SCHEDULE.

CLASS I.—PASTORAL LANDS, being Lands suitable exclusively for Pasturage, and not capable of being used with Profit in Areas of less than Five Thousand Acres.

Run 1, 42,500 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north-east and east by the Rangitata River, freehold land, and Run 3; on the south by Run 3; on the south-west by the Orari River; and on the west by Run 2: excepting freehold sections lying within the said boundaries.

Run 2, 58,000 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north-east by the Rangitata River; on the east by Run 1; on the south-west by the Orari River, Phantom Creek, existing fence, and a line along the top of the range to a point opposite the division-fence between the Mesopotamia and Richmond Runs; and on the north-west by the Forest Creek.

Run 5, 24,200 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by freehold land; on the east by the Orari River and freehold land; on the south by Run 6; and on the west by Run 6 and freehold land.

Run 6, 22,600 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 5 and freehold land; on the east by freehold land; on the south-east by freehold land and a line drawn from the west corner of Section 34446 to the north-west corner of Section 27542, by the Waihi River, and Runs 7 and 8; on the south-west by Runs 8 and 14.

Run 8, 10,800 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Runs 6 and 7; on the north-east by the Hae-hae-te-moana River and freehold land; on the south-east by freehold land; on the south by Runs 9, 10, and 11; and on the north-west by Run 14.

Run 14, 46,800 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 2 and the Phantom River; on the east by the Orari River, freehold land, and Run 6; on the south-east by Runs 8 and 10; and on the west by freehold land and the North Opuha River: excepting a piece of land containing 530 acres between Sections Nos. 31990 and 39157.

Run 15, 44,500 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 77; on the east by the North Opuha River and a line to the top of the saddle; on the south-east by freehold land; on the south-west by the South Opuha River and the western branch thereof, past a stone hut, to the head of the north-east branch thereof; and on the west by Runs 76 and 77.

Run 16, 32,900 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 15; on the south-east by freehold land from north corner of Section No. 32474 to north-east corner of Section No. 33347 and a line drawn through Trig. Z to the north-west corner of Section No. 32049, and a line in continuation of the south-west boundary of Section No. 32047; on the south-west by Runs 75 and 76; and on the west and north-west by Edwards Creek and the southern branch of the same to its source and a line along the top of the Two-thumb Range.

Run 23, 5,400 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Runs 21 and 22; on the east by freehold land; on the south-east by the Tengawai River; and on the west by freehold land and Run 24: excepting the purchased land within said boundaries.

Run 25, 18,500 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the fence on the south side of the Burke's Pass Road; on the east by freehold land and Run 24; on the south by Run 74; and on the west by freehold land and Run 74.

Run 27, 9,700 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 26; on the north-east by the existing line of fence and a line drawn in continuation thereof to the south-west corner of Section No. 28508, and by freehold; on the south by Run 28; and on the west by the Hakateramea River and Run 74.

Run 28, 15,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 27; on the north-east by freehold land; on the south by Runs 41 and 65; and on the west by the Hakateramea River.

Run 41, 14,000 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-west by the Pareora River and Run

28; on the east by Run 37; on the south-east by Run 38; and on the south-west by Runs 44 and 65.

Run 44, 17,000 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-east by Runs 39, 40, 41, and 42; on the south by Run 47; on the west by the Waihao River, a fence, and freehold land; and on the north-west by Run 65.

Run 47, 15,500 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-east by Runs 44 and 43; on the east by Runs 45 and 46; on the south by Run 50; and on the west by the Waihao River and freehold land.

Run 50, 6,300 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Run 47; on the east by Run 48; on the south by Run 49; and on the south-west by the Waihao River and freehold land.

Run 51, 7,250 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the east by freehold land; on the south by the south branch of the Waihao River and Run 53; on the west by Run 53; and on the north and north-west by Run 52.

Run 52, 12,500 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by freehold land and the Waihao River; on the east by freehold land and the Waihao River; on the south and south-east by freehold land and Runs 51 and 53; and on the north-west by freehold land.

Run 53, 6,500 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Runs 51 and 52; on the east by Run 51, freehold land, and Educational Reserve No. 2001; on the south by Meyer's Creek, Gorge Road, and freehold land; and on the west by freehold land.

Run 54, 5,800 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Gorge Road and Meyer's Creek; on the south-east by Educational Reserves Nos. 2002 and 2003, and freehold land; on the south by freehold land; on the south-west by a line in continuation of the south-west boundary of Section No. 29416; and on the north-west by freehold land.

Run 61A, 7,000 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-west by Runs 62A and 66; on the south-east and east by Run 61 within Educational Reserve No. 1574; on the south-west by the Waitaki River and freehold land; and on the west by freehold land and Run 66.

Run 62A, 9,700 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-east by the proposed rabbit-fence and freehold land; on the south-east by Run 62 within Educational Reserve No. 1574; on the south by Run 61A; and on the west by Runs 66 and 70.

Run 64, 11,000 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 74; on the south-east by freehold land; on the south-west by the proposed rabbit-fence; and on the west by Runs 70 and 72.

Run 65, 11,800 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Run 28; on the north-east by Runs 23 and 41; on the south-east by Run 44 and Peter's Creek; and on the south-west by freehold land and the Hakateramea River.

Run 66, 48,900 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Runs 68 and 70; on the east and south-east by Runs 61A and 62A; on the south by freehold land and the Waitaki River; and on the west by Run 67 and freehold land.

Run 67, 29,200 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Run 68; on the east and south-east by Run 66 and freehold land; and on the south and west by the Waitaki River.

Run 68, 20,800 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by Educational Reserve No. 1358; on the north-east by Run 70; on the south-east by Run 66; on the south by Run 67; and on the west by the Waitaki River.

Run 70, 37,200 acres, situated in the Waimate County. Bounded on the north by the rabbit-fence and Run 72; on the east by Runs 62A and 64; on the south by Run 66; on the south-east by Run 68; and on the west by Educational Reserves Nos. 1358 and 1359.

Run 72, 45,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the reservation at Trig. V.; on the north-east by the Snow River to its source; on the east by Run 64; on the south by Run 70; and on the north-west by Educational Reserve No. 1359 and freehold land.

Run 73, 26,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 75; on the south-east by the creek rising at the old Whalesback Station, freehold land, and the Sawdon Stream; on the south-west by Gray's Creek; and on the west by the Tekapo River.

Run 74, 32,500 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Section No. 33831, a line in continuation of the south-east boundary thereof, and Run 25; on the east by Runs 25, 26, and 27, freehold land, and the Hakateramea River; on the south-east by Runs 64 and 72; and on the west by Run 73 and freehold land.

Run 75, 27,750 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Runs 16 and 76; on the south-east by freehold land and Runs 25 and 74; on the south-west by Run 73; and on the west by the Tekapo River: excepting a reservation of 1,400 acres between a line through Trig. J and the northern boundary of the run.

Run 76, 27,900 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 77; on the east and south-east by Runs 16 and 75; on the south-west by Run 75; and on the north-west by Lake Tekapo, freehold land, and the Tekapo River: excepting a reservation of 130 acres at the Reference Trig. Station at Lake Tekapo.

Run 77, 87,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the east by a line along the top of the Two-thumb Range; on the north-east by Runs 2 and 110A; on the south-east by Runs 15 and 76; on the west by Lake Tekapo and the Godley River; and on the north-west by the Macaulay River and the eastern branch of the North-east Gorge Creek.

Run 78, 70,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the creek near the end of the Godley Glacier and a line across to the Macaulay Glacier; on the north-east by a line along the top of the Two-thumb Range; on the south-east by Run 77 and the Macaulay River; and on the west by the Godley River.

Run 79, 53,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by the Cass River and the eastern branch thereof to its source; on the east by reserved land, freehold land, and Lake Tekapo; on the south-east by the Tekapo River; on the south-west by the Fork Stream; and on the west by a line at the top of the range up to the watershed of the rivers running into the Cass River on the west side thereof.

Run 80, 62,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the Classen Glacier; on the east by the Godley River and Lake Tekapo, and a line in continuation of the western boundary of Section No. 33490; on the south-west by the Cass River and the eastern branch thereof; and on the west by a line along the watershed of the streams running into the Godley River on the west side thereof.

Run 81, 29,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by the Fork Stream and freehold land; on the south by Run 84; on the west by freehold land and Run 82; and on the north-west by Run 82.

Run 82, 40,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by the Fork Stream; on the south-east by Run 81 and freehold land; on the south-west by freehold land; and on the north-west by the Jollie River and a line across to the Fork Stream.

Run 83, 10,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the stream running into the Tasman River near the junction of the Tasman and Hooker Rivers, and by Reserve No. 2756; on the east and south-east by the Jollie River; on the south by a line in continuation of the southern boundary of Section No. 34902; and on the west by the Tasman River.

Run 84, 23,500 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 81 and a line from the fence to the junction of the Fork Stream with the Tekapo River; on the south-east by Run 85 and land reserved on same; on the west by Lake Pukaki and land reserved at old woolshed near Trig. W; and on the north-west by freehold land and Run 81.

Run 85, 42,300 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 84; on the east by Tekapo River; on the south-east by Run 86 and freehold land; on the south-west by the road through Dover Pass and a line in continuation thereof to the lake; on the west by Lake Pukaki, the Maryburn Stream and land reserved thereon, and by freehold land; and on the north-west by Run 84: excepting the freehold land and land reserved included within these boundaries.

Run 86, 30,600 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 85; on the south-east by the Tekapo River; on the south-west by the Pukaki River; and on the north-west by land reserved, Lake Pukaki, and Run 85: excepting out of the land described all freehold sections and land reserved.

Run 87, 54,700 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Runs 88 and 93, and the road to Pukaki Ferry; on the north-east by the Pukaki River; on the south-west by the Ohau River; and on the west by Lake Ohau: excepting out of the land described all freehold sections and land reserved.

Run 88, 65,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by freehold land, Boundary Creek, and a line to the top of the range; on the east by land reserved and Lake Pukaki; on the south by Run 87; and on the north-west by a line along the top of the range up to the watershed-line of all streams running into the Pukaki Lake or River.

Run 89, 58,000 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by the rabbit-fence, a creek, and a line run to the top of the main range; on the east by the Tasman River, freehold land, and reserved land; on the south-west by Run 88; and on the west by a line along the top of the range up to the watershed of all streams running into the Tasman River: excepting the bush and other land reserved within this run.

Run 92, 12,000 acres, situated in the Waitaki County. Bounded on the north by the fence forming the boundary between this run and Run 93, and a line in continuation to the top of the range; on the east by Lake Ohau; on the south by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Canterbury and Otago; and on the west by the watershed-line on the main range on the eastern side of Ahuriri River.

Run 93, 200,000 acres, situated in the Waitaki County. Bounded on the north by an east and west line at the source of the Dobson River; on the east by a line on the top of the range forming the western boundary of Runs 88 and 89; on the south by Run 87, Lake Ohau, and Run 92; on the west by a line along the top of the range forming the watershed between the Hopkins, Ahuriri, and Hunter Rivers; and on the north-west by the boundary-line of the province: excluding all forest lands coming within the boundaries described.

Run 94, 60,000 acres, situated in the Waitaki County. Bounded on the north by a line at the top of the range between the Ahuriri and Hopkins Rivers; on the east by Runs 92 and 93; on the south by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Canterbury and Otago; and on the west by the watershed-line along the top of the range between the Dingle, Ahuriri, and Hunter Rivers: excluding any forest lands coming within the boundaries described.

Run 95, 125,000 acres, situated in the Vincent County. Bounded on the north and west by the watershed-line along the top of the range between the Hunter and Makarora Rivers; on the east by the Hunter River; and on the south by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Canterbury and Otago.

Run 96, 50,000 acres, situated in the Lake County. Bounded on the north by the Wilkin River; on the east by the Makarora River and Lake Wanaka; on the south by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Canterbury and Otago; and on the west by a line at the top of the range at the source of Albertburn and Nottingley River, forming the watershed between these rivers and the Wilkin River.

Run 97, 56,000 acres, situated in the Lake County. Bounded on the south by the Otago Provincial District; on the north-west by the County of Westland; on the north-east by a line from the northerly corner of Run 96, up the leading range to Mount Alba; and on the south-east by Run 96.

Run 98, 95,000 acres, situated in the Vincent County. Bounded on the south by the Wilkin River and Run 97; on the north and west by the County of Westland; and on the south-east by the Makarora River to its source near Haast Pass: excepting freehold and reserved land included within the above-described boundaries.

Run 99, 52,000 acres, situated in the Vincent County. Bounded on the south by the Otago Provincial District; on the West by the Makarora River to its source at Haast Pass; on the north by the County of Westland; and on the south-east by Run 95: excepting freehold and reserved land included within the above-described boundaries.

Run 99A, 63,000 acres, situated in the Vincent County. Bounded on the south by the Otago Provincial District; on the north-west by the Hunter River to its source at the Hunter Saddle; on the north by the County of Westland; and on the south-east by Runs 93 and 94.

Run 100, 35,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the Rakaia River and third-class freehold land; on the south-east by freehold land, the Pudding Hill Bush, and Reserve No. 1116; on the south-west by the north branch of the Ashburton River; and on the north-west by the fence up Terrible Gully, extending down the ridge on the west side of the Swift River: excluding the small bush on the east side of the Pudding Hill Bush.

Run 102, 30,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the north branch of the Ashburton River; on the south-east by Run 101, Taylor's Stream, Section No. 22039, and the edge of the Alford Bush; on the south-west by Bowyer's Stream and a fence extending to the Winterslow Saddle; on the west by a line along the top of Taylor's Range; and on the north by Boundary Creek and a line to the top of the range.

Run 104, 12,700 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 102, Alford Forest, and Run 103; on the south-east by a line drawn from a branch of Bowyer's Stream to the top of a small bush, and from thence by a line to the north-east corner of Section No. 29637; on the south by freehold land, and a line from the north-west corner of Section No. 29613 to the north-east corner of Section No. 9300, and a line in continuation of the north boundary of the latter section; and on the west by the Stour River and a line to the Winterslow Saddle.

Run 106, 7,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by a line from the south-east corner of Section No. 34118 to a public road, and by the said road and freehold land; on the east by freehold land; on

the south-west by a fence erected in the valley of the South Hinds River up to the saddle dividing it from the North Hinds River, and a line drawn to the top of the Moorhouse Range, and by a line along the summit of that range; and on the north-west by Educational Reserve No. 1357.

Run 107, 7,300 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 106; on the south-east by freehold land; on the south-west by the Rangitata River; and on the north-west by Educational Reserve No. 1357 and the Pudding Valley Stream.

Run 110A, 44,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east and south-east by Educational Reserves Nos. 1575 and 1576 and Forest Creek; on the south-west by the fence forming the boundary of Run 77 and a line from the bush stream to the top of the Two-thumb Range; on the west by the Two-thumb Range; and on the north by a line from Alma Hill to the nearest corner of Educational Reserve No. 1575.

Run 110B, 14,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the River Havelock and Educational Reserve No. 1575; on the south by Run 110A; on the south-west by the Two-thumb Range; and on the north-west by a tributary of the Havelock River north of Finlay's Bush.

Run 111, 18,500 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the Clyde River; on the south-west by the Havelock River; and on the north-west by a line extending between the two rivers crossing the range opposite the northern boundary of Run 110B.

Run 112, 17,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north by a line starting about 1 mile north of Trig. N on the Clyde River, and crossing the range to a point about 3 miles up the Lawrence River; on the north-west by the said river and a branch of the same running into it about  $5\frac{1}{2}$  miles north of its junction with the Clyde River; on the east by a line on the top of the main range, and a line running from the same into a wooded gully, and by said gully; on the south by a line in continuation of an old line of fence running to a lagoon at the foot of the Jumped-up Downs between the said gully and the Clyde River; and on the west and south-west by the Clyde River.

Run 113, 54,700 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the south branch of the Ashburton River and a line to the north corner of Run 112; on the south by freehold land and Educational Reserve No. 1357; and on the west by the Potts River to its source, a line drawn to the top of the range, and by Run 112.

Run 114, 26,500 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the east by Run 113 and the Potts River; on the south-west by the Rangitata River; on the west by the Clyde River; and on the north and north-west by Run 112.

Run 115, 52,600 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north and north-west by Lake Heron, a reserve, existing fence, and a proposed new line of fence running up a stream to the west of the Swin River as far as the Clent Hills saddle; on the east by a line on the top of Taylor's Range to the Winterslow saddle and by Run 104; on the south by freehold land; on the south-west by the south branch of the Ashburton River and a line in continuation of the south-west boundary of Section No. 30666; and on the west by a public road, freehold land, and the existing fence between their run and Run 116.

Run 116, 25,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the Cameron River; on the east by Lake Heron and Run 115; on the south and south-west by the south branch of the Ashburton River; and on the north-west by a line extending between the Ashburton and Cameron Rivers, to include all the grass country.

Run 117, 37,500 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north by the Rakaia River; on the east and north-east by Lake Stream, and a branch of the same, and a line starting from a bush on the said branch drawn through Trig T, and by existing line of fence; on the south by Run 115, a reserve, and Lake Heron; and on the south-west by the Cameron River and a line drawn therefrom to the foot of the glaciers on Mount Medhurst and extended to the Rakaia River.

Run 118, 64,000 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north by the Rakaia River; on the east by a line 70 chains east of Double Hill from the Rakaia River to the existing fence at the foot of the range, and by said fence running through the Turton Saddle to the Turton Stream, and by said stream; on the south-east by the north branch of the Ashburton River and a branch of the same to the Clent Hills saddle and by Run 115; and on the south-west by Run 117 and the Lake Stream.

Run 119, 49,500 acres, situated in the Ashburton County. Bounded on the north-east by the Rakaia River and freehold land; on the south-east by Run 100 and the Swift River; on the south by the Ashburton River and Run 102; and on the west by Runs 115 and 118.

CLASS II.—PASTORAL LANDS as aforesaid, but suitable for Subdivision as small Runs into Areas not exceeding Five Thousand Acres.

Run 3, 2,700 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 1; on the east by freehold land; on the south by a line parallel to the boundary of Section No. 23478, drawn through a point where two roads join; and on the west by Run 1.

Run 4, 4,000 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 1; on the north-east by Peel Forest; on the east by freehold land; on the south-east by a public road and a line drawn to the corner of Section 29776, by that section and Section 2012, and lines in continuation of the western boundary thereof; and on the west by the Orari River.

Run 7, 900 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north-east by freehold land; on the south-east and south-west by Run 8; and on the north-west by Run 6.

Run 9, 5,000 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 8; on the south-east by Runs 11 and 13; on the south by freehold land; on the south-west by the north branch of the Opuha River; and on the north-west by Run 10.

Run 10, 3,900 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by freehold land; on the north-east by Runs 8 and 14; on the south-east by Run 9; and on the south-west by the north branch of the Opuha River.

Run 11, 3,400 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 8; on the east by the Hare River and freehold land; on the south by Runs 12 and 13; and on the north-west by Run 9.

Run 12, 4,100 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north-east and east by freehold sections and lines in continuation of the boundaries thereof; on the south by freehold land; and on the west and north-west by freehold land and Runs 11 and 13.

Run 13, 4,700 acres, situated in the Geraldine County. Bounded on the north by Run 11; on the east by Run 12; on the south-west by freehold land; and on the north-west by Run 9.

Run 17, 1,578 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by freehold land; on the south-east by Run 18; on the south-west by Run 20 and freehold land; and on the north-west by the Opihi Stream.

Run 18, 1,712 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by freehold land; on the south by Run 19; on the west by Run 20; and on the north-west by Run 17.

Run 19, 3,100 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 18; on the east by freehold land; on the south by Runs 21 and 22; and on the west by Run 20.

Run 20, 3,400 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by freehold land and Run 17; on the east by Runs 18, 19, and 22; on the south-west by Run 24 and freehold land; and on the north-west by the Opihi Stream and freehold land.

Run 21, 4,800 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north by Run 19; on the east by freehold land; on the south by Run 23; and on the west by Runs 22 and 23.

Run 22, 2,800 acres, situated in the Mackenzie County. Bounded on the north-east by Run 19; on the east by Run 21; on the south by Run 23; and on the west by Runs 20 and 24 and freehold land.

RUN 116, about 25,000 acres, DUNBAR'S STATION, Ashburton County; 20 years and 10 months, fixed tenure; upset rental, £220 per annum.
