FOREIGN JURISDICTION CONSOLIDATION BILL.-MEMO-RANDUM.

THE object of this Bill is to consolidate the Foreign Jurisdic

The object of this Bill is to consolidate the Foreign Jurisdiction Acts, with such amendments only as are necessarily incidental to the process of consolidation. The amendments appear from the following notes:—

Section 4. The words "or held under the authority of Her Majesty" are added to include Courts established under the Foreign Jurisdiction Acts.

Section 5. "The Evidence by Commission Act, 1885," has been added to the Acts comprised in the Schedule to "The Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1878," as being an enactment amending the Acts in that Schedule.

Section 6. Words have been added giving power to define, by Order in Council, what is meant by the expression "supreme criminal Court."

Section 7. In consequence of the alteration of the law with respect to penal servitude, sections 5 and 6 of "The Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1843," cannot be exactly reproduced. The new section reproduces in substance the power Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1843," cannot be exactly reproduced. The new section reproduces in substance the power given by those sections of removing offenders for punishment, but substitutes the machinery provided by the more recent Colonial Prisoners' Removal Act of 1869.

ment, but substitutes the machinery provided by the more recent Colonial Prisoners' Removal Act of 1869.

Section 12. This section sets out the provisions of 28 and 29 Vict., c. 63, instead of applying them by reference.

Sections 17, 18. The Acts 24 and 25 Vict., c. 31, as to territories near Sierra Leone, and 26 and 27 Vict., c. 35, as to certain portions of South Africa, are practically superseded by section 5 of "The Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1878" (41 and 42 Vict., c. 67), which would extend to the whole of Africa, and not merely to the limited portions mentioned in the above Acts. Accordingly an Order in Council could at any time supersede the provisions of those Acts. The Act 20 and 21 Vict., c. 75, as to Siam, would have been unnecessary if the Order in Council to which it referred had been made since since the passing of the latter Act, 29 and 30 Vict., c. 87, s. 1 (reproduced by section 9). The amending Act, 33 and 34 Vict., c. 55, merely declared what Court was to exercise jurisdiction under the previous Order in Council. Accordingly it is proposed to repeal all these Acts as Acts, but to leave them in force as if they were Orders in Council issued under the present Bill. A precedent for this course may be found in 37 and 38 Vict., c. 29, s. 3.

Sections 6 and 7 of "The Pacific Islanders Protection Act, 1875" (38 and 39 Vict., c. 51), are in much the same position; but, as the powers given by section 6 were mostly to be exercised by Orders in Council, slightly different language is required.

CHAPTER 37.

An Act to consolidate the Foreign Jurisdiction Acts. [4th August, 1890.

WHEREAS by treaty, capitulation, grant, usage, sufferance, and other lawful means, Her Majesty the Queen has jurisdiction within divers foreign countries, and it is expedient to consolidate the Acts relating to the exercise of Her Ma-

jesty's jurisdiction out of her dominions:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

Exercise of jurisdiction in foreign country.

1. It is and shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen to hold, exercise, and enjoy any jurisdiction which Her Majesty now has or may at any time hereafter have within a foreign country in the same and as ample a manner as if Her Majesty had acquired that jurisdiction by the cession or conquest of territory.

Exercise of jurisdiction over British subjects in countries without regular governments.

2. Where a foreign country is not subject to any government from whom Her Majesty the Queen might obtain jurisdiction in the manner recited by this Act, Her Majesty shall by virtue of this Act have jurisdiction over Her Majesty's subjects for the time being resident in or resorting to that country, and that jurisdiction shall be jurisdiction of Her Majesty in a foreign country within the meaning of the other provisions of this Act. other provisions of this Act.

Validity of acts done in pursuance of jurisdiction.

3. Every act and thing done in pursuance of any jurisdiction of Her Majesty in a foreign country shall be as valid as if it had been done according to the local law then in force in that country.

Evidence as to existence or extent of jurisdiction in foreign country.

4. (1.) If in any proceeding, civil or criminal, in a Court in Her Majesty's dominions, or held under the authority of Her Majesty, any question arises as to the existence or extent of any jurisdiction of Her Majesty in a foreign country, a Secretary of State shall, on the application of the Court, send to the Court within a reasonable time his decision on the question, and his decision shall for the purposes of the proceeding he final.

(2.) The Court shall send to the Secretary of State, in a document under the seal of the Court, or signed by a Judge of the Court, questions framed so as properly to raise the question, and sufficient answers to those questions shall be returned by the Secretary of State to the Court, and those answers shall, on production thereof, be conclusive evidence of the matters therein contained.

Power to extend enactments in First Schedule.

5. (1.) It shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen in Council, if she thinks fit, by order, to direct that all or any of the enactments described in the First Schedule to this Act, or any enactments for the time being in force amending or substituted for the same, shall extend, with or without any exceptions, adaptations, or modifications in the order mentioned, to any foreign country in which for the time being Her Majesty has jurisdiction

Her Majesty has jurisdiction.
(2.) Thereupon those enactments shall, to the extent of that jurisdiction, operate as if that country were a British possession, and as if Her Majesty in Council were the Legislature of that possession.

6. (1.) Where a person is charged with an offence recognisable by a British Court in a foreign country, any person having authority derived from Her Majesty in that behalf may, by warrant, cause the person so charged to be sent for trial to any British possession for the time being appointed trial to any British possession for the time being appointed in that behalf by Order in Council, and, upon the arrival of the person so charged in that British possession, such criminal Court of that possession as is authorised in that behalf by Order in Council, or, if no Court is so authorised, the supreme criminal Court of that possession, may cause him to be kept in safe and proper custody, and so soon as conveniently may be may inquire of, try, and determine the offence, and on conviction punish the offender according to the laws in force in that behalf within that possession, in the same manner as if the offence had been committed within the jurisdiction of that criminal Court.

(a.) A person so charged may, before being so sent for trial, tender for examination to a British Court in trial, tender for examination to a British Court in
the foreign country where the offence is alleged to
have been committed any competent witness whose
evidence he deems material for his defence, and

(b.) In such case the British Court in the foreign country
shall proceed in the examination and cross-examination of the witness as though he had been tendered at a trial before that Court, and shall cause

(c.) Thereupon the Court of the British possession before which the trial takes place shall allow so much of the evidence so taken as would have been admissible according to the law and practice of that Court had the witness been produced and examined at the trial to be read and received as legal evidence at the trial. the trial:

(d.) The Court of the British possession shall admit and give effect to the law by which the alleged offender would have been tried by the British Court in the

foreign country in which his offence is alleged to have been committed, so far as that law relates to the criminality of the act alleged to have been committed, or the nature or degree of the offence, or the punishment thereof, if the law differs in those respects from the law in force in that British pos-

(2.) Nothing in this section shall alter or repeal any law statute, or usage by virtue of which any offence committed out of Her Majesty's dominions may, irrespectively of this Act, be inquired of tried, determined, and punished within

Act, he inquired of, tried, determined, and punished within Her Majesty's dominions or any part thereof.

7. Where an offender convicted before a British Court in a foreign country has been sentenced by that Court to suffer death, penal servitude, imprisonment, or any other punishment, the sentence shall be carried into effect in such place as may be directed by Order in Council or be determined in accordance with directions given by Order in Council, and the conviction and sentence shall be of the same force in the place in which the sentence is so carried into effect as if the conviction had been made and the sentence passed by a competent Court in that place.

8. Where, by Order in Council made in pursuance of this Act, any British Court in a foreign country is authorised to order the removal or deportation of any person from that

Act, any British Court in a foreign country is authorised to order the removal or deportation of any person from that country, that removal or deportation, and any detention for the purposes thereof, according to the provisions of the Order in Council, shall be as lawful as if the order of the Court were to have effect wholly within that country.

9. It shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen in Council, by order, to assign to or confer on any Court in any British possession, or held under the authority of Her Majesty, any jurisdiction, civil or criminal, original or appellate, which may lawfully by Order in Council be assigned to or conferred on any British Court in any foreign country, and to make such provisions and regulations as to Her Majesty in Council seem meet respecting the exercise of the jurisdiction so assigned or conferred, and respecting the enforcement and execution of the judgments, decrees, orders, and sentences of any such Court, and respecting appeals therefrom.

10. It shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen in Council to revoke or vary any Order in Council made in pursuance of this Act.

11. Every Order in Council made in pursuance of this Act shall be laid before both Houses of Parliament forthwith after it is made, if Parliament be then in session, and if not, forthwith after the commencement of the then next session of Parliament, and shall have effect as if it were enacted in this Act.

12. (1.) If any Order in Council made in pursuance of this Act as respects any foreign country is in any respect repugnant to the provisions of any Act of Parliament extending to Her Majesty's subjects in that country, or repugnant to any order or regulation made under the authority of any such Act of Parliament, or having in that country the force and effect of any such Act, it shall be read subject to that Act, order, or regulation, and shall, to the extent of such repugnancy, but not otherwise, be void.

(2.) An Order in Council made in pursuance of this Act shall not be, or be deemed to have been, void on the ground of repugnancy to the law of England unless it is repugnant to the provisions of some such Act of Parliament, order, or regulation as aforesaid.

An action, suit, prosecution, or proceeding against any person for any act done in pursuance or execution or intended execution of this Act, or of any enactment repealed by this Act, or of any Order in Council made under this Act, or of any such jurisdiction of Her Majesty as is mentioned in this Act, or in respect of any alleged neglect or default in the execution of this Act, or of any such enactment, Order in Council, or jurisdiction as aforesaid, shall not lie or be instituted-

(a.) In any Court within Her Majesty's dominions, unless it is commenced within six months next after the act, neglect, or default complained of; or, in case of a continuance of injury or damage, within six months next after the ceasing thereof; or, where the cause of action arose out of Her Majesty's dominions, within six months after the parties to the action, suit, prosecution, or proceeding have been within the jurisdiction of the Court in which the same is

instituted; nor
(b.) In any of Her Majestv's Courts without Her Majestv's (b.) In any of Her Majesty's Courts without Her Majesty's dominions, unless the cause of action arose within the jurisdiction of that Court, and the action is commenced within six months next after the act, neglect, or default complained of; or, in case of a continuance of injury or damage, within six months next after the ceasing thereof.

(2.) In any such action, suit, or proceeding, tender of amends before the same was commenced may be pleaded in lieu of or in addition to any other ples. If the action, suit, or proceeding was commenced after such tender, or is pro-

ceeded with after payment into Court of any money in satisfaction of the plaintiff's claim, and the plaintiff does not recover more than the sum tendered or paid, he shall not recover any costs incurred after such tender or payment, and the defendant shall be entitled to costs, to be taxed as between solicitor and client, as from the time of such tender or payment; but this provision shall not affect costs on any injunction in the action, suit, or proceeding.

14. It shall be lawful for Her Majesty the Queen in Council to make any law that may seem meet for the government of Her Majesty's subjects being in any vessel at a distance

Dear Sir Francis Bell,—I am in a little difficulty, for on one hand I should not like to raise a causeless alarm, and on the other I should never cease to regret if a bad pest took hold in New Zealand for want of a timely word.

Therefore I venture to mention that yesterday I heard from Dr. Selmar Schonland (the Curator of the Albany Museum, Grahamstown, Cape Colony) that he had been applied to from King Williamstown regarding an attack of moth-caterpillars, seriously injurious in flour-mills. Dr. Schonland had written for specimens and further information, but meanwhile, from the attack being apparently something new and so seriously destructive, I am afraid that it may turn out to be that of the Ephestia kuhniella, the "flour-moth," which is a perfect scourge where it gains a footing.

This infestation is steadily spreading in the world, and it reached Canada last year. You will see notices of it up to

This infestation is steadily spreading in the world, and it reached Canada last year. You will see notices of it up to date in my 12th and 13th reports.

I do not like to risk raising a false alarm, but I am sure you will forgive me (even if happily this should turn out the case) drawing your attention to a possible grievous trouble; and, as I have some little connection with South Australian entomology, I have written to Sir Arthur Blyth, and also written out to Mr. Frazer Crawford as the official South Australian Entomologist. If it is this attack, and we could be beforehand and ready to receive it, it would be a most happy prevention.


