NATIVE LAND COURT, NEW ZEALAND, DISTRICT OF GISBORNE.

IN the matter of a judgment of the Court given at Waipawa, in the said district, on the 2nd day of October, 1883, upon the hearing of a claim to succeed to the interest of Mata Whataunga in a block of land situate in the said district, and known as "Te Whiti"; and in the matter of the application of Emiri Tiweta for a rehearing upon such claim:

I, John Edwin Macdonald, Chief Judge of the said Court, and in exercise of the authority in that behalf vested in me, do hereby dismiss such application.
