New Electoral Districts.

(L.S.) ONSLOW, Governor.
A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Permanent Commission appointed under the provisions of "The Representation Act, 1887," have made their report to me under their hands and seals, setting forth the names and boundaries of the electoral districts fixed by them in accordance with the said Act and the Acts amending the same:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the provisions of the fifth section of "The Representation Act, 1887," I, William Hillier, Earl of Onslow, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the names and boundaries of the electoral districts so fixed by the said Commission to be those respectively mentioned and set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

BAY OF ISLANDS.

THIS district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the ocean, from North Cape to Helena Bay; thence towards the south-east generally by Township Reserve and Sections Nos. 2 and 1, Block I., Opuawhanga Survey District, to the north-western corner of the latter section; thence by the boundary-line between Native land and Crown land (the said boundary-line being part of the north-west boundary-line of Whangarei County) to the Taparahaia River; thence by the said Taparahaia River, the Kaimamaku River, and the Whakapara River to the confluence of the last-mentioned river with the Wairua River; thence by the said Wairua River to its confluence with the Wairoa River; and thence by the said Wairoa River to a right line drawn between Trig. Station No. 41 (Tangihua), Maungaru Survey District, and Trig. Station No. 18 (Te Tarai-o-Rahiri), Mangakahia Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to the said Trig. Station No. 41; thence towards the north and again towards the north-east by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 16, Block III., Tangihua Survey District, and by Section No. 7, Block I., and Sections Nos. 92 (eastern and western portions), 91, 90, 89 (eastern and western portions), 88, 87, 129, 130, 25 (eastern and western portions), 24 (northern and southern portions), and 18, all of Maungakaramea Parish, in the said Tangihua Survey District, to the Tauraroa River; thence again towards the south-east by the said Tauraroa River to its confluence with the Mangonui River; thence again towards the north-

east by the said Mangonui River to the main road from Tokatoka to Waikiekie, which passes through Section No. 174, Okahu Parish, Tangihua Survey District aforesaid; thence again towards the south-east by the said road from Tokatoka to Waikiekie to the southernmost corner of Section No. 89 of the said Okahu Parish, Tokatoka Survey District; thence by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the north-western portion of Section No. 36 of Tokatoka Parish; thence by the said north-western portion of Section No. 36, and by Sections Nos. 35, 34 (northern and southern portions), 33, 31, 30 (northern portion), 25, 23, 13, 12, 24, and an education reserve of 1 acre, all of the said Parish of Tokatoka, to the north-western corner of the said Section No. 24; thence by a right line across the Wairoa River to the northernmost corner of Section No. 12, Tatarariki Parish, Tokatoka Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by the Wairoa River; again towards the south-east by the Kaipara Entrance; towards the south-west generally by the ocean; and again towards the north by the ocean: including Cavalli and adjacent islands.

MARSDEN.

THIS district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the ocean, from the northernmost corner of a township reserve, situate at Helena Bay, in Block I., Opuawhanga Survey District, to the north head of Mahurangi Harbour; thence towards the south-west by the said Mahurangi Harbour to Duck Creek; thence towards the north-west by the said Duck Creek to Section No. 25, Mahurangi Parish, Mahurangi Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 25 to the Matakana River; thence towards the west by the said Section No. 25 and Sections Nos. 26, 28, and 29 of the said Mahurangi Parish to Section No. 30; thence towards the south by the river which forms the northern boundary of the said Section No. 30, and which forms the northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 31, 32, 33, and 34, of a block of Crown land, and of Sections Nos. 35 and 110, all of Mahurangi Parish aforesaid, to a point in line with the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the summit of The Dome; thence again towards the west by a line due north to the right bank of the Waiwhiu River; thence again towards the south-west and towards the south-east generally by the said Waiwhiu River and the Hcteo River respectively to the Kaipara River; thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Kaipara River and the Wairoa River to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Te Kuri Parish; thence again towards the south-east by a right line across the said Wairoa River to the northernmost corner of the said Te Kuri Parish:

and thence again towards the north-west generally by the Bay of Islands Electoral District hereinbefore described to the point of commencement: including Kawau Island, and Motutekateka, Motureke, Motutara, Motuhora, Morotiri, and Taranga Islands.

WAITEMATA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by the Marsden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Hotoe River to the north head of Mahurangi Harbour; thence towards the east generally by the ocean to the north head of Waitemata Harbour; thence towards the south generally by the said Waitemata Harbour; again towards the east by the said Waitemata Harbour and the Whau Estuary to Section No. 90, Parish of Waikomiti; thence towards the south-east generally by the said Section No. 90 to the Oratia Stream; thence by that stream to a point in line with the northern side of William Street in the Township of Henderson, thence by a right line to the northern side of the said William Street, and thence by that street to the Helensville Railway-line; thence towards the south-west and west by the said Helensville Railway-line to the eastern portion of the Taupaki Block; thence again towards the south-east generally by the southern boundary of the said eastern portion of the Taupaki Block and the southern boundary of the western portion of the said Taupaki Block to the ocean; thence again towards the south-west by the ocean, towards the north by the Kaipara entrance, and again towards the north-east and west by the Kaipara River to the place of commencement: including the Islands of Great and Little Barrier and Tiritiri, and Herald Island in Waitemata Harbour.

EDEN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by the Waitemata Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the southernmost corner of the western portion of the Taupaki Block, on the west coast, to the northernmost corner of Section No. 90, Waikomiti Parish, at the Whau Estuary; thence towards the north generally by Waitemata Harbour and Motion's Creek to the road at the north-western boundary of Allotment No. 13 of Section No. 9 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence again towards the north-east and again towards the north generally by Allotment No. 11 of the said Section No. 9 to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 12; thence by a right line across a road to the north-western corner of the said Allotment No. 12; thence by that allotment and Allotment No. 14, the crossing of a road, and Allotment No. 15 of the said Section No. 9 to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned allotment; thence by a right line across the old Great North Road to the north-eastern corner of Allotment No. 21 of Section No. 7 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by Allotments Nos. 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, 15, and 14 of the said Section No. 7 to the south-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 9 of Section No. 5 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by the said Allotment No. 9 to the New North Road; thence by the north side of the said New North Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 2c of Section No. 10 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line across the said New North Road to the westernmost corner of the said Allotment No. 2c; thence by that allotment and Allotments Nos. 2b, 2a, and 2 of the said Section No. 10 to Mount Eden Road; thence by the said Mount Eden Road to its junction with the road leading to the Mount Eden Stockade; thence by the latter road to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Allotment No. 105 of Section No. 6 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence towards the east generally by the last-mentioned road, and by the road fronting Allotments Nos. 106, 107, and 108, all of the said Section No. 6, to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned allotment; thence by a right line across a road to the westernmost corner of Allotment No. 110; thence by the said Allotment No. 110, the crossing of a road, and by Allotments Nos. 97, 98, 99, and 100 of the said Section No. 6, the crossing of a road, and by the south-eastern boundary-line of the Mount Eden Reserve to the northernmost corner of Allotment No. 11 of the said Section No. 6; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Allotment No. 11 to its easternmost corner; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Allotment No. 40 of the said Section No. 6; thence again towards the north-west generally by the road which forms the western and northern boundaries of the said Allotment No. 40, and by the continuation of that road to the north-eastern corner of Allotment No. 42 of the said Section No. 6; thence by the crossing of a road, and by the road which forms the western boundaries of Allotments Nos. 23c, 23b, and 23a of the said Section No. 6; thence again towards the north-east by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned allotment to the Epsom-Onehunga Road; thence again towards the east by the said Epsom-Onehunga Road to Mount Smart Road; thence again towards the south-west

by the said Mount Smart Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 3 of Section No. 13 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence again towards the east by a right line to the said boundary-line; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the said Allotment No. 3 and the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 2 of the said Section No. 13 to Manukau Harbour; thence towards the south and south-east generally by the said Manukau Harbour; and again towards the south-west by the ocean to the place of commencement.

NEWTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Waitemata Harbour; towards the north-east generally by Curran Street, Ponsonby, to Ponsonby Road; thence by the said Ponsonby Road to the Great North Road; thence by the latter road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 13 of Section No. 7 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of the said Allotment No. 13; thence by the north-eastern boundary-lines of Allotments Nos. 13 (afore-said) and 4 to Basque Road; thence by the north side of the said Basque Road to the New North Road; thence by a right line across the said New North Road to the northernmost corner of Allotment No. 2 of Section No. 10 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by Mount Eden Road to the easternmost corner of the said Allotment No. 2; thence towards the south and south-west generally by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Motion's Creek; and thence by that creek to Waitemata Harbour.

CITY OF AUCKLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by Waitemata Harbour, from the south side of Curran Street, Ponsonby, to the middle of Franklin Street, at the original high-water mark of Freeman's Bay; thence towards the west by lines 50 and 300 links; thence towards the north by lines 1225, 700, 270, 4300, 1735, 82, 250, 758, 852, 1171, 1059, and 1800 links (the said lines being the northern boundary-lines of the City of Auckland); towards the south-east generally by a line, 1500 links, to The Strand; thence by The Strand, 50 links; thence to and by Suburban Section No. 96; thence by a line at right angles to the western boundary-line of that section to and along the east side of Stanley Street to the Government Domain; thence by the said Government Domain and the Hospital Reserve to the road known as Park Road; thence by the northern side of the said Park Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 22 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to, and thence by the said eastern boundary-line and its production to the south side of Carleton Gore Road; thence by the south side of that road to the western boundary-line of Subdivisional Lot No. 37 of original Allotment No. 4 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by the said Lot No. 37, and by Lots Nos. 55, 56, 65, 66, 75, 76, 85, 86, 95, 96, 105, 106, 115, 116, and 13, all of original Allotment No. 4 of the said Section No. 3, and by the western boundary-line of the said Lot No. 13 produced to the southern side of the Kyber Pass Road; thence by that road to the eastern side of the road leading to the Mount Eden Stockade; thence by the eastern side of the last-mentioned road to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Allotment No. 105 of Section No. 6 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence towards the south by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and towards the south-west generally by the Newton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the place of commencement.

PARNELL.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by Waitemata Harbour; towards the east by Sections Nos. 40A, 39A, 38A, and 45, all of Waitemata Parish, Rangitoto Survey District; towards the south-east generally by Allotments Nos. 12A and 26, and by the southern boundary-line of Allotment No. 25 of Section No. 12 of the Suburbs of Auckland to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned allotment; thence by a right line to the junction of roads at the Harp of Erin Inn; thence towards the south-west by the Great South Road to its junction with Green Lane; thence towards the south by the said Green Lane to the Epsom-Onehunga Road; thence towards the west generally by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and towards the north-west generally by the City of Auckland Electoral District, hereinbefore described.

MANUKAU.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Hauraki Gulf; towards the south-west by Section No. 58, Wairoa Parish, and the south-western boundary-lines of the Papepape and the Kiripaka Blocks; towards the south-east and again towards the south-west by the south-eastern and south-western boundary-lines of Section No. 46, Maraetai Parish; thence again towards

the south-east generally by the eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 72, 71, 64, 61, and 63 of the said Maraetai Parish; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section, by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 57, and by the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 55 of the said Maraetai Parish; thence by the north-eastern and south-eastern boundary-lines of Section No. 33, the south-eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 132 and 131, Pakuranga Parish, and the south-eastern and south-western boundary-lines of Section No. 178; thence by Section No. 64, Papakura Parish, and by Sections Nos. 96 and 95, Manurewa Parish; thence again towards the south-west by the road which forms the south-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 94, 93, 92, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 27A, 33, 32, and 30, all of the said Manurewa Parish; again towards the south-east by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 40 of the last-named parish to the southernmost corner of that section; thence again towards the north-east by the Great South Road to the road which forms the north-western boundaries of Allotments Nos. 2 and 1 of Section No. 7 of the Town of Papakura, and the road which forms the north-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 18, 17, 16, 15, and 14 of Section No. 6 of the Town of Papakura; thence again towards the south-east by the latter road to the Pahurehure River; thence towards the south by the said Pahurehure River; thence again towards the south-west and north-west by Manukau Harbour to the south-eastern corner of Allotment No. 2 of Section No. 13 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence towards the west by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the north and again towards the west by the Parnell Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Hauraki Gulf: including the Islands of Rangitoto, Motutapu, Waiheke, Ponui, Tarataroa, Brown's, Chamberlin's, Rakino, Bean Rock, and adjacent islands; and the islands in Manukau Harbour to the north of the Pahurehure River.

FRANKLIN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Manukau Harbour and by the Manukau Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the Frith of Thames; towards the south-east generally by the Pukorokoro Creek to Section No. 82 (reserve), Block VI., Wharekawa Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 82 to the high road and telegraph-line from Pukorokoro to Mercer; thence by the said high road and telegraph-line to the Mangatangi River; thence by the said Mangatangi River and the Maramarua River to the confluence of the latter with the Waikato River; thence by the latter river to its mouth; and thence towards the south-west by the ocean: including the islands in the Waikato River between the mouth of the Maramarua River and Waikato Heads, and including also the islands in the Pahurehure River.

THAMES.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east by the ocean; towards the south-west by a right line drawn in a north-westerly direction from the north head of Tairua Harbour in the direction of the source of the Waikawau River, as far as the Waiwawa River; thence towards the south-east generally by the said Waiwawa River and its tributary the Taitoko Stream to the source of the latter; thence by the Waiwhakaurunga and Mangarehu Blocks (timber leases of 14,186 acres and 1,825 acres) respectively to the Mangakirikiri No. 1 Block (No. 3387A); thence by that block to its southernmost corner; thence by the summit of the range leading to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 2, Block V., Thames Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 2, the Karaka South No. 1 Block (No. 2597), and Karaka Creek to a point in line with the north-eastern side of Augustus Street, in the Town of Shortland; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to and along the north-eastern side of the said Augustus Street to Hape Creek; thence towards the south by the said Hape Creek to a point in the middle of Rolleston Street; thence again towards the north-east by a line being the production of a line drawn along the middle of the said Rolleston Street to the middle of Grey Street, in the said Town of Shortland; thence again towards the south-east by a line along the middle of the said Grey Street to Hape Creek, and thence across that creek; and towards the east by the said Hape Creek to its confluence with the Kaueranga River; thence again towards the south by a right line due west 80 chains; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to a point 11681½ links distant from Trig. Station F, Thames Survey District, on a bearing of 282° 36' 31"; thence again towards the north by a line due east to Rocky Point; and thence towards the west generally by the Frith of Thames: including Great Mercury, Cuvier, and adjacent islands.

TE AROHA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the ocean; towards the east by a right line from the southern-

most point of Matakana Island to the northernmost point of the Town of Tauranga; thence by the said Town of Tauranga and the Kopurererua River to a point in line with the south-western side of Hospital Street, in the said Town of Tauranga; thence by a right line to and along the south-western side of the said Hospital Street to the waters of Tauranga Harbour; thence by the waters of the said Tauranga Harbour to the Waimapu River; thence by that river to the road which forms the southern boundary of Section No. 37, Te Papa Parish; towards the south by the said road to the Tauranga-Rotorua Road; thence again towards the east by the said Tauranga-Rotorua Road to the south-eastern corner of the Taumata No. 2 Block; thence towards the south-east by the Taumata No. 3B West Block to Puhenua Trig. Station; thence by a right line to Uraura Trig. Station; thence towards the south-west by a right line to Maungatautari Trig. Station; thence by a right line running in the direction of Opahau as far as the right bank of the Waikato River; thence by the said Waikato River to Section No. 161, Hautapu Parish; thence towards the west by the said Section No. 161, the crossing of a road, and by Sections Nos. 1 and 18 of the said Hautapu Parish to Victoria Road; thence by the said Victoria Road to Section No. 157, Tamahere Parish; thence towards the north-west by the said Section No. 157, the crossing of a road, by Sections Nos. 168 and 221, the crossing of a road, Sections Nos. 220 and 213, all of the said Parish of Tamahere, the crossing of a road, and by Section No. 212 to its south-eastern corner; thence by a right line to Pukemoremore Trig. Station; thence again towards the south-west by the confiscation boundary-line to Pukorokoro Creek; thence again towards the north-west by the Frith of Thames, and the Thames Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and towards the north by the said Thames Electoral District to the north head of the Tairua Harbour: including Slipper and Shoe Islands.

WAIKATO.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Franklin Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the north-east by Te Aroha Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Uraura Trig. Station; thence towards the south-east by a right line to the mouth of the Waihora Stream in Lake Taupo; thence by the said Lake Taupo to the mouth of the Waibi Stream; thence by a right line to the summit of Tongariro Mountain; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the south-easternmost corner of the Kirikau Block, and thence by that block to the Wanganui River; thence towards the north-west generally by the said Wanganui River to the confluence of the Ongarue River with the said Wanganui River, and thence by the said Ongarue River to its intersection by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Taranaki and Auckland, at a point about 10½ miles south of the source of the Mokau River; thence by the said boundary-line to the source of the said Mokau River; thence towards the south generally by the said Mokau River to the parallel of 38° 30' south latitude; thence by the said parallel of 38° 30' to the ocean; and towards the west by the ocean.

EAST COAST.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the ocean; towards the east and south-east by the Waipaoa River and Poverty Bay to the right bank of the Waipaoa River; thence towards the south-west by the right bank of the said Waipaoa River to Te Arai River; thence again towards the south-east generally by Te Arai River to its confluence with the Waimata River; thence by the last-named river and the north-western boundary-line of the Waimata Native Reserve (4,186 acres) to Trig. Station No. 136 (Parikanapa), in Block IX., Patutahi Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by Sections Nos. 2 and 3 of the said Block IX., and Section No. 3, Block XII., Hangarua Survey District, to the Hangarua River; thence by the said Hangarua River to its source nearest to Maungatapere Trig. Station; thence by a right line to the said Maungatapere Trig. Station; thence again towards the south-east by a right line to Maungapohatu; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to Trig. Station No. 93 (Matakapia); thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the most northerly point of Waikaremoana; thence by a right line in the direction of the Rangitaiki River and the main road from Napier to Taupo, till it meets a right line joining the summits of Tatarakino (Trig. Station No. 69) and Tawhiwhau (Trig. Station No. 76A) Mountains; thence towards the north-west by a right line to the summit of the said Tawhiwhau Mountain; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to Paeroa Trig. Station (No. 31); thence by a right line to Uraura Trig. Station; and thence again towards the north-west by Te Aroha Electoral District, hereinbefore described: including Motiti, Motuhora, and Mayor Islands.

NEW PLYMOUTH.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Waikato Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the said Waikato Electoral District and the left bank of the Wanganui River to a point in line with the southern boundary-line of Block VI., Huiroa Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line in the direction of the said southern boundary-line of Block VI. as far as the Makino Stream; thence towards the south-west by that stream and the Waitara River to the confluence of the Manganui River with the said Waitara River; thence again towards the south-east by the said Manganui River to the confluence of the Kurapete Stream with that river; thence by the said Kurapete Stream to Section No. 238 of (Huirangi) Huiroa Survey District; thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Section No. 238, the crossing of a road, and Sections Nos. 233, 230, and 221, to Richmond Road; thence across that road, and by Sections Nos. 215 and 214, and 205, all of (Huirangi) Waitara Survey District, to Wortley Road; thence across that road and by Sections Nos. 212 and 204 of (Huirangi) Paritutu Survey District, to the western side of the Wanganui-New Plymouth Railway-line; thence again towards the south-east generally by the said railway-line to Humphries Street, in the Town of Inglewood; thence by that street and its northern side produced to the left bank of the Waiiongona-iti; thence by that stream to Junction Road; thence by the said Junction Road to Windsor Road; thence by the said Windsor Road to Section No. 111 of (Moa) Egmont Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 111 to the Waiiongona; thence by that stream to the road which forms the northern boundary of Section No. 12, Block VII., of the said Egmont Survey District; thence by that road and the road which forms the northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 11 and 10 of the said Block VII. to the Mangaoraka Stream; thence by the said Mangaoraka Stream to Section No. 4 of the said Block VII.; thence by the said Section No. 4 to Egmont Road; thence across that road and by Section No. 25 of the said Block VII. to the Waiwakaiho; thence by that stream to the Egmont Forest Reserve; thence again towards the south-west by that reserve to the Mangorei Stream; thence again towards the south-east by that stream to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 134 of (Omata) Egmont Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by a line to and along the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 134, by the crossing of a road, and the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 135, 128, and 107, all of (Omata) Egmont Survey District, to the Hurford Road; thence by the said Hurford Road to Section No. 120; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 105 and 104 of the said Egmont Survey District to the Nakara Stream; thence by that stream to its confluence with the Tapuae Stream; and thence by the said Tapuae Stream to the ocean; and thence again towards the north and towards the west by the ocean to the parallel of 38° 30' south latitude.

EGMONT.

Section No. 202; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 205, 206, 182, 192, 209, 210, and 124 of the said Block XIII. to the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 104, Block XVI., Nukumarū Survey District; thence by that road to the Kai-iwi Stream; thence by the left bank of the said Kai-iwi Stream to the south-eastern boundary-line of the Kai-iwi Block; thence again towards the south-east by the south-eastern boundary-lines of the said Kai-iwi Block to the ocean; and thence again towards the south-west by the ocean.

WANGANUI.

MASTERTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Rangitikei and the Waipawa Electoral Districts, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the ocean to the Whareama River; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Whareama River to the confluence of the Mangapokia River with the said Whareama River; thence by the said Mangapokia River to Section No. 240, Rewa Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 240, and Sections Nos. 260, 261, 739, 620, 619, and 618, all of the said Rewa Survey District, to the Mangapakeha Stream; thence by that stream and by Sections Nos. 617, 522, 521, and 520, the southern boundary-line of Section No. 518, Mangapakeha Survey District, and by Section No. 524 of the said Rewa Survey District; thence by Section No. 523, Otahoua Survey District, by a line along the south-western boundary of Section No. 866 of the said Mangapakeha Survey District, and the southern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 93 and 97, Kopuaranga Survey District, and thence by Sections Nos. 92 and 96, Otahoua Survey District, to the Taueru River; thence by the right bank of the said Taueru River to the road which intersects the Takamaitu Block; thence again towards the south-east by that road and its continuation in a westerly direction towards Masterton as far as the Wangaeahu River; thence by the said Wangaeahu River to its confluence with the Ruamahanga River; thence by the said Ruamahanga River to its confluence with the Waingawa River; thence again towards the south-west by the said Waingawa River to its source; thence by a line due west to the summit of the Tararua Range; and thence towards the north-west by the Palmerston Electoral District, hereinbefore described.

WAIRARAPA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by Tasman Bay, from the Motueka River to the City of Nelson Electoral District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east, towards the north, and towards the west by the said City of Nelson Electoral District to the seaward boundary of the Boulder Bank; thence towards the north-west by Tasman Bay; again towards the north-east and towards the south-east by Cook Strait to the southernmost point of White's Bay; thence towards the south-west generally by a line bearing N. 45° W. to the summit of the watershed between Queen Charlotte Sound and Port Underwood and Cloudy Bay; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 96, Block XV., Linkwater Survey District; thence by Sections Nos. 117 and 97 of the said Block XV. to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the crossing of a road and by the road which forms the southern boundary of Section No. 66 of the said Block XV. to the Picton-Blenheim Railway-line; thence again towards the east by the said Picton-Blenheim Railway-line to the Wairau River; thence again towards the south-east by the said Wairau River to Hannam's Creek; thence towards the south generally by that creek to the south-western corner of Section No. 106, Block XII., Onamalutu Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 106 and 107 to the westernmost corner of the said Section No. 107; thence by a right line to the nearest point on the summit of the watershed between the Onamalutu and the Kaituna Valleys; thence by that watershed to the summit of the dividing-range between the Pelorus and Wairau Valleys; thence by that summit to the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Marlborough and Nelson; thence again towards the south-east by that boundary-line to Tophouse; thence by the summit of the St. Arnaud Range to a point near the headwaters of the Motupiko River; thence again towards the south-west generally by the summit of the watershed of the Rivers Motupiko and Buller, and the summit of the dividing-range between the said Buller River and the Hope River, to the confluence of the last-named river with the said Buller River; and thence towards the north-west generally by a right line to the summit of the range at the source of the Tadmor River; thence by the summit of the dividing-range between the said Tadmor River and the Motupiko River to a point due west of the north-western corner of Section No. 87, Block XIII., Wai-iti Survey District; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of that section; thence by the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 87, and its production to the right bank of the Motueka River; thence by the said Motueka River to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 104, Block I., Wai-iti Survey District; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of that section; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 104 to its north-eastern corner; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Section No. 88 of the said Block I.; thence by Sections Nos. 89, 83, 25, 18, and 12 of Square 6, and 25 of Square 7, of the said Block I., and the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 10, to the easternmost corner of that section; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 139, Block II., of the said Wai-iti Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section and by Sections Nos. 109A, 111, 112, and 113, all of the said Block II., to the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 82, Block XV., Motueka Survey District; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Section No. 47, Block X., of the said Motueka Survey District; thence by the western boundary-line of that section and the western boundary-line of Section No. 45, the southern and western boundary-lines of Section No. 44, the southern and western boundary-lines of Section No. 43, and the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 42 and 41, all of the said Block X.; thence by Section No. 51, Block VI., of the said Motueka Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by a right line to the westernmost corner of Section No. 2 of B1; thence by the north-western boundary-line of that section to its northernmost corner; thence by Sections Nos. 2 of 33, 260, and 2 of 32 of Block VII. of the said Motueka Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 4 of 31, 253, 252, 251, 250, 249, 248, 247, and 246, all of Block III. of the said Motueka Survey District, to the Motueka River; and thence by the left bank of the said Motueka River to the ocean: including D'Urville, Arapawa, The Brothers, and adjacent islands, and Rabbit Island.

WAIRAU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Waimea-Picton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to White's Bay; thence towards the north-east by Cook Strait to Cape Campbell; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the Conway River; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Conway River to its source; thence by a right line to Palmer Saddle; thence towards the south by the boundary-line between the Provincial Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to the left bank of the Clarence River; thence by the said Clarence River to the confluence of the Acheron River with the said Clarence River; thence again towards the north-west by the said Acheron River to the confluence of the Guide River with the said Acheron River, and thence by the said Guide River to its source; thence by a right line to Barefell Pass; and thence again towards the south-west by a right line to Tophouse.

BULLER.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the ocean from the Buller River to the Cape Farewell Lighthouse; thence towards the north-east generally by Golden Bay and Tasman Bay to the Motueka River; thence towards the south-east generally by the Waimea-Picton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of the Hope River with the Buller River; thence towards the south-west by a right line to Mount Owen; thence again towards the south-east by the summit of the watershed between the Mokihini River and the Buller River and by the summit of the Lyell Range to the Buller River, opposite the mouth of Little Deepdale Stream; and thence towards the south and again towards the south-west generally by the said Buller River to the ocean: including Adele Island and adjacent islands, and the lighthouse at Cape Farewell.

INANGAHUA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Buller Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Buller River to Mount Owen; thence towards the north-east by the said Buller Electoral District and by the Waimea-Picton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the summit of the St. Arnaud Range; thence towards the south-east by the summit of the said St. Arnaud Range, the summit of the Spenser Range, and the summit of the main range leading to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Teremakau River; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the outflow of the Arnold River from Lake Brunner; thence by the said Arnold River to its confluence with the Grey River, and by a line across that river; thence again towards the south-east by the said Grey River to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 211, Square 119, in Block V., Cobden Survey District; thence towards the west generally by a right line to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 211; thence by that section and Section No. 118 of the said Block V.; thence by the crossing of a road and by Sections Nos. 167 and 166, the crossing of a road, and by Section No. 123, all of the said Block V., to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 17 of the said Block V.; thence by a right line across a road to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 17; thence by that section and its eastern boundary-line produced across a road to Section No. 15; thence by the said Section No. 15, and Section No. 16, to the north-eastern corner of the said Section No. 16; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 14 of Block III.; thence by the eastern boundary-line of that section produced to Coal Creek, and thence by the said Coal Creek to its source; thence by a right line to the nearest spur leading to the main range; thence by the summit of the dividing-range between the Grey River and the West Coast to a point due east of another point on the right bank of Seven-mile Creek, the latter point being in line with the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 13 of Block III. of the said Cobden Survey District; thence towards the south generally by a line due west to the said Seven-mile Creek, and thence by that creek to the ocean; thence again towards the west and towards the north by the ocean to the Buller River.

GREY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Inangahua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the ocean to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Teremakau River; thence towards the south by a right line to the source of the last-named river; thence by the left bank of that river to the mouth of the Waimea Creek; thence again towards the north-east by that creek to the road which forms the northern boundary of Section No. 1379, Block I., Tur-whate Survey District; thence again towards the south generally by that road and its continuation in a westerly direction to the road which forms the south-western boundary of Section No. 1356, Block IV., Kanieri Survey

District; thence towards the west by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a northerly direction to the road which forms the south-western boundary of Section No. 1928, Block XVI., Waimea Survey District; thence towards the south-west by that road and its continuation in a north-westerly direction to the road which forms the north-western boundary of Section No. 1359 of the said Block XVI.; thence again towards the west by that road and its continuation in a northerly direction to the road which forms the western boundary of Reserve No. 128 (educational endowment); and thence by the last-mentioned road (known as the Kumara Road) to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 1931, Block XII., of the said Waimea Survey District; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 1931 to the road which forms its north-western boundary; thence by that road and its continuation and by the Kumara Borough Endowment (Reserve No. 203) to Section No. 1309 of the said Block XII.; thence again towards the north-east by the said Section 1309 and Sections Nos. 1308, 1307, 1181, 1180, 1179, and 1178, all of the said Block XII., to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section, and thence towards the north-west by that road and the production of its northern side to the said Teremakau River; thence again towards the south-west by the left bank of that river to the ocean; and thence towards the north-west by the ocean to Seven-mile Creek.

WESTLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and towards the north by the Grey Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the ocean to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and Teremakau River; thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Southern Alps to Mount Aspiring; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the mouth of the Awatara River in Big Bay; and thence towards the north-west by the ocean to the Teremakau River.

ASHLEY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Wairau Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to the mouth of the Conway River; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the Ashley River; thence towards the south by the said Ashley River to a right line drawn between Trig. Station 16, Mairaki Survey District, and the north-western corner of Section No. 9791 on the Mairaki Downs Road; thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the north-western corner of the said Section No. 9791; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 27370, Block VI., of the said Mairaki Survey District; thence by the eastern side of the road which forms the western boundary of that section and the eastern side of the road which intersects Section No. 11134; thence by the crossing of a road and by Sections Nos. 13684 and 15467 to the Oxford and Rangiora Railway-line; thence by a right line across that railway-line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 4643; thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of that section, and which forms also the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 23243, 14607, 19574, and 23164, and by that road produced to Section No. 18588; and thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section to the Eyre River; thence by a right line across that river to the northernmost corner of Section No. 13682, Block IX., of the said Mairaki Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 13682 and Sections Nos. 13681 and 15260 to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 23223; thence by the said Section No. 23223, the crossing of a road, and by Sections Nos. 30310, 33342, and 33451, and by the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced until it is intersected by a right line drawn from the northernmost corner of Section No. 30646, Block XIV., of the said Mairaki Survey District to Trig. Station 48 in Block XIII. of the said Mairaki Survey District; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the said Trig. Station 48; thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 32083 of Block IV., Hawkins Survey District, and thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of that section and the production of the western side of that road to the Waimakariri River; thence towards the south-west and west by that river to a line formerly known as the northern boundary-line of Run No. 270; thence towards the north by that boundary-line to the summit of the Puketirake Range; thence towards the north-west by the summit of that range to Ashley Head; thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the range leading over Esk Head and Snowy Peak to the source of the south branch of the Hurunui River; thence again towards the south by a line due west to the summit of the Southern Alps; thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, the

Inangahua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and the Waimea-Picton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Tophouse: including Section No. 32984, in the Waimakariri River, and the remainder of the island of which it forms a portion.

KAIAPOI.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Ashley Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the mouth of the Waimakariri River; thence towards the south and towards the south-east generally by the said Waimakariri River and its south branch to a point due east of the south-eastern corner of Section No. 560, Block III., Christchurch Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line to the said south-eastern corner; thence by the road which forms the southern boundary of that section; thence towards the south-west by the road which forms the south-western boundary of the said Section No. 560 and the south-western boundary of Section No. 738 of the said Block III. to the road which forms the southern boundary of Section No. 876; thence again towards the south-east and south-west by that road and the road which forms the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of Section No. 820 of the said Block III., and the production of the northern side of the last-mentioned road to Kaikaimui Creek; thence towards the north-west by that creek to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 1014 of the said Block III.; thence again towards the south-west by that road to Cherry Road; thence by the said Cherry Road and the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 1851, Block XV., Rangiora Survey District, to the north branch of the Waimakariri River; thence again towards the north-west generally by the north branch of the Waimakariri River to the Rangiora Main Drain and Road; thence again towards the south-west by the said Rangiora Main Drain and Road and the Oxford and Rangiora Road to the Oxford and Rangiora Railway-line; thence by a line across that railway-line, and thence by the said railway-line to a point due north from former Trig. Station C30, in the Rolleston Survey District; again towards the east by a line due south to the Waimakariri River (the last-mentioned line being the western boundary-line of the Road Districts of Eyreton and Mandeville); thence again towards the south by the said Waimakariri River; and again towards the north-west by the said Ashley Electoral District.

AVON.

This district is bounded towards the west and towards the north-east generally by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point on the left bank of the Waimakariri River, due north of former Trig. Station C30, in the Rolleston Survey District, to the mouth of the said Waimakariri River; thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the estuary of the Heathcote and the Avon Rivers; thence towards the south-west and towards the south-east by the said estuary to a point in line with the north-eastern side of the canal and road reserve; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to the said north-eastern side of the canal and road reserve, and thence by that reserve, and its north-eastern side produced across the River Avon Road, and the River Avon, to the left bank of that river; thence towards the south and towards the west by the said River Avon to the East Town Belt of the City of Christchurch; thence towards the west generally by the said East Town Belt, the North Avon Road, and Hill's Road to Shirley's Road; thence again towards the south-west by the said Shirley's Road to Innes Road; thence again towards the south-east by the said Innes Road to Papanui Road; thence again towards the north-east by the last-mentioned road to Aikman's Road; thence again towards the south-east by Aikman's Road to Boundary Road; thence again towards the north-east by the said Boundary Road to the road which forms the north-western boundary of original Rural Section No. 7, and thence again towards the south-east by that road and its northern side produced to the River Avon; thence again towards the south-west by that river, and by Rural Section No. 242 to its northernmost corner; thence by a right line across Norman's Road to the easternmost corner of Rural Section No. 453; thence by that section and Rural Section No. 2382 to Bligh's Road; thence again towards the south-east by the said Bligh's Road to Wairarapa Road; thence again towards the south-west by the said Wairarapa Road to the Kaiapoi Junction Road; thence again towards the west by the last-mentioned road to the Waimakariri River; thence again towards the south by the right bank of that river to a point due south of the westernmost point of McLean's Island; thence again towards the west by a line due north to that island; thence by the western and northern limits of the said McLean's Island to a point due north of former Trig. Station No. C30, in the Rolleston Survey District; and thence again towards the west by a line due north to the left bank of the said Waimakariri River.

CITY OF CHRISTCHURCH.

This district is bounded towards the north-west, towards the north-east, and towards the east by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Boundary Road to the River Avon at a point in line with the eastern side of the East Town Belt of the City of Christchurch; thence again towards the east by a right line across the said River Avon to the eastern side of the said East Town Belt, and thence by the eastern side aforesaid to the southern side of Ferry Road; thence again towards the north-east by the said Ferry Road to Wilson's Road; thence towards the south-east by that road to the road running along the Heathcote River, and known as Heathcote Terrace; thence by the said Heathcote Terrace to Tennyson Street; thence towards the south by the said Tennyson Street to Colombo Road; thence towards the west by the said Colombo Road to Strickland Street; thence towards the south-west by the said Strickland Street and its north-eastern side produced across the River Heathcote; thence by that river to Douglas Jerrold Street, and thence by the last-mentioned street to the Lower Lincoln Road; thence again towards the north-west by that road to Antigua Street, in the City of Christchurch; thence towards the west by the western side of the said Antigua Street to the said River Avon; thence again towards the west and south by that river to Boundary Road; and thence again towards the south-west by the said Boundary Road.

HEATHCOTE.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point on the left bank of the River Avon, in line with the eastern side of the East Town Belt of the City of Christchurch, to the estuary of the Heathcote and the Avon Rivers; thence by the said estuary and Pegasus Bay to Godley Head; thence towards the south by Lyttelton Harbour to the spur of the range running down from the Port Hills to the said Lyttelton Harbour immediately on the east side of Gollan's Bay; thence towards the west by the said spur (which forms the eastern boundary of the Borough of Lyttelton) to the summit of the said Port Hills; thence towards the south generally by the said Port Hills, over Mount Pleasant and Trig. Station EE, to the Raupaki Native Reserve (the said southern boundary being the northern boundary of the Borough of Lyttelton); thence towards the south-east by the summit of the said Port Hills to the western side of Dyer's Pass Road; thence towards the west by the western side of the said Dyer's Pass Road to Colombo Road, and thence by the western side of the latter road to Tennyson Street; thence again towards the north and towards the north-west generally by the City of Christchurch Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the place of commencement.

HALSWELL.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from West Boundary Road to Boundary Road at St. Albans; thence towards the east generally by the City of Christchurch Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and the Heathcote Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the summit of the Port Hills; thence by the summit of the said Port Hills to the south-eastern corner of Rural Section No. 1060; thence by the summit of the said Port Hills to the south-eastern corner of Rural Section No. 1093; thence by the eastern boundary-line of Rural Section No. 1863 and the south-eastern and southern boundary-lines of Rural Section No. 1901 to the Ahuriri Bush Road South; thence by the said road to its junction with the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Rural Section No. 1069; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of the said Rural Section No. 1069; thence by the south-eastern boundary-line of that section to the River Halswell; thence towards the south-west by the said River Halswell to the Ellesmere Junction Road; thence by that road to the Lincoln and Prebbleton Road; thence by the latter road to the Lincoln and Coal Tramway Road; thence by the last-mentioned road to the Weedon and Springs Road, and thence by the said Weedon and Springs Road to the road to Selwyn; thence towards the north-west by the said road to Selwyn, and by Shand's Road to Hampton's Road; thence again towards the south-west by that road to the Main South Road; thence towards the south-east by the said Main South Road to Curragh's Road at the south-western boundary of Reserve 871, Block XVI., Rolleston Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the last-mentioned road to Newton's and Coal Tramway Road; thence again towards the north-west by that road to Dawson's and Waimakariri Road; thence again towards the south-west by Dawson's and Waimakariri Road to West Boundary Road; and thence again towards the north-west by the said West Boundary Road to the Waimakariri River.

AKAROA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east, the east, and the south by the ocean, from Godley Head to Taumutu, at the entrance to Lake Ellesmere; thence towards the north-west by a right line to the outflow of the River Halswell in Lake Ellesmere; thence towards the west generally by the said River Halswell to the south-eastern boundary-line of Rural Section No. 1069, and thence again towards the north-west by the Halswell Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and thence towards the north by the Heathcote Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the said Godley Head.

SELWYN.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and east generally by the Ashley Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the north by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described; again towards the east and the north-east generally by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and the Halswell Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and again towards the east by the Akaroa Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Lake Ellesmere; thence towards the south-west by the said Lake Ellesmere and the River Selwyn to the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 22385, Block II., Selwyn Survey District; thence again towards the south-east by a right line across the said River Selwyn to the easternmost corner of Section No. 10646 of the said Block II.; thence by the southern boundary-line of the said Section No. 10646 to Section No. 4084 of the said Block II.; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 4084 to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by a right line to a point on the southern side of Dunsandel Road in line with the western side of the road which forms the western boundary of Section No. 29306 of the said Selwyn Survey District; thence by the road leading to the last-mentioned road, and thence by that road and its continuation to Sharlund's Road; thence towards the south by the said Sharlund's Road to the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 30752, Block VII., Hall Survey District; thence again towards the east generally by the last-mentioned road, and by the road which forms the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 28944 and 30070 of the said Block VII., and which forms also the eastern boundary of Reserve No. 2458, to the Rakaia Terrace Road; thence by the said Rakaia Terrace Road to Section No. 31064, Block IX., Selwyn Survey District; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 31066, 21189, 14728, 26946, 14727, and 33572 to the Rakaia River; thence again towards the south-west by that river to its source near Whitcombe's Pass; thence again towards the south by a line due west to the summit of the Southern Alps; and thence towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described.

ELLESMERE.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Selwyn Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the Akaroa Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and by the ocean; towards the south-west generally by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 27206, Block VIII., Wakanui Survey District, and by that road continued through Reserve No. 1999; thence by the road which forms the north-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 25267, 25223, 25169, 25159, and 26624, 26754, 27069, 26729, 26921, and 26726, to the road which forms the north-western boundary of Section No. 26716; thence by that road, and the road which forms the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 26735, 27147, and 26734, to the road which forms the north-western boundary of the said Section No. 26734; thence by the said Section No. 26734 and Sections Nos. 27292 and 26673 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 26673 produced across Reserves Nos. 1774 and 1770 to Section No. 27353; thence by the said Section No. 27353 to its northernmost corner; thence by a right line to the westernmost corner of Section No. 6502; thence by the road which forms the southern boundary of Section No. 27031 and by the road which forms the southern boundaries of Section Nos. 27388 and 27494 of Reserves Nos. 2186 and 2187, and of Sections Nos. 28221, 28220, and 27907, to Winchmore Road; thence by that road to Reserve No. 1123 in Block III., Westerfield Survey District; thence by Section No. 34165 and its north-western boundary-line produced to the north branch of the Ashburton River; thence by the said north branch and by Boundary Creek to the source of the said creek near Mount Taylor; thence by a right line to the said Mount Taylor; and thence by Runs Nos. 115 and 117 to the mouth of Lake Stream, in the Rakaia River.

ASHBURTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the Selwyn and the Ellesmere Electoral Districts respectively,

hereinbefore described, from the Southern Alps to the ocean; towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Rangitata River; thence towards the south-west by the said Rangitata River to the confluence of Forest Creek with that river; thence again towards the south-east by the said Forest Creek to Run No. 77; thence towards the west generally by that run to The Thumbs; thence by the summit of the watershed over Alma Peak to the Southern Alps; and thence towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described.

GERALDINE.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east by the Ashburton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Run No. 77 to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Opihi River; thence towards the south by the right bank of that river to the road which forms the eastern boundary of Rural Section No. 21601 (Stonyer's Road); thence towards the east by that road and its continuation to the Albury Railway-line; thence by a line across that railway-line; thence again towards the north-east by the said railway-line to a point opposite to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 14449; thence again towards the south-east generally by a right line to the said south-eastern corner; thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of the said Rural Section No. 14449, and the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 12740, 12622, 12585, 12529, 12725, 12817, 15049, 18975, 15926, and 18045; thence by the road which forms the southern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 18045 (aforesaid) and 15904, by the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 17811, 19165, 19454, 19427, 19222, 18561, and 23283, by the road which intersects Rural Section No. 18558, and by that road continued in a south-westerly direction through Rural Sections Nos. 18559, 19552, and 19553, and passing Rural Sections Nos. 25600, 21782, and 29557, and through Rural Sections Nos. 23303 and 18688 to the road known as Tycho Flat Road; thence towards the east by the said Tycho Flat Road to its junction with the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Rural Section No. 18872; thence again towards the south-west generally by the last-mentioned road, and its continuation past Rural Sections Nos. 18873, 21787, 25538, 20970, and through Rural Section No. 3277, to Rural Section No. 20634; thence by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the said Rural Section No. 20634, and which forms also the north-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 28826, 20635, 28824, and 20636, and by the road which forms the north-western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 25597 and 28825, the southern and western boundary-lines of Section No. 20259, the south-western boundary-lines of Rural Sections Nos. 28532 and 20257, and the south-eastern boundary-line of Rural Section No. 28533, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Rural Section No. 28821; thence by that section and Rural Sections Nos. 30443, 28462, and 21213, to the road which forms the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by the road which intersects Rural Section No. 16285 to the western boundary-line of Rural Section No. 2440; thence by the western and northern boundary-lines of that section, and the north-western boundary-lines of Rural Sections Nos. 33833, 26284, and 21990, and the southern and western boundary-lines of Rural Section No. 5209, all of Pareora Survey District, to the Tengawai River; thence by a right line across that river to the south-eastern corner of Rural Section No. 5394; thence by the said Tengawai River to the road which intersects Section No. 11607; thence by that road and the road which intersects Rural Sections Nos. 11606 and 11608, and by Rural Section No. 20518 to the Opihi River; thence by the right bank of the said Opihi River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Rural Section No. 30438; thence by a right line across the said Opihi River to the southernmost corner of the said Section No. 30438; thence towards the north-west by that section and Rural Sections Nos. 30437, 30454, 19949, 20209, and 25368 to the confluence of the south branch of the Opuha River with the north branch of the Opuha River; thence again towards the south-west by the said south branch, and by the south-western boundary-line of Run No. 15, to Two-thumb Range; thence again towards the north-west generally by that range and Run No. 77 to Forest Creek.

TIMARU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the Geraldine Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Rural Section No. 18872 to the ocean; towards the south-east by the ocean to a point due east of the mouth of the Otipua Creek; thence towards the south by a right line to the mouth of that creek; thence towards the south-west by the said Otipua Creek to the road which forms the north-western

boundary of Rural Section No. 1690; thence again towards the south generally by that road and its continuation through Rural Sections Nos. 2407 and 3753, and past Sections Nos. 8167, 8838, 9635, 9743, 10702, 12244, 12464, 15736, 15928, 14376, 15803, 14784, 15520, 15801, 15800, 15790, 15757, and 12711, to the road which forms the western boundary of Rural Section No. 16050; thence again towards the south-west generally by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a generally northerly direction past Rural Sections Nos. 15800, 15652, 15661, 15656, 16087, 15860, 21989, 25492, 20764, 25882, and 25533 to the road at the north-eastern boundary of Rural Section No. 18872.

WAIMATE.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the north-east generally by the Ashburton, the Geraldine, and the Timaru Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the ocean to the mouth of the Waitaki River; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Waitaki River to the confluence of the Ohau River with the said Waitaki River; thence by the said Ohau River and by Ohau Lake to the mouth of the Hopkins River, and thence by the said Hopkins River to its source; and thence by a line due north to the summit of the Southern Alps.

OAMARU.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the Waimate Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Kakanui River; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Kakanui River to Section No. 24, Block VII., Oamaru Survey District; thence towards the west generally by the said Section No. 24, and Sections Nos. 23, 21, 19, and 15 (Quarry Reserve), to the road which forms part of the eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 13 and 1 of the said Block VII., and by the road which forms part of the south-eastern boundary of Application No. 3317A, to the Waiareka Creek; thence by the said Waiareka Creek to Section No. 45, Block IX., Awamoko Survey District; thence by the road which forms the southern boundary of that section, and by the road which forms the western boundaries of Section No. 45 (aforesaid), a reserve, and Section No. 44, and which forms the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 43, 15, 14, 13, 12, 5, and 4, all of the said Block IX., to the road which intersects Section No. 21, Block V., of the said Awamoko Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation through Section No. 22 of the said Block V. to the eastern boundary of the said Section No. 22; thence by Section No. 22 aforesaid and Sections Nos. 20, 12, 27, and 19 of the said Block V., and Sections Nos. 22, 14, 5, 9, and 12, all of Block II., of the said Awamoko Survey District, and by the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the left bank of the Waitaki River.

WAITAKI.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and east generally by the Waimate and the Oamaru Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of Pleasant River; thence towards the south-west by the said Pleasant River to the Main South Road; thence again towards the east generally by the said Main South Road to Subdivision No. 28 of Section No. 16, Block VI., Hawksbury Survey District; thence by the said Subdivision No. 28 and Subdivisions Nos. 27, 26, 25, 24, 23, 2A, and 1A of the said Section No. 16 to the Main South Road; thence by that road to the Waikouaiti River; thence towards the south generally by the said Waikouaiti River and its north branch to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Pre-emptive Right Section No. 1, Hummockside Survey District; thence by a right line to the north-eastern boundary-line of that pre-emptive-right section; and thence by that boundary-line and by Section No. 5, Block IV., Hummockside Survey District, and Sections Nos. 8 and 4 of the said Block IV. to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the north-west generally by Runs Nos. 171F, 171, 171C, and 121A to Little Hummock; thence by a right line to the source of Back Creek, and thence towards the north by that creek to the said Waikouaiti River; thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Waikouaiti River to Run No. 109B; thence by that run and Run No. 109A to Deepdell Creek, at the north-western corner of Section No. 2, Block VI., Waihemmo Survey District; thence towards the north-west by the said Deepdell Creek to its confluence with the Shag River; thence towards the north and north-east generally by the said Shag River to the confluence of the Happy Valley Creek with that river; thence towards the west generally by the said Happy Valley Creek and Section No. 8, Block VIII., Waihemmo Survey District, and by Run No. 255, to the summit of

the Horse Range; thence by the summit of that range and the summit of the Kakanui Mountains through the Maruwhenua Pass to Kyeburn Hill; thence by the summit of the main range leading to Mount Ida, and thence by the summit of the Hawkdun Mountains to a point due east of Mount St. Bathans; thence by a line drawn due west to the said Mount St. Bathans; thence by the summit of the range through the Lindis Pass to Longslip Hill; thence by the summit of the range leading to the watershed between the Rivers Ahuriri and Hunter; and thence by that watershed and the watershed between the said River Hunter and the Hopkins River to the Hunter Saddle; and thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described.

MOUNT IDA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Mount St. Bathans to the north-western corner of Section No. 4, Block IV., Hummockside Survey District; thence towards the south by Runs Nos. respectively 171A, 171B, and 218 to a right line drawn from Silver Peak to the Hummock (Trig. Station D); thence again towards the north-east by a right line to the said Silver Peak; thence by a right line to Trig. Station S (Swampy Hill); thence again towards the south by Blocks V., IV., and III. of Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 19, 18, 17, 15, 14, 2 of 13, 1 of 13, 11, 10, 9, and 8 of Block II. of the said Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and by the northern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced across the Taieri River; thence by the said Taieri River to the confluence of the Lee Stream with that river; thence by the said Lee Stream to its source; thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of the watershed between the Waipori River and Deep Stream, and by the summit of the Lammerlaw Range and the summit of the watershed to the Knobby Range, and thence by the summit of the said Knobby Range to a point due east of Rocky Mount; thence again towards the south by a right line to the said Rocky Mount; thence towards the west by the summit of the Garvie Mountains and the summit of the Carrick Range to Run No. 390A; thence towards the north by the said Run No. 390A and Run No. 325A to the Clutha River; thence again towards the west by the right bank of that river to a point due west of the confluence of Leaning Rock Creek with the said Clutha River; thence towards the north by a right line to the said confluence, and thence again towards the north-west by the said Leaning Rock Creek to its source; thence by a right line to Leaning Rock Hill; thence by the summit of the Dunstan Mountains to Run No. 238; thence by that run and by Runs Nos. 237E and 226B to Lauder Creek; thence by the said Lauder Creek to its source; thence by a right line to a peak (geodesical station) between the Dunstan Pass and Dunstan Peak; and thence by a right line to Mount St. Bathans.

PORT CHALMERS.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the north-western corner of Section No. 4, Block IV., Hummockside Survey District, to the mouth of Pleasant River; thence towards the south-east generally by the ocean and the Otago Harbour to the south-western corner of Section No. 51, Block IX., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence towards the north-east by that section to its southern corner; thence again towards the north-west by a right line to Trig. Station E, in the said Block IX.; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 37 of the said Block IX.; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Section No. 37 and Sections Nos. 36 and 33 to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 82 of the North-east Valley Survey District; thence by a right line intersecting the said Section No. 33 to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 82; thence by that section to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 83 of the said North-east Valley Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 82 produced across that road to the said Section No. 83, and thence by that section to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 43, Block VII., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 83 produced across that road; thence by the said Section No. 43 to its northernmost corner; thence towards the west by Sections Nos. 48 and 60, Block VIII., of the said North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 8, 23, 22, 3, 4, 5, 15, 2, 1, 6, 13 (E.R.), 14, 12, and 9, all of Block XII. of the said North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, to the north-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the south by the said Section No. 9 and Sections Nos. 10, 11, and 16 of the said Block XII. to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 16 produced across a road to Section

No. 7, Block III. of the said North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence again towards the west by the said Section No. 7 and Sections Nos. 6 and 3 of the said Block III. to the Waitate; thence towards the south-east by that stream to its source east of Trig. Station S (Swampy Hill), and thence by a right line to the said Trig. Station S; and thence again towards the south-west and north by the Mount Ida Electoral District, hereinbefore described: including the islands in Otago Harbour and in Blueskin Bay.

PENINSULA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Otago Harbour; towards the east and south generally by the ocean to the road which forms the eastern boundary of the Township of St. Clair (Forbury Road); thence towards the south-west by that road to original Section No. 13, Block VI., Town Survey District; thence towards the north-west by the said Section No. 13 to Surrey Road, in the Township of South Dunedin; thence by the crossing of the said Surrey Road to Cargill Road, and thence by the said Cargill Road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of original Section No. 18, Block VII., Town Survey District; thence again towards the south-west generally by a right line to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 18, and thence by that section to the road which forms its northern boundary; thence by that road to the Main South Road; thence again towards the north-west generally by that road to the boundary-line of the Town Belt of the City of Dunedin; thence by the said Town Belt and the Southern Recreation-grounds of said City of Dunedin, and by a line being the said boundary-line of the Town Belt produced across the Anderson's Bay Road to the north-eastern corner of the Borough of Caversham; thence towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Borough of Caversham to the Borough of South Dunedin; and thence again towards the north-west and north-east by the north-western and north-eastern boundary-lines of the said Borough of South Dunedin to the said Otago Harbour.

CITY OF DUNEDIN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west, towards the north-east, and towards the south-east respectively by the north-western, the north-eastern, and the south-eastern boundary-lines of the City of Dunedin, as specified in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 101, 20th December, 1877, from the easternmost corner of original Section No. 6, Block I., Upper Kaikorai Survey District, to the Borough of Caversham; thence again towards the south-east generally by the Peninsula Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 5, Block VI., Town Survey District; thence towards the south-west by that section; thence again towards the south-east and south-west by the said Section No. 5 and Sections Nos. 6 and 7, by the crossing of a road, and Sections Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 18, 19, 22, 23, 26, 27, and 30 of the said Block VI., to the road which forms the western boundary of Section No. 59 of the said Block VI. (Elgin Road); thence towards the west by that road to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of original Section No. 53 of the said Block VI.; thence again towards the south-west by a right line across the said road to the north-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by that section to the northern side of a district road known as Hawthorn Road; thence by the northern side of that road to Section No. 21, Lower Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards the north-west by the said Section No. 21, and Sections Nos. 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2 of the said Lower Kaikorai Survey District to the Kaikorai Valley Road; thence by the said Kaikorai Valley Road to its junction with the main road leading from Dunedin to North Taieri; thence again towards the south-west by the last-mentioned road to the Waikari Road; thence again towards the north-west by the said Waikari Road to Section No. 103, Waikari Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by that section to its southernmost corner; thence again towards the north-west by said Section No. 103, and Sections Nos. 102, 101, and 100 of the said Waikari Survey District, to the road which forms the south-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, and 9 of Block II., Upper Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by that road to the road which forms the north-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 8 and 7 of Block I., Upper Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards the south-east by the last-mentioned road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 6 of the said Block I.; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 6; and thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of that section to the Town Belt of the City of Dunedin.

hereinbefore described; towards the south generally by the City of Dunedin Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the said City of Dunedin Electoral District and the Peninsula Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south by the ocean; towards the south-west by the road which forms the south-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 58, 59, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, and 99, all of Ocean Beach Suburban Survey District, and by the eastern side of that road produced to Section No. 18, Green Island Bush Survey District; thence by that section and the eastern boundary-line thereof produced across a road to Section No. 57, Lower Kaikorai Survey District; thence towards the north-west generally by the said Section No. 57 and Sections Nos. 56, 55, and 54 of the said Lower Kaikorai Survey District to the Main South Road; thence by a right line across that road to the southernmost corner of Section No. 66 of the said Lower Kaikorai Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 66 to the Southern Trunk Railway-line; thence by that railway-line to the Kaikorai Valley Road; thence by the western side of that road to Section No. 81 of the said Lower Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards the south-west generally by Section No. 32 to the road intersecting Section No. 45, Block VI., Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District; thence by that road to the road which forms the north-western boundary of the said Section No. 45; thence by the last-mentioned road and the road which forms the south-western boundary of Section No. 47 of the said Block VI. to the road at the southern boundary of Section No. 46 of the said Block VI.; thence towards the west generally by that road and its continuation to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 2 of 49 of the said Block VI.; thence by Sections Nos. 68 and 57 of the said Block VI. to the north-eastern corner of the said Section No. 57; thence again towards the south and west generally by the said Block VI. to the northernmost corner of Section No. 65 of that block; thence again towards the north-east and north-west by Block V., Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, to the easternmost corner of Section No. 2 of 40 of the said Block V.; thence again towards the south-west by the said Section No. 2 of 40 and Sections Nos. 2 of 38 and 61, all of the said Block V., and thence again towards the north-west generally by Sections Nos. 4 of 49, 3 of 49, 2 of 50, 51, 1 of 52, 53, 54, 55, all of the said Block V., the crossing of a road, and by Sections Nos. 9, 10, and 11 of the said Block V., the crossing of a road, and by Section No. 3, to Swampy Hill.

TAIERI.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Mount Ida Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east generally by the Dunedin Suburbs Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Taieri River; towards the south-west generally by the said Taieri River to Waipori Lake; thence by the said Waipori Lake to the Waipori River; thence by the said Waipori River to the western boundary of the Maungatua Survey District; thence towards the west by a line drawn due north to a point due west of Trig. Station F, Maungatua Survey District; thence towards the north by a right line to the said Trig. Station F; thence again towards the west by a line drawn due north to Section No. 2 (pre-emptive right), Block VIII., Maungatua Survey District; and thence again towards the north by the said Section No. 2 and Section No. 3 of the said Block VIII., and by the south-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 3 produced to the left bank of Lee Stream: including Green Island and adjacent islands, and Taieri Island.

BRUCE.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Crook Burn from its confluence with the Clutha River to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 13, Block XI., Waitahuna West Survey District; thence by that road, and the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 14 and 15 of the said Block XI., and by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 10, and the southern boundaries of Sections Nos. 9 and 8, Block IX., of the said Waitahuna West Survey District, to the road which forms the north-western boundary of Section No. 15 of the said Block IX.; thence by that road to the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 15; thence towards the north-east by Section No. 1 of the said Block IX., and by Sections Nos. 1, 2, 3, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18, Block VII., of the said Waitahuna West Survey District, and the south-western boundary-line of last-mentioned section produced to the Waitahuna River; thence again towards the north-west by that river to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 6, Block VII., Waitahuna East Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 6; thence again towards the north-west by the said Section No. 6, and Sections Nos. 9 and 80, a road, and Sections Nos. 1,

82, and 81, all of the said Block VII., by a road fronting Section No. 2, and by Section No. 10, Block X., of the said Waitahuna East Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by the last-mentioned section, and by Section No. 44 of the said Block X., to the Waitahuna River; and thence again towards the north-west by that river to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 1, Block IX., Waipori Survey District; thence towards the north-east by a right line to that boundary-line; thence by the said northern boundary-line to Waitahuna Hill, and thence by the summit of the watershed over Trig. Stations K, J, and G of the said Waipori Survey District to the north-western boundary-line of the West Taieri Hundred, and thence again towards the north-west by that boundary-line to the left bank of the Waipori River; thence again towards the north-east generally by the Taieri Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Koau Branch of the Clutha River; and thence towards the south-west generally by the said Koau Branch and the Clutha River to the south-eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Balclutha; thence by the said Borough of Balclutha to the said Clutha River; and thence again towards the south-west by that river to the mouth of the said Crook Burn.

CLUTHA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the Argyle Burn from its confluence with the Wakaia River to the southern boundary of Switzer's Commonage; thence towards the north by the said commonage to the Umbrella Mountains; thence again towards the north-east and north-west by the summit of the said Umbrella Mountains to Black Umbrella (Trig. Station K); thence by the summit of the range to the source of Leithen River; thence by that river to its confluence with the Pomahaka River; thence by the said Pomahaka River to the confluence of Back Creek with that river; thence by the said Back Creek to a point due west of Trig. Station D, Rangleburn Survey District; thence again towards the north by a line due east to the left bank of the Clutha River; thence again towards the north-east generally by the left bank of the said Clutha River to Crook Burn; thence by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to Chasland's Mistake; thence towards the west generally by a right line to Black Horn; thence by the summit of the watershed over Bleak Hill, the Chimney, and Flower-pot to Catlin's Cone; thence by a right line to the source of the Waipahi River in Section No. 1, Block XI., Kuriwao Survey District; thence by the said Waipahi River to where it is crossed by the main road from Dunedin to Invercargill; thence towards the south by that road to the Town District of Maitara; thence by that town district to the Maitara River; thence again towards the north-west by that river to the confluence of the Waikaka River with the said Maitara River; thence by the said Waikaka River to a point due south of the easternmost corner of Section No. 16, Block XXV., of the Town of East Gore; thence towards the west by a line due north to the north side of Talbot Street, in the said town; thence again towards the south by the said Talbot Street to Section No. 3 of Block XXIV. of the said Town of East Gore; thence by the said Section No. 3 and Sections Nos. 2 and 1 of the said Block XXIV. to Wentworth Street, and thence by the crossing of that street and by Boundary Road to the said Maitara River; thence again towards the south-west generally by that river to the mouth of the Wakaia River; and thence again towards the north-west by the said Wakaia River to the mouth of the said Argyle Burn.

TUAPEKA.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east by the Mount Ida Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the Taieri Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-west generally by the Clutha Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the summit of the Black Umbrella Mountains at the south-east corner of the Switzer's Commonage; and thence towards the north-west by the summit of the said Umbrella Mountains to a point due east of Rocky Mount.

MATAURA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Clutha Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Wakaia River to the ocean; towards the south by the ocean to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Block VII., Invercargill Hundred; thence towards the west by a right line to the said western boundary-line of Block VII., and thence by that boundary-line to Block V. of the said Invercargill Hundred; thence towards the north-west by the said Block V. and Block VI. of the said Invercargill Hundred to the eastern boundary-line of the latter block; thence towards the south-west by the said

Block VI., and Blocks XI., XII., and XVIII. of the said Invercargill Hundred, to the Makarewa River; thence towards the north-west by that river to the north-western corner of Section No. 190, Forest Hill Hundred; thence towards the north by a line due east for a distance of 174 chains; thence towards the west by a line due north for a distance of 200 chains; thence again towards the north-west by a line bearing N. 45° E. to the eastern boundary-line of the said Forest Hill Hundred; again towards the west by the Forest Hill Hundred aforesaid; again towards the south by the said Forest Hill Hundred to Lora Stream; thence again towards the north-west generally by the said Lora Stream to Run No. 148A; thence by the said Run No. 148A, and by the western boundary-line of Run No. 119A, to Cowan's Creek; thence by the said Cowan's Creek to its confluence with the Waimea Stream; thence by the said Waimea Stream to its confluence with the Longridge Stream; and thence by the last-mentioned stream to Section No. 512, Hokonui Survey District; thence towards the north by that section and Section No. 42, and by the road which forms the north-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 625, 626, 627, 628, 629, and 198 of the said Hokonui Survey District, to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the north-east by that road and its continuation to the easternmost corner of Section No. 148, and thence again towards the north by a right line to the westernmost corner of Section No. 202 of the said Hokonui Survey District; thence by Sections Nos. 639, 150, 541, 567, 40, and 511, all of the said Hokonui Survey District, and by the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the left bank of the Maitaura River; and thence again towards the north-east by the left bank of that river to the mouth of the Wakaia Stream.

WAKATIPU.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east by the Mount Ida, the Tuapeka, and the Clutha Electoral Districts, respectively hereinbefore described; towards the south by the Maitaura Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-west by the Maitaura River to the confluence of the Tomogalak Stream with that river; thence by the said Tomogalak Stream to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Run No. 207; thence towards the south by a right line across the said Tomogalak Stream to the north-eastern corner of the said Run No. 207; thence by that run and Section No. 154, Hokonui Survey District, to the Oreti River; thence again towards the south-west and towards the west by the said Oreti River to a point due west of Hummock Peak; thence towards the north by a right line to Hummock Peak; thence again towards the west generally by the summit of the watershed over Mount Lookup and the Thomson Mountains to a line drawn between Round Peak and Moffat Peak; thence again towards the south by a right line to Moffat Peak; thence by a right line to Mount Eglinton; thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the Earl Mountains to a point in line with the Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass; thence again towards the south-west by a right line over the said Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass to Bligh Sound, and thence by the said Bligh Sound to the ocean; and thence again towards the north-west by the ocean.

WALLACE.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Wakatipu Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south-east generally by the Maitaura Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the road which forms the south-western boundary of Section No. 340, Hokonui Survey District; thence towards the south-west by that road and its continuation in a north-westerly direction through Section No. 215 of the said Hokonui Survey District, crossing Taylor's Stream and the Otupiri Stream, and through Sections Nos. 273, 345, and 335, along the south-western boundary of Section No. 336, and through Sections Nos. 711 and 426, all of the said Hokonui Survey District, to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 365; thence by that road and its continuation in a westerly direction across the Winton Stream, and through Section No. 256, along the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 316, and through Section No. 136A, to the Benmore Railway-station, on the Invercargill-Kingston Railway-line; thence towards the east by that railway-line to the Township of Limehills; thence towards the south by that township and the southern boundary-line of Section No. 86 of the said Hokonui Survey District, and by that boundary-line produced across the said Oreti River; thence by the Oreti Hundred to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, Oreti Hundred; thence again towards the east generally by Section No. 63, and the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, and that road continued through Section No. 62 of the said Oreti Hundred to the western boundary of the said Section No. 62; thence by the eastern side of that road to Section

No. 108; thence towards the south by the said Section No. 108, and Sections Nos. 107 and 44, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the east by the said Section No. 44, and Sections Nos. 43, 80, 86, 89, 90, 91, 94, and 95, all of the said Oreti Hundred, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the south by the New River Hundred to the Waimatuku Stream; thence again towards the east by the left bank of that stream to the ocean; and thence again towards the south and towards the west by the ocean.

INVERCARGILL.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Waihopai River; towards the east and north by part of Section No. 26, Block I., Invercargill Hundred (being the eastern and northern boundary-lines of the Borough of Gladstone), to the road which forms the western boundary of Section No. 36, Block I., Invercargill Hundred; thence again towards the east by that road to a point in line with the southern boundary-line of the said Section No. 36; thence again towards the north by a right line to the southern boundary-line of that section; thence by the said Section No. 36 and Sections Nos. 37 and 38 of the said Block I. to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Section No. 35 of the said Block I.; thence again towards the east by a right line across a road to the said western boundary-line; thence by the said Section No. 35 and Section 34 of the said Block I.; again towards the north by the said Section No. 34 to Section No. 6 of the said Block I.; thence towards the north-east by the said Section No. 6; thence towards the south-east by Sections Nos. 5, 4, and 3 of the said Block I.; thence again towards the north-east by the last-mentioned Section to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 2; thence again towards the south-east and south by that road and East Road to the road which forms the western boundary of Section No. 8 of the said Block I.; thence again towards the east by the eastern side of that road to the road which forms the southern boundary of the said section No. 8; thence again towards the north by the last-mentioned road to Section No. 17 of the said Block I.; thence again towards the east by the said Section No. 17 and Section No. 34; thence again towards the north by the said Section No. 34 and Sections Nos. 35, 36B, 37B, and 38 of Block XIX., Invercargill Hundred; thence again towards the east by the road which forms the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 4, 7, 11, and 15 of Block XXII. to the Seaward Bush Railway Reserve; thence towards the south-west by that railway reserve to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 57 of the said Block XIX.; thence again towards the south by a right line to the said northern boundary-line; thence by the said Section No. 57 and its northern boundary-line produced across a road to Section No. 45 of the said Block XIX.; thence towards the west by the said Section No. 45; thence again towards the south by that section and Section No. 39 of the said Block XIX. and the northern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced across a road to Section No. 7, Block III., Invercargill Hundred; thence again towards the west and south by the said Section No. 7 and its northern boundary-line produced to the New River Estuary; and thence again towards the west by the said New River Estuary to the mouth of the Waihopai River.

AWARUA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by the Wallace Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east generally by the Maitaura Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; towards the south-west by the ocean; again towards the north-west, towards the north, and towards the west by the New River Estuary and the Invercargill Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the south by the said Invercargill Electoral District; again towards the east by the New River Estuary; and again towards the south-west by the ocean: including Stewart Island, Centre Island, Dog Island, and all adjacent islands.
