To the LEGISLATIVE COUNCILLORS of the COLONY of NEW ZEALAND, and the MEMBERS elected to serve in the HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES of the said colony, and to all whom it may concern—GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS I have thought fit to dissolve the General Assembly of New Zealand, which stands prorogued to the ninth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three: Now KNOW YE that I, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do for that end publish this Proclamation, and do hereby dissolve the said General Assembly accordingly; and the Legislative Councillors, and the Members elected to serve in the House of Representatives, are discharged from their meeting and attendance on the said ninth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three.
