit of the eastern watershed of the Awatere Valley to Blue Mountain; thence by the south-western boundary-line of Richmond Brook Run, as leased by the Crown, to the south-western corner of Section No. 74, Richmond Brook Run, Blue Mountain Survey District; thence down a tributary and up another tributary of the Medway River to the saddle between Monument Hill and Mount Peggie; thence by the Flaxbourne River and a tributary of that river to the saddle at the head of Upton Brook; thence by the summit of the dividing range to the Blind River, and by that river to the ocean; and thence towards the North-east and South-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Clarence River, the place of commencement.

Lower Awatere Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-east by the Flaxbourne Subdivision, hereinbefore described, from the source of the Hodder River to the mouth of the Blind River; thence towards the East by the ocean to the mouth of the Awatere River; thence towards the North and North-west by the Omaka and the Wairau Road Districts respectively, hereinafter described, to the head of Penk River; and thence towards the South-west generally by that river, the Awatere River, and the Hodder River to its source, the place of commencement.

Upper Awatere Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson; thence towards the South-east by the Clarence River to the Elliott River; thence again towards the South-east and towards the North-east by the Flaxbourne and the Lower Awatere Subdivisions respectively, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the North and North-west by the Wairau Road District, hereinafter described, to Barefell Pass; thence by the Guide River to its confluence with the Acheron River, and by the Acheron River aforesaid to the place of commencement.

Wairau Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North and East by the Onamalutu Creek, from the Wairau River to the south-west corner of Section No. 106, Onamalutu Survey District; thence towards the North-east by Section No. 106 aforesaid and Section No. 107, aforesaid survey district; thence by a right line to the nearest point on the summit of the watershed between the Onamalutu and the Kaituna Valleys; thence by that watershed to the summit of the dividing range between the Pelorus and Wairau Valleys; thence again towards the North by that summit to the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson; thence towards the North-west and South-west by that boundary-line to Barefell Pass; thence towards the South-east by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described, to the Taylor River, at the base of the hill called the Maori; thence towards the North-east and East by the Omaka Road District, hereinafter described, and the Borough of Blenheim to the north-eastern corner of Section No. part 2 of 8, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence again towards the North by Sections Nos. 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, and 19, aforesaid survey district, and the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 89, Cloudy Bay Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the East by the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 89 aforesaid to the north-eastern corner of that section; thence again towards the North by the northern boundary-line of said Section No. 89, by that boundary-line produced across the Omaka River, and by the northern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 91 and 131, Cloudy Bay Survey District aforesaid, to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 157, Onamalutu Survey District; thence again towards the East by that boundary-line and its production to the north-east corner of Section No. 35, Block L, Onamalutu Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the North-east by a right line to the mouth of the Onamalutu Creek, the place of commencement.

Wairau Valley Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-west, North-west, North, and North-east by the south-western, north-western, northern, and north-eastern boundary-lines of the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, from Barefell Pass to the confluence of the Onamalutu Creek with the Wairau River; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the Wairau Road District aforesaid to the south bank of the said Wairau River; thence towards the South and South-east by the south bank of that river to the confluence of the Waihopai and the Wairau Rivers; thence by the said Waihopai River to its source; thence again towards the North and towards the East by the summit of the dividing range between the Waihopai and Acheron Valleys; and thence towards the South-east by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described, to Barefell Pass, the place of commencement.

Waihopai Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North-west and North by the Wairau River, from its confluence with the Waihopai River to the north-eastern boundary-line of the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the East and again towards the North by the eastern and northern boundary-lines of the Wairau Road District aforesaid to the Fairhall River; thence towards the South-east generally by that river to its source; thence by a leading spur to the dividing range between the Wairau and the Awatere Valleys; thence by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the South-west by the Wairau Valley Subdivision, hereinbefore described, to the source of the Waihopai River; and thence towards the North-west by the said Waihopai River to the Wairau River, the place of commencement.

Fairhall Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North, East, and North-east by the northern, eastern, and north-eastern boundary-lines of the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, from the Fairhall River to the confluence of a branch of the Taylor River with the Taylor River, at the base of the hill called the Maori; thence towards the South-east and South by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the North-west by the Waihopai Subdivision, hereinbefore described, to the source of the Fairhall River aforesaid; and thence by that river to the northern boundary-line of the Wairau Road District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Spring Creek Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North-west, North, and North-east by the Wairau River, from its confluence with the Opawa River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 32, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence towards the South-east by a road fronting the said Section No. 32 and Sections Nos. 31 and 30, said survey district, to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the South-west by a road between Sections Nos. 30 and 29, Cloudy Bay Survey District aforesaid, to the northern corner of the latter section; thence

again towards the South-east by the north-western boundary-line of said Section No. 29 to Section No. 33; thence by the boundary-line between Sections Nos. 33 and 29 aforesaid to the Opawa River aforesaid; thence again towards the South-west and towards the South-east by a line along the middle of that river to the western corner of Section No. 37, aforesaid survey district; thence by a line along the middle of the new channel of the Opawa River aforesaid to the south-western corner of Section No. 85, aforesaid survey district; thence towards the South by a line along the middle of the old channel of the Opawa River aforesaid to the Wairau River, the place of commencement.

Omaka Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North, North-east, and North-west by the Spring Creek Road District, hereinbefore described, from the confluence of the Wairau and the Opawa Rivers to the easternmost corner of Section No. 32, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence by a right line across the said Wairau River in continuation of the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 32 aforesaid; thence again towards the North-east by the north bank of the last-mentioned river to its mouth; thence by the ocean to the mouth of the Awatere River; thence towards the South-east and South-west by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of a tributary of the Taylor River with the Taylor River, at the base of the hill called the Maori; thence again towards the South-west and towards the West by the eastern side of the Taylor Pass Road to its junction with the road between Sections Nos. 28 and 48, Taylor Pass Survey District; thence again towards the North by Section No. part 4 of 28; thence again towards the West by a road fronting the last-mentioned section, and Sections Nos. part 1 of 28 and part 3 of 28, aforesaid survey district; thence across a road and by Sections Nos. part 1 of 8 and part 2 of 8 to the north-eastern corner of the latter section; thence towards the South and West generally by the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of the Wairau and the Opawa Rivers, the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Borough of Blenheim.

Renwick Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North and North-east by the Spring Creek Road District, hereinbefore described, from the confluence of the Wairau and the Opawa Rivers to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 50, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence towards the South, East, and South-east by the Borough of Blenheim to the north-western corner of Section No. 6, aforesaid survey district; thence towards the South and West generally by the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of the Wairau and the Opawa Rivers, the place of commencement.

Opawa Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North-west by the Spring Creek Road District, hereinbefore described, from the Borough of Blenheim to the easternmost corner of Section No. 32, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence by a right line across the Wairau River, in continuation of the south-eastern boundary-line of that section; thence towards the North-east by the north bank of the said Wairau River to its mouth; thence by the ocean to the mouth of the Awatere River; thence towards the South-east and South-west by the Awatere Road District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of a tributary of the Taylor River with the Taylor River, at the base of the hill called the Maori; thence again towards the South-west and towards the West by the eastern side of the Taylor Pass Road to its junction with the road between Sections Nos. 28 and 48, Taylor Pass Survey District; thence towards the North by Section No. part 4 of 28; thence again towards the West by a road fronting the last-mentioned section and Section Nos. part 1 of 28 and part 3 of 28, aforesaid survey district; and thence towards the North and West generally by the Borough of Blenheim aforesaid to the place of commencement.

Picton Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the South-west and South by the north bank of the Wairau River, from its mouth to the Waikakaho Stream; thence towards the South-west by the said Waikakaho Stream to its source; thence towards the North-west by the summit of the dividing range between the Kaituna and Mahakipawa and Waitohi Valleys to a line bearing N. 60° W. to the deep-water landing-place at the Grove; thence towards the South-west by that line; thence towards the North generally by the waters of Queen Charlotte Sound to Karaka Point; thence towards the East and South-east by the eastern boundary-lines of the Waikawa Native Reserve to the summit of the watershed between Queen Charlotte Sound and Port Underwood and Cloudy Bay, and by that summit to a line bearing S. 45° E. to the southernmost point of White's Bay; thence towards the North-east by that line to the southernmost point of White's Bay aforesaid; thence again towards the East and North-east by Cloudy Bay to the mouth of the Wairau River,

the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Borough of Picton.

Cloudy Bay Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-west by the Wairau River, from its mouth to the Tuamarina River; thence towards the West by the said Tuamarina River to Massacre Hill; thence towards the North-west by the spur leading to the watershed; thence by the summit of the watershed between the Waitohi Valley and Cloudy Bay to a line bearing S. 45° E. to the southernmost point of White's Bay; thence towards the North-east by that line to the last-named point at White's Bay aforesaid; thence towards the East and North-east by Cloudy Bay to the mouth of the Wairau River, the place of commencement.

Tuamarina Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South by the Wairau River, from the mouth of the Tuamarina River to the mouth of the Waikakaho Stream; thence towards the South-west by the said Waikakaho Stream to its source; thence towards the North-west by the summit of the dividing range between the Kaituna, Mahakipawa, and Waitohi Valleys to a line bearing N. 60° W. to the deep-water landing-place at the Grove; thence towards the South-west by that line to the waters of Queen Charlotte Sound; thence towards the North generally by the waters of that sound to Karaka Point; thence towards the East and South-east by the eastern boundary-lines of the Waikawa Native Reserve to the summit of the watershed between Queen Charlotte Sound and Port Underwood and Cloudy Bay, and by that summit to a line bearing S. 45° E. to the southernmost point of White's Bay; thence again towards the South-east and East by the Cloudy Bay Subdivision, hereinbefore described, to the mouth of the Tuamarina River, the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Borough of Picton.

Pelorus Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North-east, South-east, and again towards the North-east by the Picton Road District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Waikakaho Stream to the deep-water landing-place at the Grove; thence towards the North-west, North-east, and South by the waters of Queen Charlotte Sound to the boundary of a block of land granted to Joseph Toms, 1870 links from a stream called Te Awa; thence towards the East by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 21, Linkwater Survey District, Pelorus Sound; thence by the waters of Pelorus Sound to Waitanihi or Black Point; thence again towards the North-east by the summit of the leading spur from Waitanihi or Black Point aforesaid to Mount Elliott; thence towards the North-west generally by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson to the summit of the range between the Pelorus and Wairau Valleys; thence towards the South-east and South-west by the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, to the Wairau River; thence again towards the South-east by the said Wairau River to the Picton Road District aforesaid, the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Town of Havelock, as described in "The Picton and Havelock Improvement Act, 1872."

North Bank of Wairau Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-east by the Wairau River, from the Waikakaho Stream to the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the South-west by the Wairau Road District aforesaid to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 55, Onamalutu Survey District; thence towards the North-west by a right line to and by that boundary-line and its production to the Waikakaho Stream aforesaid; and thence towards the North-east by that stream to the Wairau River, the place of commencement.

Kaituna Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-east by the North Bank of Wairau Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the East and South-east by the Picton Road District, hereinbefore described, to the leading spur to Cullen's Point, between the Kaituna and Mahakipawa Valleys; thence towards the North and North-east by the summit of that spur to Cullen's Point aforesaid; thence towards the West and North by the waters of Pelorus Sound to the Town of Havelock, as described in "The Picton and Havelock Improvement Act, 1872;" thence by that town to the watershed between the Pelorus and Kaituna Valleys; thence towards the North-west and West by the summit of the dividing range between the Kaituna and the Pelorus Valleys to the Wairau Road District hereinbefore described; and thence towards the South-west by the Wairau Road District aforesaid to the North Bank of Wairau Subdivision aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Pelorus Valley Subdivision.

Bounded towards the East by the Kaituna Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the South-east by the Wairau Road District, hereinbefore described, to the boundary-line

between the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson; thence towards the West and North-west by that boundary-line to Mount Elliott; thence towards the North-east by the leading spur from Mount Elliott to Waitanihi or Black Point; and thence towards the South-east and North-east generally by the waters of Pelorus Sound and the Town of Havelock, as described in "The Picton and Havelock Improvement Act, 1872;" to the Kaituna Subdivision, the place of commencement.

Mahakipawa Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-west by the Kaituna Subdivision hereinbefore described; thence towards the South-east and North-east by the Picton Road District, hereinbefore described, to the deep-water landing-place at the Grove; thence towards the North-west, South-east, and South by the waters of Queen Charlotte Sound to the boundary of a block of land granted to Joseph Toms, 1870 links from a stream called Te Awa; thence towards the East by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 21, Linkwater Survey District; thence towards the North and South generally by the waters of Pelorus Sound to the Kaituna Subdivision aforesaid, the place of commencement at Cullen's Point.

KAIKOURA COUNTY.

Kaikoura Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Marlborough, bounded towards the North-east, North, and North-west by the Clarence River, from its mouth to a point due west from Mount Ross; thence towards the South by a right line to that point; thence towards the West, South-west, and South respectively by a right line to the source of the Conway River, and by that river to its mouth; and thence towards the South-east generally by the ocean to the mouth of the Clarence River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Town of Kaikoura Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-east, North, and North-east by the ocean and the Lyell Creek, from a point in line with the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 225, Mount Fyffe Survey District, to a point on Lyell Creek aforesaid in line with the southern boundary-line of Section No. 263, said survey district; thence towards the North by a right line to Section No. 206, said survey district; thence towards the West, South-west, and South-east respectively by Sections Nos. 206, 207, 208, 209, and 210, a road, Sections Nos. 264 and 268, another road, Sections Nos. 269, 270, 2 of 271, 1 of 271, 272, and 273, another road, Section No. 274, another road, and Section No. 225 aforesaid, all of the survey district aforesaid, and the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the ocean, the place of commencement.

Kaikoura Suburban Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North-east, South-east, and again towards the North-east respectively by the ocean, the Town of Kaikoura Subdivision, hereinbefore described, and the Hapuka River, from the easternmost promontory of the Kaikoura Peninsula to a point in line with the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 226, Mount Fyffe Survey District; thence towards the North-west by a road fronting said Section No. 226, Sections Nos. 1 of 190, 3 of 189, 2 of 189, 2 of 188, 187, 186, 185, 184, and 182 to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the South-west by a road fronting Section No. 182 aforesaid and Section No. 181; thence again towards the North-east by a road fronting Section No. 179 to the easternmost corner of Section No. 292; thence by the south-western and north-western boundary-lines of Section No. 38 to Section No. 47; thence by the western boundary-line of that section and that line produced to a road being the continuation of the road between Section No. 2 of 29 and Section No. 30, Mount Fyffe Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the North-west by that road to the Waimanarara River; thence across the said Waimanarara River; and again towards the North-east by that river to the north-eastern corner of Native Reserve B; thence again towards the North-west by a right line to the north-western corner of Native Reserve C; thence across a road; thence by the north-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 306 and 312, across a road, and by the north-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 313 and 327, across another road, and by the north-western boundary-lines of Section No. 328, aforesaid survey district, to its westernmost corner; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 331; thence due west across a road fronting that section; thence towards the South-west by the western side of that road to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 61, Greenburn Survey District; thence again towards the North-west by that section and by Sections Nos. 60, 56, 55, and 54, said Greenburn Survey District, and the south-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the Kohai River; thence again towards the South-west by the left bank of that river to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 57, Mount Fyffe Survey District aforesaid; and by a right line thence to the

northern side of a road forming the north-western boundary of Section No. 235, Mount Fyffe Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the North-west by that road to the northernmost corner of Section No. 236, Mount Fyffe Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the North-west by the north-western boundary-line of said Section No. 236 and by the north-western and south-western boundary-lines of Section No. 252, said Mount Fyffe Survey District, to its south-westernmost corner; thence again towards the South-west and North-west by Sections Nos. 97, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, and 109, Greenburn Survey District aforesaid, to the Kahautara River; thence towards the South by that river to the ocean; and thence again towards the South-east and South-west by the ocean to the place of commencement.

Kaikoura Rural Subdivision.

Bounded towards the South-east by the ocean, from the Conway River to the Kahautara River; thence by that river to the Kaikoura Suburban Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence again towards the South-east and towards the South generally by the Kaikoura Suburban Subdivision aforesaid to the Hapuka River; thence by the said Hapuka River; thence again towards the South-east by the ocean to the Clarence River; thence towards the North-east, North, and North-west by the said Clarence River to a point due west from Mount Ross; thence towards the South by a right line to the said Mount Ross; thence towards the West, South-west, and South respectively by a right line to the source of the Conway River; and by that river to its mouth, the place of commencement.

WAIMEA COUNTY.

Pokororo Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Nelson, bounded towards the North by a right line due west from the northern corner of Section No. 62 of Square No. 9, Motueka Survey District, to Collingwood County; thence towards the North-east by the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 62 aforesaid, and the north-eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 56, 57, 22, and 4 of 62 of Square No. 9 aforesaid, Motueka Survey District; thence across a road to the Motueka River; thence generally towards the South-east by a line along the middle of that river to Graham River; thence towards the South-west by that river to its source; thence by a right line to Trig. Station L; thence by a right line between the said Trig. Station L and Trig. Station MP, Mount Arthur Survey District, as far as Collingwood County aforesaid; and thence towards the North-west by that county to the place of commencement.

Pangatotara Road District.

Bounded towards the North-west by the Makarewa River; thence towards the North by a right line due east from the northern boundary-line of Section No. 190, Forest Hill Hundred, 17400 links; thence towards the West by a right line due north, 2000 links; thence towards the North-west by a right line bearing 45° to the eastern boundary-line of Forest Hill Hundred; thence towards the East by the Waimumu Hundred and its western boundary-line produced to the main road between Dunedin and Invercargill; thence towards the South-east by the Oteramika Road District, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the South-west by the Myross Subdivision, hereinbefore described, to the Makarewa River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Waikaka Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north, west; and again towards the north by the Otama and the Chatton Subdivisions, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by Clutha County and

Blocks III. and VI., Waikaka Survey District; thence towards the south by the Pukerau Stream and the Town District of Gordon to the Mataura River; and thence towards the west by that river to the place of commencement.

Tuturau Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the north-east by the Otakaramu Stream and its northern branch to its source; thence by the northern boundary-line of the Waiariki Hundred to its eastern boundary-line; thence towards the east by the eastern boundary-line of the Waiariki Hundred aforesaid to its southern boundary-line; thence towards the south by a right line due west to the Waiariki Stream; thence again towards the east by that stream to its confluence with the Mimihau Stream; thence towards the south and south-east by the latter stream to the Mataura River; and thence towards the south-west and north-west by that river to the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Town District of Mataura.

Waikana Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north-east by the Otakaramu Stream and its northern branch to its source; thence by the northern boundary-line of the Waiariki Hundred to its eastern boundary-line; thence towards the east by the eastern boundary-line of the Waiariki Hundred aforesaid; thence towards the south by a right line due west to the Waiariki Stream; thence by that stream and a tributary thereof forming the northern boundary of section No. 66, Block VI., Tuturau Survey District; thence by the southern boundaries of sections Nos. 71, 89, 93, 60, 90, 59, and 94, Block VI. aforesaid, and sections Nos. 21, 19, and 18, Block III., Tuturau Survey District aforesaid; thence towards the west by sections Nos. 32, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11, Block III. aforesaid, and the Town District of Mataura to the Mataura River; and thence towards the north-west by that river to the place of commencement.

Marairua Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Town District of Mataura; thence towards the east and again towards the north by the Waikana Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by Blocks VI. and VII., Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the south and south-east by the Mimihau Stream; and thence towards the west by the Mataura River to the place of commencement.

Waiariki Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Waikana Subdivision hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by the Waiariki Stream; thence towards the south by the Mimihau Stream; and thence towards the west by the Marairua Subdivision, hereinbefore described, to the place of commencement.

Otaraia Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the north by the Town District of Gordon and the Knapdale Road District, hereinbefore described, from the Mataura River to Block VI., Waikaka Survey District; thence towards the west by the Knapdale Road District aforesaid; thence again towards the north by Clutha County; thence towards the east, north-east, and again towards the east by Clutha County aforesaid to a point due east from the south-eastern corner of the Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line due west to the north-eastern corner of the Wyndham Survey District; thence towards the west by a right line due north to the Mimihau Stream; thence towards the south-west by that stream to the Tuturau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence again towards the west and north and again towards the west and south-west by the Tuturau Road District aforesaid to the Mataura River; and thence towards the north-west by that river to the place of commencement.

Pukerau Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Town District of Gordon and the Knapdale Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the west by the Knapdale Road District aforesaid; thence again towards the north by Clutha County; thence towards the east by Clutha County aforesaid; thence towards the south by Blocks IX., XII., and XIII., Waikaka Survey District; and thence towards the west by the Mataura River to the place of commencement.

Otaraia Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Pukerau Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east and north-east by Clutha County to the confluence of the Kaiwera Stream with the Waipahee River; thence towards the south-east and again towards the north-east by the Kaiwera Stream aforesaid to section No. 16, Block II., Slopdown Survey District; thence by that section and section No. 15, Block II. aforesaid; thence towards the east by Block VI., Slopdown Survey District

aforesaid, to a point due east from the south-eastern corner of the Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line due west to the north-eastern corner of the Wyndham Survey District; thence towards the west by a right line due north to the Mimihau Stream; thence towards the south-west by that stream to the Tuturau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence again towards the west and north and again towards the west and south-west by the Tuturau Road District aforesaid to the Mataura River; and thence towards the north-west by that river to the place of commencement.

Kaiwera Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north east and east by Clutha County to a point due east from the south-eastern corner of the Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line due west to the Otaraia Subdivision, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the west, south-west, and north-west by the Otaraia Subdivision aforesaid to the place of commencement.

Wyndham Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the north-west by the Tuturau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the north-east by the Otaraia Road District, hereinbefore described, to a point due north from Trig. Station T, Wyndham Survey District; thence towards the east by a right line due south through Trig. Station T aforesaid to the Wyndham River; thence towards the south-west by that river and the south-western boundary-line of section No. 15, Block IV., Wyndham Survey District aforesaid, to the Mataura River; and thence towards the west by that river to the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Town District of Wyndham.

Oware Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north-west by the Tuturau Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the north-east by the Otaraia Road District, hereinbefore described, to a point due north from Trig. Station T, Wyndham Survey District; thence towards the east by a right line due south to a point due east from the north-eastern corner of section No. 15, Block III., Wyndham Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line to that corner; thence by sections Nos. 15 aforesaid and 6, Block III. aforesaid, sections Nos. 9 and 5, Block II., Wyndham Survey District aforesaid; thence towards the east by sections Nos. 5 aforesaid and 46, the main centre road, and sections Nos. 44 and 45 to a point due east from the north-western corner of section No. 34; thence again towards the south by a right line to that corner; thence by section No. 34 aforesaid and the Redan Road to the Oware Creek; thence by that creek to the Wyndham River; thence towards the south-east and south-west by that river and the south-western boundary-line of section No. 15, Block IV., Wyndham Survey District aforesaid, to the Mataura River; and thence towards the south-west by the Mataura River aforesaid to the Town District of Wyndham; and thence by the Town District of Wyndham aforesaid to the place of commencement.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the north-east by the Wyndham Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by the Mokoreta Survey District; thence towards the south by the Mokoreta Survey District aforesaid and the Toetoes Survey District; and thence towards the north-west by the Mataura River to the place of commencement.

Don Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north-east by the Wyndham Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by the Mokoreta Survey District; thence towards the south by Blocks XI., X., and IX., Wyndham Survey District, and a road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 13, Block VIII., Wyndham Survey District aforesaid, to the Mataura River; and thence towards the north-west by that river to the place of commencement.

Kuriwao Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Don Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by the Mokoreta Survey District; thence towards the south by the Mokoreta Survey District aforesaid and the Toetoes Survey District to the Mataura River; and thence towards the north-west by that river to the place of commencement.

Toetoes Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the north by the South Wyndham Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east and south-east by the Mokoreta and the Otara Survey Districts; thence towards the south-west and south by the ocean and Toetoes Harbour; and thence towards the west by the Mataura River.

Titiroa Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the South Wyndham Road District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east by the Mokoreta Survey District; thence towards the south by Blocks VI. and V., Toetoes Survey District, to the intersection of the northern boundary-line of the latter block with the Waimahaka Stream in section No. 13; thence by that stream to the Titiroa Stream; thence again towards the east by the latter stream, Toetoes Harbour, and the Mataura River; and thence towards the west by the Mataura River aforesaid to the place of commencement.

Tokanui Subdivision.

Bounded towards the north by the Titiroa Subdivision, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east and south-east by the Mokoreta and the Otara Survey Districts; thence towards the south-west by the ocean; and thence towards the south-west and west by Toetoes Harbour and the Titiroa Subdivision aforesaid to the place of commencement.

Aparima Road District.

All that area in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the North by the Wairio and the Taringatura Survey Districts; thence towards the East by Southland County; thence towards the South-west and North-west by the ocean, the Jacob's River Estuary, and the Pourapourakina River to the north-western corner of Block III., Jacob's River Hundred; thence towards the South by a right line due west to the Longwood Survey District; and thence towards the West by that survey district and the Waiiau Survey District to the

place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Borough of Riverton and the Town District of Otautau.

Heddon Bush Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North by the Taringatura Survey District; thence towards the East by Southland County; thence towards the South and South-west by that county and the Waimatuku Subdivision, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the North-west by Jacob's River to the place of commencement.

Mount Pleasant Subdivision.

Bounded towards the North by the Wairio Survey District; thence towards the South-east and North-east by the Heddon Bush and the Waimatuku Subdivisions, hereinbefore described; thence towards the South by the Jacob's River Subdivision, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the West by the Longwood and the Waiiau Survey Districts to the place of commencement: excepting from the above-described area the Town District of Otautau.

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
