ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings, at Wellington, this seventeenth day of May, 1883.

Present:

THE HONOURABLE THE PREMIER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the valuation rolls prepared by the Property-Tax Commissioner under "The Rating Act, 1882," were not furnished to certain Road Boards in sufficient time to prepare therefrom the ratepayers' roll as required by section forty-one of "The Road Boards Act, 1882," and the elections of members of the Boards for certain road districts have not consequently been held during the first week of the present month of May, as required by the said "Road Boards Act, 1882," and it is expedient to extend the time for holding such elections in such road districts:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, and in exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in him by "The Road Boards Act, 1882," doth hereby order and declare that the time for holding the general elections of members of Road Boards under the said last-mentioned Act is hereby extended in all districts where there has been a failure to hold such elections, and that such elections may take place during the month of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three.

SPECIAL ORDER.

SPECIAL order passed by the Featherston Road Board on the 26th May, 1883:—

That all that portion of the Featherston Road District situated within the under-mentioned boundaries be constituted No. 8 or Pabaua Subdivision thereof, and return one member of the Featherston Road Board, viz.: Bounded on the North by the Taratahi-Carterton Road District; on the East by the Pacific Ocean; on the South by the Pabaua River, from its mouth upwards to its junction with the Kaikaikuri Stream, and thence by a direct line to the south-western angle of Section No. 96 of the Ahiarui Block, Huangarua Survey District; and on the West by the Wangaeahu Stream upwards to the boundary of the Taratahi-Carterton Road District aforesaid.

SPECIAL ORDER.

PASSED by the Taratahi-Carterton Road Board, the 19th day of May, 1883:—

That that portion of the Taratahi-Carterton Road District situate within the under-mentioned boundaries be constituted No. 8 Subdivision of the said district, and return two members of the Taratahi-Carterton Road Board, viz.: Bounded on the North by the Masterton Road District; on the East by the Pacific Ocean; on the South by the Featherston Road District; and on the West by the Ruamahanga River, from the confluence of the Pohaturiki Stream therewith upwards to the junction of the Taueru River with the Ruamahanga River; and thence up the Taueru River to the boundary of the Masterton Road District aforesaid.

That Sections 14, 15, 17, 18 of the Taueru Survey Block, situate near the confluence of the Taueru and Ruamahanga Rivers, be added to the existing No. 1 Subdivision of the Taratahi-Carterton Road District.

THE following special orders, made by the Wallace County Council under "The Roads and Bridges Construction Act, 1882," are published for general information.

THOMAS DICK.

SPECIAL ORDERS.

1. THAT the district as herein defined be a district to be rated to repay the cost of construction of the road commencing at eastern boundary of county, and extending in a westerly direction through Section 48, and north of Sections 135, 133, 132, 131, 130, through Section 41, north of 75, and through Section 79 and part of Section 4, all of Oreti Hundred; thence south-west through Section 4 to county road, viz.: That portion of the Oreti Hundred bounded on the South by county road, commencing at Jacob's River, and extending in an easterly direction through Section 4, south of Section 78, through Sections 79, 45, 41, 61, 47, 42, and south of Section 50; on the East by eastern

boundary of Sections 50, 49, 48, 136, 144, 145; on the North by north boundary of Section 145, and road-line north of Sections 142, 141, 32, and said road-line extended south of Sections 23, 24, and through Section 4, all of Oreti Hundred, to Jacob's River; on the West by Jacob's River to commencing point.

2. That the district as herein defined be a district to be rated to repay the cost of construction of road east of Heddon Bush, and extending to the county road, viz.: That portion of the Wallace County commencing at Jacob's River, and bounded on the South by road-line through Section 4, south of Sections 24, 23, through Section 79, and south of Section 146; again on East by part of Section 146; again on South by south boundary of Section 147; again on West by western boundary of Section 62 to Section 48; again on South by north boundary of said Section 48 and county boundary to Winton Road; on the East by county boundary to road north of Oreti Hundred, then by road east of Section 118, Taringatura, to a point opposite north-west corner of Section 207, Taringatura; on the North by a line extending in a direct line to road-line north of Section 3, Taringatura District, and by said road-line extended through Section 15, Taringatura District, to Jacob's River; on the West by Jacob's River to commencing point.

3. That the following sums be apportioned to the following roads, viz.: £600 for purchasing road from Mr. F. Sutton and completing road from bridge to county road, £300 for making

road to Wild Bush, £200 for making road from Upper Ford Bridge to Groper's Bush; and that the district as herein defined be a district to be rated to repay the sums to be advanced, viz.: That portion of Jacob's River Hundred bounded on the West by western boundary of Blocks III., V., and XIII. of said hundred; on the North by northern boundary of said Block XIII.; then on the East by east boundary of said Block XIII. to corner of Section 5 of said block; again on the North by north boundary of Sections 5 and 6, Block XIII.; again on the West by western boundary of Sections 32 and 30, Block VIII., of said hundred; on North-east by county road from Groper's Bush to south-east corner of Section 24, Block IX., of said hundred; then on the East by Jacob's River to south-east boundary of Section 48, Block IV.; on the South by south boundary of Sections 48, 40, 26, and 56, Block IV.; again on the East by county road to Jacob's River, and by Jacob's River to the estuary; again on the South by estuary of Jacob's River to commencing point.
