Issue of Letter-cards.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-first day of December, 1894.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section four of "The Post Office Acts Amendment Act, 1893" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), it is enacted that the Postmaster-General may furnish and issue post-cards and letter-cards to the public for transmission by post between places either within or beyond New Zealand, and also that the Postmaster-General, with the advice and consent of the Governor in Council, may from time to time make arrangements with the constituted authorities in England, or in any of Her Majesty's colonies or possessions, or in any foreign country, for the reciprocal transmission of post-cards and letter-cards by means of the Post Office, subject to the payment of such rate of postage as may be mutually arranged in each case: And whereas it is expedient to arrange for the reciprocal transmission of letter-cards between the Australian Colonies and Tasmania on the one hand and New Zealand on the other hand, and to introduce the transmission of letter-cards by post within the colony:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred by the said Act, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling him in this behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, doth hereby authorise and empower the Postmaster-General to enter into agreements with the Postmasters-General, or other in that behalf constituted authorities, in the Colonies of Australia and the Colony of Tasmania, for the mutual transmission of letter-cards, and also to despatch letter-cards by post to other countries beyond New Zealand than those aforesaid; and, in respect of all letter-cards posted for transmission to places either within or beyond New Zealand, doth hereby fix the rates of postage and make the regulations given in the Schedule hereto, and doth order and declare that this Order in Council shall take effect on and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.

SCHEDULE.

1. A LETTER-CARD is a card which may be folded and closed against inspection. It shall be of such size and design as may be determined by the Postmaster-General, and shall bear an impressed stamp of the value of 1½d. No letter-cards other than those issued by the Postmaster-General shall be used for the purpose of making a communication through the Post Office unless such cards be prepaid in accordance with the letter rates of postage.

2. The postage on letter-cards shall be: For transmission to any place within New Zealand or to the Australian Colonies or Tasmania, 1½d. each.

3. In respect of any letter-card posted and insufficiently prepaid, the addressee shall be charged double the deficiency.

4. The front of the card must be reserved for postal super-scriptions and the address.

5. If any letter-card be found to contain any enclosure the addressee shall be charged letter rates of postage in addition to the postage impressed upon the card.

6. Letter-cards may be used for transmission to the South Sea islands named in Table A if, in addition to the impressed stamp of 1½d., an adhesive postage-stamp of the value of ½d. be affixed to the card; and to the United Kingdom, any British possession or colony, or any country beyond Australasia and the South Sea islands if, in addition to the impressed stamp of 1½d., an adhesive postage-stamp of the value of 1d. be affixed to the card.

Altering Regulation under "The Electric Lines Act, 1884."

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the twenty-fifth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, certain regulations were made, under the provisions of "The Electric Lines Act, 1884," for the transmission of telegrams by means of electric lines under the said Act, including the regulation contained in the First Schedule hereto: And whereas it is expedient to amend such last-mentioned regulation in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, and in pursuance of all the powers in that behalf enabling him, doth hereby order and declare that the regulation specified in the First Schedule hereto, and being Regulation No. 2 of the regulations so published as aforesaid, shall be amended as set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, and doth further declare that such amended regulation shall have effect on and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, and shall thereupon supersede the regulation set forth in the First Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

2. PRINTED forms upon which telegrams should be written may be obtained at all stations on application; but all telegrams, whether written upon the prescribed form, upon any other printed form, or upon plain paper, shall be considered as presented for transmission under the several conditions contained in these regulations.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

2. PRINTED forms upon which telegrams should be written may be obtained at all telegraph-offices on application; but all telegrams, whether written upon the prescribed form, upon any other printed form, or upon plain paper, shall (subject to the provision hereinafter stated) be considered as presented for transmission under the several conditions contained in these regulations: Provided that telegrams written upon printed forms other than those supplied by the Government shall be first approved of by the Electric Telegraph Commissioner, or the same may be refused at any telegraph-office when presented for transmission.

Extending the Close Season for Seals.

WHEREAS by "The Sea-fisheries Act, 1894" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), it is, among other things, enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time make regulations (which shall have general force and effect throughout the colony, or particular force and effect only in any waters or places specified therein) for prescribing, among other things, a close season for seals:

And whereas it is further provided by the said Act that every person who, during any close season for seals, takes any seals is liable for every such offence to a penalty not

exceeding five hundred pounds, and in addition thereto is liable to a further penalty, not exceeding twenty pounds, in respect of every seal so taken :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, doth hereby make the regulations set forth in the Schedule hereto; and with the like advice and consent doth order that such regulations shall have force and effect throughout the Colony of New Zealand, and in all salt, fresh, and brackish waters of the colony, and on all shores of such waters or any part thereof.

SCHEDULE.

REGULATIONS.

1. THE months of January, February, March, April, May, and June, 1895, are hereby prescribed as a close season for seals.

2. Every person who, during the close season prescribed as aforesaid, takes any seals is liable to a penalty of not less than £25, nor more than £500, and in addition thereto is liable to a further penalty of not less than £1, nor more than £20, in respect of every seal so taken. The taking of seals means and includes the killing, catching, dragging for, raising, or hunting of any seal, or any attempt so to do.

3. No person shall buy, sell, expose for sale, consign for sale, buy for sale, or have in possession any seal, or any skins, oil, or blubber from any seal, in any manner in contravention of the said Act or of these regulations; and every person so doing is liable for every such offence to a penalty of not less than £1 nor more than £20.

Amending Dues and Rates and Regulations for Use of Kaikoura Wharf.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is provided by section four of "The Harbours Act Amendment Act, 1879," that the power granted to the Governor in Council by the seventeenth section of "The Harbours Act, 1878," in respect of prescribing what dues and rates may be charged on wharves vested in local bodies, may be exercised from time to time as occasion may require, and shall not be limited as in the said section is provided: And whereas dues and rates to be charged for the use of the Kaikoura wharf and goods-shed (the management of which was by Order in Council dated the second day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, vested in the Kaikoura County Council) were prescribed by Order in Council dated the twenty-third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 19, of the eighth day of March in the same year: And whereas it is expedient to amend the dues and rates prescribed by the said Order in Council of the twenty-third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, and to make an additional regulation for the use of the wharf:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, and in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority granted to him by "The Harbours Act, 1878," "The Harbours Act Amendment Act, 1879," and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, doth hereby prescribe that the dues and rates specified in the First Schedule hereto shall be charged and taken, on and after the date of the publication of this Order in Council in the *New Zealand Gazette*, for the use of the said wharf and goods-shed; and such dues and rates shall be applied to keeping the above-mentioned wharf and goods-shed and all erections on the wharf in repair, as provided by the said Order in Council of the second day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three; and in further pursuance and exercise of the said powers and authority, and with the like advice and consent, His Excellency the Governor in Council doth make the regulation set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, and doth order that the same shall apply to the Port or Harbour of Kaikoura and to the wharf aforesaid.

Prescribing Close Season for Oysters in Queen Charlotte Sound and Tory Channel.

WHEREAS by "The Sea-fisheries Act, 1894," it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time make regulations, which shall have general force and effect throughout the colony, or particular force and effect only in any waters or places specified therein, for, amongst other things, prescribing in any place a close season for oysters over any term not exceeding three years, and, before the expiration of such term, further extending the same:

And whereas it is desirable to prescribe a close season for oysters in Queen Charlotte Sound and Tory Channel:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the said Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, doth hereby make the following regulation:—

REGULATION.

The period from the 1st December, 1894, to the 30th November, 1897, is hereby prescribed a close season for oysters in Queen Charlotte Sound and Tory Channel, and in all bays and inlets therein. During such close season it shall be unlawful for any person to take any oysters in such sound, channel, bays, and inlets.

WHEREAS by the one hundred and sixty-third section of "The Land Act, 1892," it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time make, alter, and repeal regulations fixing the terms and conditions upon which the lands in any special settlement shall be disposed of by lease in perpetuity:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the hereinbefore in part recited Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said colony, doth hereby make the following regulations fixing the terms and conditions upon which the lands known as the Lepperton Special Settlement Association Block, described in the Schedule to the said regulations, shall be disposed of, that is to say:—

REGULATIONS.

1. In the construction of these regulations, unless the context shall otherwise require, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:—

"Association" means the Lepperton Special Settlement Association, being a body of persons, not less than thirteen in number, voluntarily associated together at Lepperton, in the Provincial District of Taranaki, for the purpose of taking up the land as a special settlement of farm homesteads:

"Land" means the land described in the Schedule, set apart for a special settlement, to be dealt with under these regulations:

"Settler" means any member of the association or other person, not being a married woman, leasing land under these regulations:

"Receiver of Land Revenue" means Receiver of Land Revenue at New Plymouth, or other officer for the time being acting as such:

"Minister" means the Minister of Lands for the time being, or any member of the Executive acting for him:

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Crown Lands for the Land District of Taranaki:

"Secretary" means the secretary of the association for the time being, and shall include any person acting in that capacity, and, if there shall be no secretary, then the chairman of the association:

"Substantial improvements of a permanent character" mean and include reclamation from swamps, clearing of bush, gorse, broom, sweetbriar, or scrub, cultivation, planting with trees or live hedges, the laying-out and cultivation of gardens, fencing, draining, making roads, sinking wells or water-tanks, constructing water-races, in any way improving the character or fertility of the soil, or the erection of any building:

"Cultivation" means—

- (1.) Fencing the land with timber or other durable materials, not being a brush fence; or
- (2.) Breaking up and laying down the same in English or other cultivated grass; or
- (3.) Breaking up and planting or sowing root or other crops therein:

"Lease" means a lease in perpetuity in terms of Part III. of "The Land Act, 1892."

2. The block of land to be dealt with under these regulations has been surveyed into sections of not more than 320 acres each, and the number of persons to be located thereon shall not be less than thirteen.

3. The allotments of sections to members of the association shall be made at such time and in such manner as the association may, with the consent of the Commissioner, determine.

4. The land shall be disposed of by lease at an annual rental of 4 per cent. on the capital value fixed by the Minister.

5. One-third of the rents paid from time to time shall, for the first fifteen years, be paid to the local body of the district charged with the construction and maintenance of roads in the district, for the expenditure on roads in or leading to the block. Such expenditure to be first sanctioned by the Land Board for the Land District of Taranaki.

6. All rents and moneys required to be paid for the land under these terms and conditions shall be paid to the Receiver of Land Revenue, and receipts given by him shall be sufficient discharge for the payment of the moneys therein respectively acknowledged to have been received.

7. The settlers shall be members of the association, and no settler shall be under seventeen years of age.

8. The secretary shall inform the Commissioner of the names of the settlers; pay a deposit of 10s. per member, and also furnish the Commissioner from time to time with minutes of proceedings of the association if so required.

9. The original or amended list of members, signed by the secretary of the association, and sent to the Commissioner, shall be *prima facie* evidence that the persons claiming to select land are members of the association.

10. Each settler shall put on the land comprised in his lease substantial improvements as follows:—

- (a.) Within one year from the date of his lease, to a value equal to ten per centum of the price of the land;
- (b.) Within two years from the date of his lease, to a value equal to another ten per centum of the price of the land;
- (c.) And thereafter, but within six years from the date of his lease, to a value equal to another ten per centum of the price of the land;

And in addition thereto shall, within six years from the date of his lease, put substantial improvements of a permanent character to the value of £1 per acre.

11. Residence and occupation of the land shall be in accordance with Part III. of "The Land Act, 1892."

12. No person who is the owner in fee or leasehold of any land in New Zealand which, together with the land included in his application or transfer under these regulations, would exceed 320 acres, and no person who has made an arrangement or agreement to permit any one, save his son or daughter, to acquire by purchase or otherwise the allotment in respect of which his application is made, shall be entitled to become a settler under these regulations.

13. Any settler who shall fail to comply with these regulations in any respect shall, upon sufficient proof thereof to the satisfaction of the Land Board of the district, forfeit his interest in the land selected, and the land shall thereafter be dealt with as ordinary Crown land; and these conditions shall be sufficient authority for such forfeiture.

14. The association may make such rules and regulations from time to time as it may deem necessary, subject to the approval of the Commissioner.

15. In case any doubt shall arise as to the sufficiency of the compliance with these regulations, with reference to the selection, occupation, or improvement of any land, or otherwise arising thereunder respectively, the same shall be settled by the Land Board.

16. Excepting as expressly modified by these regulations, the provisions of "The Land Act, 1892," and its amendments shall be deemed to have full force and effect over and upon the land herein referred to, and shall, *mutatis mutandis*, be read as if these regulations formed part of the Act.

PURSUANT to and in exercise of the powers in this behalf conferred upon him by "The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1894," His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand doth hereby, for the purposes of the said Act, declare as follows, that is to say:—

1. The colony is hereby divided into six industrial districts, constituted with the names and boundaries following, that is to say:—

- (1.) The Northern Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Northern Judicial District constituted under "The Supreme Court Act, 1882";
- (2.) The Wellington Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Wellington Judicial District, constituted as aforesaid;
- (3.) The Nelson Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Nelson Judicial District, constituted as aforesaid;
- (4.) The Westland Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Westland Judicial District, constituted as aforesaid;
- (5.) The Canterbury Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Canterbury Judicial District, constituted as aforesaid; and
- (6.) The Otago and Southland Industrial District, the boundaries whereof are coterminous with those of the Otago and Southland Judicial District, constituted as aforesaid.

2. In each of the aforesaid industrial districts one of the persons for the time being holding the office of Deputy Registrar of the Supreme Court of the judicial district coterminous with such industrial district shall be appointed to be the Clerk of Awards in and for such industrial district, and the two offices shall be held in conjunction.

3. The Board of Conciliation in and for each industrial district shall consist of four members, in addition to the Chairman.

Regulations under "The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1894."

GLASGOW, Governor.

PURSUANT to and in exercise of the powers in this behalf conferred upon him by "The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1894," His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand doth hereby, for the purposes of the said Act, make the following regulations, that is to say:—

REGULATIONS.

Industrial Unions and Associations.

1. Application for registration as an industrial union or industrial association may be in the form numbered 1 in the Schedule hereto.

2. The certificate of registration and incorporation of an industrial union or industrial association shall be in the form numbered 2 in the Schedule hereto.

3. The application for registration as an industrial association shall be accompanied by a list of the industrial unions which the council or other body making the applica-

tion represents, as well as by a list of its members and officers, and by two copies of its rules.

4. In the months of January and July of every year there shall be forwarded to the Registrar of Friendly Societies, Wellington, by every industrial association, a list of the industrial unions constituting such association, and by every industrial union a list of the members of such union.

5. Such lists shall be made up to the first day of the month in which they are to be forwarded as aforesaid, and shall be verified by the statutory declaration of the president or chairman of the association or union forwarding them.

6. Such statutory declaration may be in the form numbered 3 in the Schedule hereto.

Industrial Agreements.

7. The Clerk of Awards in each district, being a Deputy Registrar of the Supreme Court, shall keep in his office (being the same office as the Supreme Court office wherein he is Deputy Registrar) a register of all industrial agreements, duplicates whereof are filed in the office of the Supreme Court in that district. Such duplicates shall be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are filed, and the register shall set forth the date of the agreement, and of the filing thereof, the names of the parties thereto, and of every employer who, in the prescribed manner, signifies concurrence therein.

8. Such concurrence as aforesaid may be signified by filing in the same office as that in which the industrial agreement is filed a notice in the form numbered 4 in the Schedule hereto, and every notice of concurrence shall bear the same number as the industrial agreement to which it relates.

9. Before permitting the duplicate of an industrial agreement (if other than a duplicate original) to be filed, the Clerk of Awards (hereinafter called "the Clerk") shall satisfy himself that such duplicate is a true copy of the original agreement whereof it purports to be the duplicate, and for that purpose he may require the production of such original agreement.

Boards of Conciliation.

10. Nomination-papers, consent-papers, and voting-papers for the purpose of election of members of the Board of Conciliation (hereinafter called "the Board") may be in the forms numbered respectively 5, 6, and 7 in the Schedule hereto.

11. At any such election as aforesaid an industrial union may distribute its votes at pleasure amongst all the candidates to be elected by its division. Thus, if there be two candidates to be elected by the industrial unions of workmen in a given district, a union of workmen may give two votes to one candidate and none to the other.

12. The successor to a member of the Board shall be elected by the division of unions which elected such member.

13. For the purpose of electing the Chairman of the Board, the members present at the meeting called for the purpose shall select to preside at that meeting one of their number, who shall have a deliberative but no casting vote. Nominations of qualified persons shall then be received from members. If there be only one person nominated, he shall be declared elected as Chairman.

14. If there be more such nominations than one, the person receiving an absolute majority of votes of the members present shall be elected. To that end the names of all the persons so nominated shall be written on a list and submitted to the vote. The name of the person receiving the smallest number of votes shall be struck out, and the remaining names shall be again submitted to the vote. This process is to be repeated until there remains only one person on the list, and he shall be the elected Chairman.

15. In the event of two such persons remaining on the list with an equal number of votes, and neither of them being able to obtain an absolute majority, then, when all reasonable attempts to secure an absolute majority have failed, the members of the Board shall be deemed to have refused to elect a Chairman, and the Governor shall appoint one.

Industrial Disputes.

16. Applications for the reference of an industrial dispute for settlement to the Board (hereinafter called "a Reference") may be in the form numbered 8 in the Schedule hereto.

17. When lodging a Reference with the Clerk, the applicant shall also lodge as many copies thereof as there are other parties to the dispute. The applicant shall file the original, and the Clerk shall indorse on each copy a memorandum signed by him, setting forth the fact and date of the filing of the original, and shall then forthwith post one such copy by registered letter, addressed to each of the said other parties to the dispute.

18. All References shall be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are filed, and the Clerk shall keep a register thereof, setting forth the number of the Reference and the date of the filing thereof, together with the name of the applicant and of the other parties to the Reference.

19. All documents subsequently filed, lodged, or issued in the matter of the Reference shall bear the same number as the Reference to which they relate, and shall be intitled in the form numbered 9 in the Schedule hereto.

20. The Clerk shall convene a meeting of the Board by posting to each member a notice in the form numbered 10 in the Schedule hereto.

21. The date of such meeting shall be not sooner than seven nor later than fourteen days after the day on which the notice convening the same is posted, and the notice shall be posted within three days after the filing of the Reference.

22. The Clerk shall post by registered letter, addressed to each party to the Reference, a notice of the day, hour, and place of such meeting.

23. Such notice shall be in the form numbered 11 in the Schedule hereto, and shall be posted at least three days before and exclusive of the day of meeting.

24. A party to a Reference who desires to appear by agent, or (where allowed) by solicitor or counsel, shall sign and file in the office of the Clerk a warrant in the form numbered 12 in the Schedule hereto.

25. Where all the parties to a Reference consent to the appearance of counsel or solicitor, such consent shall be given in the form numbered 13 in the Schedule hereto, and the same shall be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Witnesses.

26. A summons to a witness shall be in duplicate, in the form numbered 14 in the Schedule hereto. The Clerk shall sign both duplicates, retaining one and issuing the other for service by the applicant. Service shall be effected by delivering a copy to the witness, and at the same time producing the original for his inspection if so desired.

27. Any number of witnesses may be included in one summons, but the copy served need only contain the name of the witness upon whom it is served. If the summons is issued out of the Court of Arbitration it shall bear the seal of the Court; if issued by the Board of Conciliation, it shall be signed by the Clerk on behalf of the Board.

The Court of Arbitration.

28. Any party to an industrial dispute who is dissatisfied with the report of the Board may, by filing in the office of the Clerk notice in the Form No. 15 in the Schedule hereto, require the Clerk to refer the dispute to the Court of Arbitration (hereinafter called "the Court").

29. Immediately upon the filing of such notice, the industrial dispute to which it refers shall be deemed to be before the Court.

30. All papers and proceedings before the Court shall bear the same number as before the Board, and be similarly intitled, with the addition of the words, "Before the Court of Arbitration."

31. The clerk in each industrial district shall be an officer of the Court, and shall attend all sittings thereof in his district. He shall keep the minutes of proceedings and the records of the Court, and perform all such duties and exercise all such functions as the Court may direct.

32. The Court may prescribe rules of procedure and practice relative to all matters with which it has to do, and such rules shall be as valid as if incorporated with these regulations.
