A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and in exercise of all powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf, I, William Francis Drummond Jervois, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim that the road described in the Schedule hereto has been duly taken and laid off through the land specified in a warrant of the date given in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

ALL those parcels of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 14 acres 3 roods 18 perches and 4 acres and 33 perches respectively, more or less, situated in the Patetere North Survey District, and being road-lines, each 100 links wide, traversing the Mangapouri No. 2A Block, No. 4089:—

Road containing 14 acres 3 roods 18 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 50 chains or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 14860 links or thereabouts to a point on the eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 12 chains or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle.

Road containing 4 acres and 33 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road hereinbefore defined at a distance of 5080 links or thereabouts from the northern boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly generally for a distance of 4210 links or thereabouts to the Oraka Stream at a point distant 104 chains or thereabouts from the south-eastern angle of the aforesaid block.

Be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same are delineated on Plan No. 3662D, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

Date of Governor's warrant, 5th June, 1883.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 38 perches, more or less, situated in the Patetere North Survey District, and being a road-line, 100 links wide, traversing the Mangapouri No. 2C Block, No. 4089; commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 5210 links or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle,

being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly for a distance of 1240 links or thereabouts to the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a point on the same 50 chains or thereabouts distant from its south-eastern angle: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on Plan No. 3662D, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

Date of Governor's warrant, 5th June, 1883.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 1 acre 2 roods 25 perches, more or less, situated in the Patetere North Survey District, and being a road-line, 100 links wide, traversing the Mangapouri No. 2B Block, No. 4089; commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 4 chains or thereabouts from its north-western angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing southerly generally for a distance of 1666 links or thereabouts to the southern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 5210 links or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on Plan No. 3662D, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

Date of Governor's warrant, 5th June, 1883.

All those parcels of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 8 acres 3 roods 4 perches, 24 acres 2 roods 20 perches, 7 acres 2 roods 22 perches, 9 acres and 8 perches, and 2 acres and 3 perches respectively, more or less, situated in the Mangapouri No. 1 Block, No. 4089, in the Patetere North Survey District, and being road-lines, each 100 links wide, traversing the aforesaid block:—

Road containing 8 acres 3 roods 4 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 1850 links or thereabouts from its north-western angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing southerly generally for a distance of 8780 links or thereabouts to a point on the northern boundary of the Mangapouri No. 2B Block at a distance of 4 chains or thereabouts from the Oraka Stream.

Road containing 24 acres 2 roods 20 perches: Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the Mangapouri No. 2A Block, No. 4089, at a distance of 1112 links or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 24564 links or thereabouts to the southern boundary of the aforesaid block at a point 104 chains or thereabouts distant from its south-western angle.

Road containing 7 acres 2 roods 22 perches: Commencing at a point on the north-eastern side of the road last hereinbefore described at a distance of 85 chains or thereabouts from its north-western extremity, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-easterly generally for a distance of 7640 links or thereabouts to the Waihou River.

Road containing 9 acres and 8 perches: Commencing at a point on the western side of the road containing 24 acres 2 roods 20 perches opposite to the western termination of the road last hereinbefore described, and being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly generally for a distance of 9050 links or thereabouts to the Oraka Stream.

Road containing 2 acres and 3 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern boundary of the Mangapouri No. 1 Block aforesaid at a distance of 73 chains or thereabouts from the Oraka Stream, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing northerly generally for a distance of 2020 links or thereabouts to the road, containing 24 acres 2 roods 20 perches hereinbefore described.

Be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same are delineated on Plans Nos. 3662D and 3662E, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

Date of Governor's warrant, 5th June, 1883.

All those parcels of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 46 acres, 12 acres 2 roods 25 perches, 12 acres 1 rood 18 perches, 7 acres and 12 perches, 3 acres 2 roods, 3 acres 3 roods 16 perches, 5 acres, 5 acres and 16 perches, 2 acres and 25 perches, 4 acres 1 rood 19 perches, 6 acres 3 roods 30 perches, 7 acres 3 roods 33 perches, 8 acres 2 roods 33 perches, 3 roods 24 perches, 5 acres 1 rood 24 perches, 7 acres 2 roods 19 perches, 2 acres 3 roods 8 perches, 5 acres 3 roods 32 perches, 5 acres and 16 perches, 26 acres and 24 perches, 10 acres 3 roods 32 perches, 10 acres 1 rood, 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches, 1 acre 3 roods 32 perches, 1 acre 1 rood 24 perches, and 8 acres 2 roods 32 perches respectively, more or less, situate in the Patetere North Survey District, and being road-lines, 100 links wide and upwards, traversing the Mangarautawhiri Block, No. 4926:—

Road containing 46 acres, 100 links wide and upwards: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the Mangarautawhiri Block at a distance of 55 chains or thereabouts from its south-western angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly, north-easterly, and northerly generally for a distance of 277 chains or thereabouts to the Oraka Stream at a distance of 68 chains or thereabouts from the north-western angle of the aforesaid block.

Road containing 12 acres 2 roods 25 perches: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the block aforesaid at a distance of 75 links or thereabouts to the northward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway-crossing on the same, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly along the said railway for a distance of 120 chains or thereabouts; thence by a line running at right angles to the same to the north-eastward for a distance of 200 links; and thence by another line running at right angles to the latter line, to the south-eastward, to the road hereinbefore defined.

Road containing 12 acres 1 rood 18 perches: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the Mangarautawhiri Block aforesaid at a distance of 75 links or thereabouts to the southward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway-crossing on the same, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly along the said railway for a distance of 117 chains or thereabouts; thence by a line running at right angles south-westerly for a distance of 200 links; and thence again by a line running at right angles south-easterly to the road first hereinbefore described.

Road containing 7 acres and 12 perches: Commencing at a point on the north-eastern side of the road containing 12 acres 2 roods 25 perches, hereinbefore defined, at a distance of 25 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; thence continuing north-easterly for a distance of 30 chains or thereabouts; and thence south-easterly for a distance of 450 links or thereabouts to another road.

Road containing 3 acres 2 roods: Commencing at a point on the eastern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 96 chains or thereabouts from the Oraka Stream, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly for a distance of 35 chains to the road containing 12 acres 2 roods 25 perches, already defined.

Road containing 3 acres 3 roods 16 perches: Commencing at a point on the south-western side of the road containing 12 acres 1 rood 18 perches already defined, a distance of 68 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly for a distance of

3850 links or thereabouts to a road hereinafter defined, containing 5 acres and 16 perches.

Road containing 5 acres: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the Mangarautawhiri Block aforesaid at a distance of 2250 links from the southern side of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway-crossing, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 5000 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road last hereinbefore defined.

Road containing 5 acres and 16 perches: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 60 chains or thereabouts from the southern side of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway-crossing, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 5099 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road first hereinbefore defined.

Road containing 2 acres and 25 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road first hereinbefore described at a distance of 32 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing southerly for a distance of 2155 links or thereabouts to a road containing 6 acres 3 roods 30 perches, hereinafter defined.

Road containing 4 acres 1 rood 19 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 40 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 4365 links or thereabouts to its junction with another road containing 7 acres 3 roods 33 perches, hereinafter described.

Road containing 6 acres 3 roods 30 perches: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 2650 links or thereabouts from its south-western angle, being the middle of the aforesaid road; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 6945 links or thereabouts to its junction with another road containing 8 acres 2 roods 33 perches, hereinafter defined.

Road containing 7 acres 3 roods 33 perches: Commencing at point on the northern side of a road containing 8 acres 2 roods 33 perches, hereinafter defined, at a distance of 36 chains or thereabouts from the Ngutuwhera Stream, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing northerly generally for a distance of 31 chains; and thence south-easterly generally for a further distance of 3855 links or thereabouts to another road containing 5 acres 1 rood 24 perches, hereinafter defined.

Road containing 8 acres 2 roods 33 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern side of the Ngutuwhera Stream at a distance of 40 chains or thereabouts from the south-western angle of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing easterly generally for a distance of 8710 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road last hereinbefore mentioned to contain 5 acres 1 rood 24 perches.

Road containing 3 roods and 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road containing 6 acres 3 roods 30 perches, hereinbefore defined, at a distance of 1830 links or thereabouts from the western boundary of the Mangarautawhiri Block aforesaid, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing southerly for a distance of 965 links.

Road containing 5 acres 1 rood 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern side of the Ngutuwhera Stream at a distance of 128 chains or thereabouts from the south-western angle of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing northerly generally to the eastern termination of another road, hereinbefore defined, containing 7 acres 3 roods 33 perches.

Road containing 7 acres 2 roods 19 perches, 100 links wide and upwards: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 93 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 58 chains or thereabouts to a road containing 5 acres and 16 perches, hereinafter defined.

Road containing 2 acres 3 roods 8 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 99 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block, being the middle of the road above referred to; thence continuing south-easterly for a distance of 26 chains; and thence south-westerly for a further distance of 2 chains to its junction with the road last hereinbefore described.

Road containing 5 acres 3 roods 32 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 121 chains or thereabouts from the western boundary of the aforesaid block; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 5950 links to another road, hereinafter defined, containing 5 acres and 16 perches.

Road containing 5 acres and 16 perches: Commencing at the eastern termination of the road containing 7 acres 3 roods 33 perches, hereinbefore defined, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-easterly generally for a distance of 51 chains or thereabouts to its junction with another road, hereinafter defined, containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches.

Road containing 26 acres and 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the eastern side of the road first hereinbefore defined at a distance of 130 chains or thereabouts from the Oraka Stream, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-easterly generally for a distance of 26150 links or thereabouts to the Oraka Stream aforesaid at a distance of 23 chains or thereabouts from the north-eastern angle of the aforesaid block.

Road containing 10 acres 3 roods 32 perches: Commencing at a point on the eastern side of a road, hereinafter defined, containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches, at a distance of 18 chains or thereabouts from its northern extremity, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing easterly generally for a distance of 10950 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road last hereinbefore defined.

Road containing 10 acres 1 rood: Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 112 chains or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-westerly generally for a distance of 10250 links or thereabouts to the junction of the roads containing 26 acres and 24 perches, and 10 acres 3 roods 32 perches, hereinbefore defined.

Road containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road containing 26 acres and 24 perches, hereinbefore defined, at a distance of 850 links or thereabouts from its western extremity, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 24295 links or thereabouts to the eastern boundary of the aforesaid block, and at a point on the same 19 chains or thereabouts distant from its south-eastern angle.

Road containing 1 acre 3 roods 32 perches: Commencing at a point on the western side of the road containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches, at a distance of 27 chains or thereabouts from its northern extremity, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing westerly for a distance of 1950 links or thereabouts to another road, hereinbefore described, containing 5 acres 3 roods 32 perches.

Road containing 1 acre 1 rood 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the eastern side of the road containing 5 acres 3 roods 32 perches, last hereinbefore referred to, at a distance of 31 chains or thereabouts from its southern extremity; and thence continuing easterly for a distance of 1400 links or thereabouts to another road, hereinbefore described, containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches.

Road containing 8 acres 2 roods 32 perches: Commencing at a point on the eastern side of the road, hereinbefore described, containing 5 acres 1 rood 24 perches, at a distance of 25 chains or thereabouts from the Ngutuwhera Stream aforesaid; and thence continuing north-easterly and northerly for a distance of 8715 links or thereabouts to a road, hereinbefore described, containing 24 acres 1 rood 8 perches.

Be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same are delineated on Plans Nos. 3662F and 3662G, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

All those parcels of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 26 acres and 21 perches, 6 acres 3 roods 2 perches, 3 acres and 14 perches, 11 acres and 86 perches, 5 acres 1 rood 38 perches, 3 acres and 24 perches, 1 acre 2 roods 4 perches, and 1 acre and 3 perches respectively, more or less, situated in the Patetere North Survey District, and being road-lines, each 100 links wide, traversing the Opuaru Block No. 4925:—

Portion containing 26 acres and 21 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 88 chains or thereabouts from the Pokaiwhenua Stream, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 26120 links or thereabouts to the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block, and at a point on the same at a distance of 2050 links or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle.

Road containing 6 acres 3 roods 2 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the Opuaru Block aforesaid at a distance of 11950 links or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly generally for a distance of 69 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road hereinbefore described.

Road containing 3 acres and 14 perches: Commencing at a point on the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 4850 links from its south-eastern angle,

being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing westerly for a distance of 3089 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road first hereinbefore described.

Road containing 11 acres and 36 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 3650 links or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly and south-easterly generally for a distance of 11975 links or thereabouts to a point on the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 71 chains or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle.

Road containing 5 acres 1 rood 38 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road last hereinbefore described at a distance of 5 chains or thereabouts from the northern boundary of the Opuaru Block aforesaid, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing southerly generally for a distance of 5492 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road last hereinbefore described, and at a distance on the same of 30 chains or thereabouts from the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block.

Road containing 3 acres and 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 3550 links or thereabouts from its north-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-westerly generally for a distance of 3150 links or thereabouts to its junction with the road last hereinbefore described, and at a distance on the same of 17 chains or thereabouts from its northern extremity.

Road containing 1 acre 2 roods 4 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the aforesaid block at a distance of 56 links or thereabouts to the westward of the crossing on the same of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly along the western side of the said railway-line for a distance of 1530 links or thereabouts to the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block.

Road containing 1 acre and 3 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the Opuaru Block aforesaid at a distance of 55 links or thereabouts to the eastward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway-crossing on the same, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly along the said railway for a distance of 1025 links or thereabouts to the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid block.

Be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same are delineated on Plan No. 3662A, deposited in the Survey Office at Auckland.

Date of Governor's warrant, 5th June, 1883.

All those parcels of land in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 15 acres 3 roods 17 perches, 30 acres 1 rood 24 perches, 14 acres 3 roods, 25 acres 3 roods 24 perches, 3 acres 2 roods, 8 acres 1 rood 37 perches, 5 acres and 8 perches, 2 acres, 2 acres, 2 acres 3 roods 16 perches, 2 acres 3 roods 16 perches, 4 acres and 16 perches, 12 acres 2 roods 20 perches, 8 acres 2 roods, 24 acres, 3 acres 1 rood, 5 acres 3 roods 17 perches, and 13 acres 3 roods 20 perches respectively, more or less, situated in the Survey District of Patetere North, and being road-lines, 100 links wide and upwards, traversing the Mangakaretu Block, No. 4306:—

Portion containing 15 acres 3 roods 17 perches, 150 links wide: Commencing at a point on the north-western boundary of the Mangakaretu Block aforesaid at a distance of 12500 links or thereabouts from its northernmost angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 10575 links or thereabouts to another road at the crossing of the latter by the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway.

Portion containing 30 acres 1 rood 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the Oraka Stream at a distance to the north-eastward of 44 chains or thereabouts from the southern termination of the road hereinbefore described, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly generally for a distance of 30400 links or thereabouts to a point about 12 chains distant from the north-western angle of the Mangakaretu No. 2B Block.

Portion containing 14 acres 3 roods: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road last hereinbefore described at a distance of 7550 links or thereabouts from the intersection of the same by the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly generally for a distance of 14750 links or thereabouts to another road.

Portion containing 25 acres 3 roods 24 perches: Commencing at a point on the Pokaiwhenua River at a distance of 4850 links or thereabouts from its confluence with the Opuaru Stream; and thence north-easterly generally for a distance of 25900 links or thereabouts to the southern termination of the road last hereinbefore described.

Portion containing 3 acres 2 roods: Commencing at the eastern termination of the road last hereinbefore described, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing easterly for a distance of 3500 links or thereabouts to the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway.

Portion containing 8 acres 1 rood 37 perches: Commencing at a point being the termination of a right line produced in continuance in an easterly direction of the central line of the road last hereinbefore described, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing north-easterly and easterly generally for a distance of 8480 links or thereabouts to the Oraka Stream.

Portion containing 5 acres and 8 perches: Commencing at a point on the road last hereinbefore described at a distance of 70 chains or thereabouts from the Oraka River, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing in a south-easterly direction to a point at a distance of about 10 chains to the eastward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway.

Portion containing 2 acres: Commencing at the south-eastern termination of the road last hereinbefore defined, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south westerly for a distance of 20 chains to the south-eastern termination of another road.

Portion containing 2 acres: Commencing at a point on the road containing 5 acres and 8 perches, hereinbefore defined, at a distance of 20 chains or thereabouts from its south-eastern angle, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-westerly for a distance of 20 chains to another road.

Portion containing 2 acres 3 roods 16 perches, 150 links wide: Commencing at a point on the southern side of the road lastly hereinbefore described at a distance of 7 chains or thereabouts from its south-western termination, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly for a distance of 19 chains or thereabouts to a previously-described road.

Portion containing 2 acres 3 roods 16 perches: Commencing at a point also on the southern side of the road referred to in the last description at a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to the eastward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 19 chains or thereabouts to a previously-defined road.

Portion containing 4 acres and 16 perches: Commencing at a point on the southern side of a road containing 3 acres and 2 roods, previously defined, at a distance of 6 chains or thereabouts to the westward of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway, being the middle of the road above referred to; and thence continuing south-easterly for a distance of 41 chains or thereabouts to the western termination of a road hereinbefore defined.

Portion containing 12 acres 2 roods 20 perches: Commencing at a point on the northern side of a road containing 2 acres, hereinbefore defined, at a distance of 50 links from the eastern side of the Thames Valley-Rotorua Railway, being the middle of the road above referred to; thence continuing northerly generally along the eastern side of the aforesaid railway for a distance of 8280 links; and thence due north for a further distance of 44 chains or thereabouts.

## "THE ORAKEI NATIVE RESERVE ACT, 1886."
