New Electoral Districts for the North Island.

(L.S.) GLASGOW, Governor.
A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the North Island Representation Commission, appointed under the provisions of "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1896," have made their report to me under their hands and seals, setting forth the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the North Island, fixed by them in accordance with "The Representation Act, 1887," and the Acts amending the same:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the fifth section of "The Representation Act, 1887," I, David, Earl of Glasgow, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the North Island, so fixed by the said Commission, to be those respectively mentioned and set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

BAY OF ISLANDS.

THIS district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the ocean from North Cape to Helena Bay; thence towards the south-east generally by Township Reserve and Sections Nos. 2 and 1, Block I., Opuawhanga Survey District, to the north-western corner of the latter section; thence by the boundary-line between Native land and Crown land (the said boundary-line being part of the north-west boundary-line of Whangarei County) to the Taparahaia River; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 18, on Tarai-o-Rahiri; thence again towards the north-east by a right line in the direction of Trig. Station 41, on Tangihua, as far as the Wairoa River; thence again towards the south-east generally by the said Wairoa River to Section No. 8, Block V., Tokatoka Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 8, the crossing of a road, by Section No. 22, the crossing of a road, by Sections Nos. 39 and 47, all of the said Block V., to the road at the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by the road fronting Sections Nos. 106, 107, 119, and 120 of the said Block V., and by that road continued through Section No. 95 of the said Block V.; and through Section No. 94, Block V., Kopuru Survey District, and along the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 93; thence by a right line being the production of the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 93 to the ocean; towards the south-west by the ocean; and towards

the north by the ocean: including Moturoa, Cavalli, and all adjacent islands.

MARSDEN.

THIS district is bounded towards the east generally by the ocean from the northernmost corner of a township reserve, situate at Helena Bay, in Block I., Opuawhanga Survey District, to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 91, Parish of Waipu, Mangawai Survey District, at Bream Tail; thence towards the south generally by the south-eastern boundary-line of that section to its south-eastern corner; thence by a right line to the Kapawhiti Range at the point where the road from Mangawai to McKenzie's Cove crosses it; thence by a right line to Trig. Station H, Mangawai Survey District; thence by a right line to Trig. Station B, Waipu Survey District; thence by Section No. 235, Block XII., of the said Waipu Survey District, and the Marunui Block to the Piroa Stream; thence by the left bank of the said Piroa Stream to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 137, Parish of Wairau; thence by that section and Section No. 136 to the Great North Road; thence by the south side of that road to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 105, Parish of Wairau; thence towards the south-east generally by the said Section No. 105, and Sections Nos. 106 and 100, and the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced across the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 152, Parish of Paparoa; thence by that road and its continuation to the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 151, Parish of Paparoa; thence by that boundary-line to the road at the northern boundary of Section No. 91, Parish of Wairau; thence by that road and by the said Section No. 91, and by Section No. 93, the crossing of a road, by Sections Nos. 78, 79, and 80, Parish of Wairau, the crossing of a road, and by Section No. 84, Parish of Wairau, to its western corner; thence again towards the east by the Pahi River and the Arapaoa River; thence again towards the south-east by the Otamatea River to the Wairoa River; thence towards the south-west and south by the said Wairoa River to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Te Kuri Parish; thence by a right line across the said Wairoa River to the northernmost corner of the said Te Kuri Parish; thence towards the north-east by the Wairoa River aforesaid to the Kaipara Entrance; thence again towards the south by the said Kaipara Entrance; again towards the south-west by the ocean to a point in line with the northern side of the road forming the north-western boundary of Section No. 93, Block V., Kopuru Survey District; and towards the north-west generally by the Bay of Islands Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Helena Bay, the place of commencement: including Moko-hinau Lighthouse.

WAITEMATA.

This district is bounded towards the west and north generally by the Marsden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Kaipara Entrance on the west coast to Bream Tail; thence towards the east generally by the ocean to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 260, Parish of Takapuna, Block IV., Waitemata Survey District, in Long Bay; thence towards the south-east generally by a right line to the north-eastern corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 260 and Sections Nos. 262 and 263 of the said parish to the road which forms the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation passing Section No. 265 to Section No. 186; thence by that section to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 258; thence by that road and its continuation passing the said Section No. 258 and Section No. 259 of the said parish, and Sections Nos. 168 and 169, Parish of Paremoremo, to Section No. 171; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Section No. 171 and Sections Nos. 170, 176, 33, and 36 of the said Parish of Paremoremo, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 305, Parish of Pukeatua; thence towards the south-east by the eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 305, 301, 300, and 299, Parish of Pukeatua, to Lucas's Creek; thence by Lucas's Creek to the Waitemata River, at the southernmost point of Section No. 125, Parish of Paremoremo; thence by a right line to the northernmost point of Herald Island; thence by the eastern and southern shores of that island to its southernmost point; thence by a line due south to the mainland; thence by Waitemata Harbour and the Whau Estuary to Section No. 90, Parish of Waikomiti; thence by the said Section No. 90 to the Oratia Stream (Canty's Creek); thence by that stream to Section No. 6, Parish of Waikomiti; thence by the said Section No. 6 and Sections Nos. 7, 8, and 10 of Waikomiti Parish to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 368; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 93 and 94 of the said Parish of Waikomiti, Sections Nos. 36, 74, 73, 37, 38, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, and 82, all of the Parish of Karangahape, to the ocean; thence again towards the south-west by the ocean; towards the north by the Kaipara Entrance; and again towards the north-east and west by the Kaipara River and the Wairoa River to the place of commencement; including the islands of Great and Little Barrier, Kawau, Motuhora, and Tiritiri, and other islands adjacent thereto.

EDEN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Waitemata Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the north-western corner of Section No. 82, Karangahape Parish, on the west coast, to Long Bay on the east coast; thence towards the north-east by the Hauraki Gulf to the North Head of Waitemata Harbour; thence towards the south by Waitemata Harbour to the Victoria Wharf at Devonport; thence towards the south-east by a right line across the said Waitemata Harbour to the north-eastern corner of the City of Auckland; thence again towards the south generally by lines 1800, 1059, 1171, 852, 758, 250, 82, 1735, 4300, 270, 700, 1225, 300, and 50 links to the original high-water mark of Freeman's Bay, at the middle of Franklin Street, City of Auckland (the said lines being the northern boundary-lines of the said City of Auckland), and by the southern shore of Waitemata Harbour to Motion's Creek; thence again towards the north-east generally by the right bank of Motion's Creek to the north-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 13 of Section No. 9, Suburbs of Auckland; thence by the north-western boundary-line of that allotment to Allotment No. 12 of the said section No. 9; thence by the said Allotment No. 12 to the northernmost corner of Allotment No. 17 of the said Section No. 9; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned allotment and by that boundary-line produced to the south-eastern side of the Old Great North Road; thence towards the north generally by the Old Great North Road to its junction with King Street, Arch Hill; thence again towards the north-east by a line along the middle of King Street to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 121, Arch Hill; thence again towards the north-west by a right line to the south-western corner of the said Section No. 121, and thence by the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 121 aforesaid, 122, 123, and 124, Arch Hill to Niger Street; thence by the south side of Niger Street to Alexander Street, Eden Terrace; thence again towards the north-east by the east side of the said Alexander Street to Aitken Terrace; thence by a right line across Aitken Terrace; thence again towards the north-west by the south side of Aitken Terrace aforesaid to Greenwood Street; thence again towards the north-east by the west side of the said Greenwood Street to the New North Road; thence again towards the south-east by the north side of the said New North Road to Mount

Roskill Road; thence towards the east by the west side of Mount Roskill Road to Section No. 125 of Section No. 10, Suburbs of Auckland; thence towards the south by that section; again towards the east by the said Section No. 125 and Sections Nos. 124, 123, and 122 to Mount Albert Road; thence towards the south-west by the west side of the said Mount Albert Road to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 50, Parish of Titirangi; thence again towards the south-east generally by the south side of that road to its intersection by the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 51; thence by the north-eastern and south-eastern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 51 to the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 94; thence by the western side of that road and the western side of the road forming the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 66 and 67; thence by that road to the easternmost corner of the latter section; thence by the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 67 aforesaid and by Section No. 72 to the eastern side of the road forming the eastern boundary of Sections Nos. 78 and 77; thence by the eastern side of that road and across another road to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 75; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section to Manukau Harbour, near the Wairaki Stream; and thence again towards the south-east generally by the said Manukau Harbour to the ocean; and again towards the south-west by the ocean to the place of commencement: including Bean Rock.

CITY OF AUCKLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Motion's Creek to the north-eastern corner of the City of Auckland; thence towards the south-east generally by a line, 1500 links, to The Strand; thence by The Strand, 50 links; thence to and by Suburban Section No. 96; thence by a line at right angles to the western boundary-line of that section to and along the east side of Stanley Street to the Government Domain; thence by the said Government Domain and the Hospital Reserve to the road known as Park Road; thence by the northern side of the said Park Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 22 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to, and thence by the said eastern boundary-line and its production to, the south side of Carleton Gore Road; thence by the south side of that road to the western boundary-line of Subdivisional Lot No. 37 of original Allotment No. 4 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by the said Lot No. 37, and by Lots Nos. 55, 56, 65, 66, 75, 76, 85, 86, 95, 96, 105, 106, 115, 116, and 18, all of the original Allotment No. 4 of the said Section No. 3, and by the western boundary-line of the said Lot No. 13 produced to the southern side of the Kyber Pass Road; thence by that road to the eastern side of the road leading to the Mound Eden Stockade; thence by the eastern side of the last-mentioned road to the Main North Railway-line; thence towards the south-east and south by the said Main North Railway-line to Shaddock Street, Eden Terrace; thence again towards the north-west by Shaddock Street to Mount Eden Road, at the easternmost corner of Allotment No. 2 of Section No. 10, Suburbs of Auckland; thence again towards the south-west by the said Section No. 2 to its northernmost corner; thence by a right line across the New North Road to the north side of Basque Road at its intersection with the said New North Road; thence by the said Basque Road and by original Allotments Nos. 1, 3, and 4 of Section No. 5, Suburbs of Auckland; thence again towards the south-east by the last-mentioned allotment and original Allotments Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 14 of the said Section No. 5 to King Street, Arch Hill; thence again towards the south generally by the Eden Electoral District aforesaid to the place of commencement.

PARNELL.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Waitemata Harbour, from the easternmost corner of the City of Auckland to Resolution Point; towards the east generally by Hobson Bay to Slaughterhouse Creek; thence towards the south-east generally by Slaughterhouse Creek to the south-eastern corner of Allotment No. 23 of Section No. 4, Suburbs of Auckland; thence towards the south generally by the southern boundary-line of the said Allotment No. 23 to the north-eastern corner of the Public Hall site; thence by the eastern and southern boundary-lines of that site to Epsom Road; thence again towards the east by the eastern side of that road to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Allotment No. 23A (educational endowment), opposite the Junction Hotel; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to the north-eastern corner of the said Allotment No. 23A; thence by that allotment to Gillies Avenue; thence again towards the south-east by the eastern side of the said Gillies Avenue to a point in line with the northern side of Owen's Road; thence by a right line across Gillies Avenue aforesaid to the said Owen's Road; and thence by

that road to the south-eastern corner of Subdivision No. 1 of Allotment No. 57; thence again towards the south by the southern boundary-line of the said Subdivision No. 1 to original Allotment No. 11 of Section No. 10, Suburbs of Auckland; thence again towards the south-west by the said Allotment No. 11 to Oaklands Road; thence again towards the south by that road to Mount Eden Road; thence by a line across the latter road to Valley Road; thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Valley Road to Mount Roskill Road, at the Eden Electoral District; thence towards the west by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and again towards the north and north-west by the City of Auckland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the place of commencement.

MANUKAU.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by Hobson Bay, Waitemata Harbour, and the Hauraki Gulf respectively to Maungamaungaroa Creek; thence towards the east generally by the left bank of that creek to a point in line with the southern boundary-line of Section No. 28, Parish of Pakuranga; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of that section; thence by the road which forms the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 80, 116, and 98 of the said parish to Section No. 239; thence by Sections Nos. 239, 240, and 241 of the said parish, and the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 104 to the road which forms the western boundary of Section No. 174; thence by that road and its continuation passing Sections Nos. 217, 270, 271, 273, and 275, Parish of Pakuranga, to Section No. 192; thence by the abutment of a road and Sections Nos. 274, 117, 131, 178, 177, and 138, Parish of Pakuranga, to the northernmost corner of Section No. 153, Parish of Manurewa; thence by the said Section No. 153, and Sections Nos. 96 and 95 to the road which forms the south-western boundary of Section No. 94, Parish of Manurewa; thence towards the south-west by that road and its continuation passing Sections Nos. 94, 93, 92, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 27A, 33, 32, 30, 40, 39, 38, 12, and 11, all of the said Parish of Manurewa, to Section No. 13; thence by the road intersecting Sections Nos. 13, 10, and 9, Parish of Manurewa, and its continuation across the Tamaki River to the western shore thereof; thence towards the north-west and south by the western shores of the said Tamaki River to the Tamaki Portage Road; thence towards the south generally by that road to Manukau Harbour; thence by the said Manukau Harbour to the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, at Section No. 75, near the Wairaki Stream; and thence again towards the north-west generally by the said Eden Electoral District and the Parnell Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Hobson Bay: including the islands of Motutapu, Motuihi, Rakino, Rangitoto, and Brown's.

FRANKLIN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Manukau Entrance, Manukau Harbour, and by the Manukau Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the north generally by the Hauraki Gulf; towards the east by the Firth of Thames to the Puwhenua Stream; thence towards the south by the southern boundary-line of the Wharekawa No. 4 Block (No. 1473) to its south-western corner; thence again towards the east by the eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 102, 103, 55, and 57, Block IV., Opaheke Survey District, to the Waikaka Block (No. 1656); thence by that block, and the Mangatangi, Poupiipi, and Wharekawa No. 2 Blocks respectively, to Section No. 48A (timber reserve), Block XII., Opaheke Survey District; thence again towards the south generally by the said Section No. 48A to its north-western corner; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 12, Parish of Otau; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section, and the eastern and southern boundary-lines of Section No. 13, to the road which forms its western boundary; thence by that road and its continuation northerly, passing Sections Nos. 13, 12, and 11, to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the road which forms part of the north-western boundary of Section No. 130 to Section No. 129, Parish of Opaheke; thence by that section to the road at its north-western boundary; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 129 and 131, to Section No. 117; thence by the said Section No. 117 and the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 118 to the northernmost corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 118 and Sections Nos. 115, 245, and 246, Parish of Opaheke, to the road forming the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of Section No. 172; thence by that road to Section No. 171; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 169 and 166 to the road which forms the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 22, 198, 218, and 163, Parish of Opaheke, and on to the Great South Road intersecting Sections Nos. 49 and 50, Parish of Opaheke; thence

towards the north-east by the Great South Road to the Mangatawhiri River; and thence by that river to the Waikato River; thence again towards the south and towards the south-east generally by the left bank of the said Waikato River to the ocean; and towards the west by the ocean to Manukau Entrance, the place of commencement: including the islands of Waiheke, Ponui, Pahiki, Rotoroa, Puketutu, and adjacent islands, and the islands in Manukau Harbour.

THAMES.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the ocean, from Cape Colville to the North Head of Tairua Harbour; towards the south-west by a right line drawn in a north-westerly direction from the north head of Tairua Harbour in the direction of the source of the Waikawau River as far as the Waiwawa River; thence towards the south-east generally by the said Waiwawa River and its tributary the Taitoko Stream to the source of the latter; thence by the Waiwhakaurunga and Mangarehu Blocks (formerly timber leases of 14,186 acres and 1,825 acres respectively) to the Mangakirikiri No. 1 Block (No. 3387A); thence by that block to its southernmost corner; thence by the summit of the range leading to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 2, Block V., Thames Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 2, the Karaka South No. 1 Block (No. 2597), and the left bank of Karaka Creek to the eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Thames (as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 16, 7th February, 1896); thence by the eastern boundary-lines of the said Borough of Thames to the south-eastern corner of that borough; thence towards the south, and again towards the south-west and towards the north respectively by the southern, south-western, and northern boundary-lines of the said borough of Thames to Rocky Point; and thence towards the west generally by the Firth of Thames: including Great Mercury, Cuvier, and adjacent islands.

OHINEMURI.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east by the Thames Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the southern boundary of the Borough of Thames at the Firth of Thames to the northern head of Tairua Harbour; thence towards the east by Tairua Harbour and the ocean to the Waihi River; thence towards the south-east by a right line in the direction of the summit of Te Aroha Mountain as far as the summit of the main range between the Thames River and the Bay of Plenty; thence towards the north-east by the summit of the said range to a point due east of the northernmost corner of Section No. 29, Block XII., Aroha Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line to that corner; thence again towards the south-east by the said Section No. 29 and Section No. 28 to the Thames River; thence towards the south-west by the said Thames River to a point due west of the summit of Te Aroha Mountain; thence again towards the south by a line due west to the Confiscation boundary-line (the last-mentioned line being the boundary between the Counties of Piako and Waikato); thence towards the west by the said Confiscation line, running northerly to where it last crosses the Waitakaruru Stream; thence again towards the north-west by the said Waitakaruru Stream to the Firth of Thames; and thence by the Firth of Thames to the southern boundary-line of the Borough of Thames: including Slipper Island.

WAIKATO.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Franklin Electoral District hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Waikato River to the Firth of Thames; thence towards the east generally by the Firth of Thames to the mouth of the Waitakaruru Stream; thence by the Ohinemuri Electoral District hereinbefore described and the Confiscation boundary-line respectively to Pukemoremore Trig. Station (No. 50); thence by a right line in the direction of Opuhau Trig. Station as far as a point due east of the north-eastern corner of Section No. 173, Parish of Hautapu; thence towards the south generally by a right line to the said corner; thence by the said Section No. 173, and Sections Nos. 172, 171, 174, 177, 173, 179, 180, 181, 77, 76, 63, 62, 61, 60, 59, 58, and 98, all of the Parish of Hautapu, to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the south-east by the abutment of a road, and by Sections Nos. 155, 153, 152, 151, 150, 148, and 147, of the Parish of Hautapu, to the Waikato River; thence again towards the north-east by the said Waikato River to the western boundary-line of Section No. 20, Parish of Pukekura; thence again towards the south-east by that section and the road forming the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 23 and 28 to the road intersecting Sections Nos. 108, 107, 106, 105, 109, 104, and 103 of the said Parish of Pukekura; thence by that road and its continuation southerly intersecting Section No. 225 to Section No. 133, Parish of Puniu; thence again towards the north-east by Section No. 225, Parish of Pukekura, to the Mangapiko Stream; thence

by that stream to Section No. 156, Parish of Puniu; thence by part of the north-western boundary of Section No. 156 and the whole of the north-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 156, 157, and 158 of the said Parish of Puniu to the easternmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the south-east by Subdivisions Nos. 1G, 1H, 1J, 1K, and 1L of the Puhau Block, and by the Puhau No. 2 Block, the Ngamako No. 2 Block, and the Ngamako Block to the Puniu River; thence again towards the east generally by the said Puniu River to its source; thence by a right-line to Ranginui Trig. Station (No. 1386); thence by a right-line to the source of the Mokau River; thence by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Auckland and Taranaki to the Ongaruhe River; thence by the said Ongaruhe River to its confluence with the Wanganui River near Taumarunui; thence again towards the south-west generally by a right-line through the Ohura South Block and the Ratatomokia Block to the confluence of the Watohe Stream with the Hapurua; thence by the former-mentioned stream to its source; thence by the summit of the watershed and by the leading spur to the Mokau-iti River near Papatara; thence by the said Mokau-iti River to its confluence with the Mokau River; thence by the said Mokau River to its confluence with the Mangaotaki River; thence by the last-mentioned river to its source; thence by a right-line to Maungamangero Trig. Station (No. 1657); thence by the summit of the range leading to the sea-coast at Tirua Point; and thence towards the west generally by the ocean to the Waikato River aforesaid.

BAY OF PLENTY.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by Ohinemuri Electoral District hereinbefore described from the Confiscation boundary-line to the Bay of Plenty; thence by the Bay of Plenty to Cape Runaway; thence towards the east by a right line to the summit of Mount Hikurangi; thence towards the south-east by right lines from hill to hill along the summit of the watershed between the Bay of Plenty and the east coast to Trig. Station No. 139A; thence by a right line over Trig. Station No. 140 to the Motu River; thence by the right bank of the said Motu River to the north-western boundary-line of the Motu Block; thence by that block to its westernmost corner at the Koranga River; thence again towards the north-east by the right bank of the said Koranga River to its source; thence by a right line to Maungatapere Trig. Station; thence again towards the south-east by a right line to Maungapohatu; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to Trig. NAPIER.

WAIRARAPA.

No. 12 and Sections No. 2, 10, and 8 of the said Block XVI., and by Sections Nos. 7 and 1, and the Feilding Road to Section No. 19, Block IV., Kairanga Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 19 to Section No. 15; thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Section No. 15, and Sections Nos. 70, 47, 46, 45, 44, 43, 42, 41, 40, 39, 38, 37, 36, 35, 34, 33, and 32, Block III., Kairanga Survey District; thence by the railway-line to and over the Oroua River, and on to Section No. 149 (Native reserve); thence by that section, Section No. 86, Block XIV., Oroua Survey District, and that portion of Sections Nos. 85 and 132 of the said Block XVI. lying to the west of a line bearing 354° 11' magnetic from a point on the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 86 distant 796 links from Awahuri Road; thence by a road and Section No. 130 of the said Block XIV. to Mount Taylor; thence by the said Section No. 130 and Sections Nos. 129 and 125, Block XIV., Oroua Survey District, Sections Nos. 124, 119, 118, and 112, Block IX., Oroua Survey District, and Section No. 111, Block XII., Rangitoto Survey District, to Mount Biggs; thence by Section No. 101, the southern boundary-line of Section No. 144 (Native reserve), and the eastern and southern boundary-lines of Section No. 99, Block XII., Rangitoto Survey District, and the said southern boundary-line produced to the right bank of Rangitikei River; thence again towards the west by the right bank of the said Rangitikei River to the south-western corner of the Native reserve (173 acres), Block IV., Rangitoto Survey District; and thence by the Patea Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Trig. Station No. 28 aforesaid.

PALMERSTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by the Rangitikei Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the railway-bridge over the Oroua River to the summit of the Ruahine Range; thence towards the south-east by the Pahiatua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Ararua Trig. Station; thence towards the south-west by the south-western boundary-line of the block formerly known as the Township of Fitzherbert Block (part of the northern boundary of Horowhenua County) to the Manawatu River; thence towards the south generally by the said Manawatu River to its confluence with the Oroua River; thence towards the west by the said Oroua River to the railway-bridge over the Oroua River aforesaid.

MANAWATU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Wanganui Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Wangapehu River to the easternmost corner of Section No. 250, Block XI., Ikitara Survey District; thence towards the north-east by the Patea Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Rangitikei River; thence towards the east generally by the Rangitikei and the Palmerston Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described, to Ararua Trig. Station on the Tararua Range; thence by the summit of the Tararua Range to Mairakau Trig. Station; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 1, Block XI., Ararua Survey District; thence by the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 1, 2, and 3 of the said Block XI. to the Mangahao River; thence by the right bank of the Mangahao River to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 4, Block IV., Waiopahu Survey District to the easternmost corner of that section; thence by the south-eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 4 and 5 of the said Block IV. to subdivision No. 12 of the Horowhenua Block; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Subdivision No. 12 and original Subdivisions Nos. 5, 4, and 3 of the Horowhenua Block to the Arapaepae Road; thence by the said Arapaepae Road to Subdivision No. C (40 acres 3 roods 8 perches) of the original Subdivision No. 3 of the said Horowhenua Block; thence by Subdivisions Nos. C, B, A, and 3D, No. 1 of original Subdivision No. 3 aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned subdivision; thence by a right line across the railway-line and road to the easternmost corner of the Horowhenua Village Settlement; thence by the Horowhenua Village Settlement and the State farm to the northernmost corner of the said farm; thence by the road passing the southern shore of Horowhenua Lake and proceeding westerly through Raumatangi to the Horowhenua River; and thence by the said Horowhenua River to the ocean; and thence towards the west by the ocean to the mouth of the Wangapehu River aforesaid.

OTAKI.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Manawatu Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Horowhenua River to the easternmost corner of Subdivision No. 3 of the Horowhenua Block; thence towards the south-east generally by the Masterton and the Wairarapa Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described, to Cape Turakirae; thence towards the south-west by Cook Strait; towards the west generally by Port

Nicholson to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 8, Block XIII., Belmont Survey District; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 8; thence by that section to White's Road; thence towards the south by White's Road to the extension of the road which forms the north-western boundary of Alicetown; thence towards the north-west by that extension, and by the said road to the Hutt River; thence by the right bank of the Hutt River to the Lower Hutt Bridge; thence again towards the west generally by the south side of the road leading from the Lower Hutt Bridge (Bridge Street) to the Wellington-Eketehuna Railway-line; thence by that railway-line to a point in line with the western side of the Belmont Road; thence by a right line across the railway and road to the west side of the said Belmont Road; and thence by the western side of that road to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 28, Block VIII., Belmont Survey District, on the western boundary-line of the Borough of Lower Hutt; thence again towards the south-east by the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 28, and the north-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 24 and 20 (Native reserve), to Section No. 79, Block VIII., Belmont Survey District; thence towards the south and south-west generally by the said Section No. 79, and Sections Nos. 78 and 7, to the road forming the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road to the Johnsonville-Horokiwi Road; thence by the last-mentioned road to Section No. 10, Block XII., Belmont Survey District at the Johnsonville Town District boundary; thence by lines so as to include the Johnsonville Town District to the road at the north-western boundary of Section No. 91, Block XI., Belmont Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation passing the said Section No. 91, and Section No. 89, to Section No. 13; thence by the said Section No. 13, and Sections Nos. 16 and 19, Block I., Port Nicholson Survey District, and Sections Nos. 22, 25, and 60, Block VI., Belmont Survey District and Sections Nos. 59 and 110, Block I., Port Nicholson Survey District, to the ocean; and thence towards the west by the ocean; including the Islands of Kapiti and Mana.

CITY OF WELLINGTON.

This district is bounded by a line commencing at Port Nicholson, at the boundary between the City of Wellington and the Borough of Onslow, and proceeding thence westerly along the boundary-line between the said City of Wellington and the Borough of Onslow to Tinakori North Native Reserve; thence along the eastern boundaries of Native Reserves, Tinakori North, Tinakori South, and Orangi-Kaupapa, to the junction of Boundary Road and Grant Road; thence along the southern side of Boundary Road to Tinakori Road; thence across the Tinakori Road to the eastern side thereof; thence along the eastern side of Tinakori Road and Karori Road to the western boundary of the Botanical Gardens Reserve; thence to the north-western corner of Section No. 28 (Upland Farm), Karori District; thence along the northern boundary of said Section No. 28 (Upland Farm) to the boundary of the City Reserves in the Terrace District; thence southerly along the western boundaries of the reserves in the said district to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 28 (Upland Farm); thence westerly along the southern boundary of the said Section No. 28 to the north-western corner of Section No. 11 of the City Reserves; thence southerly along the western boundary of the City Reserves; thence easterly along the northern boundary of Section No. 11, Ohiro, to the western side of Epuni Street; thence across Epuni Street; thence southerly along the eastern side of Happy Valley Road to the southern boundary-line of City Reserve No. 41; thence easterly along the southern boundary of that reserve to its south-eastern corner; thence southerly along the western boundaries of City Reserves Nos. 38 and 37, and thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said Reserve No. 37, and southerly along the western boundaries of Reserves Nos. 35, 34, and 33 to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned reserve; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said Reserve No. 33, and along the western boundary-line of City Reserve No. 32 to its south-western corner; thence easterly along the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned reserve and the southern boundary-line of Town Section No. 934 to Adelaide Road; thence southerly along the west side of Adelaide Road to a point in line with the north side of Stokes Street; thence easterly across Adelaide Road and along the north side of Stokes Street to Rintoul Street; thence northerly along the west side of Rintoul Street to Riddiford Street; thence southerly along the west side of Riddiford Street to a point in line with the north side of Constable Street; thence easterly across Riddiford Street to Constable Street, and along the north side of that street and the north side of Travers Street to Wellington Road at the western boundary of the Township of Kilbirnie; thence northerly along the western boundary of the Township of Kilbirnie to the

northern boundary line of that township; thence easterly along the northern boundary-line of the said Township of Kilbirnie, and that line produced across the Evans Bay Road to Evans Bay; thence northerly along the shore of Evans Bay to Point Jerningham; thence south-westerly and northerly along the shore of Lambton Harbour to the eastern boundary of the land granted to the Corporation of the City of Wellington on the 24th June, 1874; thence along the said eastern boundary and along the seaward boundary of the said land to the eastern boundary of the land granted to the Superintendent of Wellington on the 18th October, 1855; and thence along the seaward boundary of the last-mentioned land, and the seaward boundary of the reclaimed land to the commencing point.

SUBURBS OF WELLINGTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north generally by the Otaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the northernmost corner of Section No. 110, Block I., Port Nicholson Survey District, to a point on Port Nicholson near the south-eastern corner of the Borough of Petone; thence towards the south-east by Port Nicholson to the City of Wellington Electoral District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the east generally, and again towards the north by the said City of Wellington Electoral District to Evans Bay; thence towards the west by Evans Bay to Point Halswell; thence again towards the east by the water of Port Nicholson to Falmer Head, and thence again towards the south and west by the ocean to the northernmost corner of Section No. 110 aforesaid; including Somes Island.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Middle Island Representation Commission, appointed under the provisions of "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1896," have made their report to me under their hands and seals, setting forth the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the Middle Island (including Stewart Island), fixed by them in accordance with "The Representation Act, 1887," and the Acts amending the same:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the fifth section of "The Representation Act, 1887," I, David, Earl of Glasgow, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the Middle Island (including Stewart Island), so fixed by the said Commission, to be those respectively mentioned and set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

CITY OF NELSON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by a right line proceeding from the lighthouse on the Boulder Bank in the direction of the south-western corner of Section No. 1, Suburban North, as far as low-water mark of Tasman Bay; thence towards the north-west generally by Tasman Bay and the French Pass to Pa Harakeke Point; thence towards the south-east generally by Admiralty Bay to a point in Hamilton's Bay due east of the easternmost corner of Section No. 20, Block VIII., French Pass Survey District; thence by a right line to the said easternmost corner; thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 20 and 21, Block VIII. aforesaid, and the north-western side of that road produced to Burnside's Bay; thence by Hallam Cove, Fitzroy Bay, Tennyson Inlet, Tawhitinui Reach, Popoure Reach, Hikapu Reach, and Mahau Sound, to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 219, Town District of Havelock; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the southernmost corner of that section; thence towards the south-west generally by the

south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 219, by the western boundary-line of that section, the north-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 218 and 217, the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 216, 215, 214, 213, 212, 211, 210, 209, 208, 207, 206, 205, 204, 203, and 64, to Kavanagh Street, Havelock; thence by Section No. 145, Havelock suburban section, to its southernmost corner; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 87, Block XI., Wakamarina Survey District; thence by that section and Section No. 15, and the north-eastern boundary-line of the said section produced to the south bank of a channel of the Pelorus River, at the northern boundary of that section; thence towards the south by the south bank of the said channel of the Pelorus River to its confluence with the Wakamarina River; thence again towards the south-east by the west bank of the said Wakamarina River to its source; thence by a line due south to the summit of the watershed between the Pelorus and Wairau Valleys; thence by the summit of that watershed to the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough; thence again towards the south-west and north-west by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to the southern boundary-line of Square 18; thence again towards the south by a line running due west until it is intersected by a right line bearing S. 45° W. from a point about two miles distant from the north-eastern corner of Section No. xviii., Suburban North, and in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. xviii.; thence again towards the south-east by a right line bearing S. 45° W., until it intersects the River Lee; thence towards the south-west generally by the said River Lee to its confluence with the River Roding; thence by the latter river to its confluence with the River Wairoa, and thence by the last-mentioned river to the Nelson-Belgrove Railway-line; thence by the said railway-line to the southernmost corner of Section No. 40, Waimea Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 40 and that line produced across the Wai-iti River to Section No. 1 of 161; thence by the southern and western boundary-lines of Section 1 of 161 of the said Waimea Survey District by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. part of 161 and 165, and the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 165, and part of the north-western boundary-line of Section No. part of 162 to the southern corner of Section No. 16, Waimea Survey District; thence by the south-western and north-western boundaries of the said Section No. 16 and the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Section No. 17 to the westernmost corner of Section No. 12, Waimea Survey District; thence by the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 12 to the road which forms the northern boundary of that section; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 13, 14, 26, 19, 206, 182, and 4, Wai-iti Survey District, to the westernmost corner of Section No. 186, Eve's Valley, of the said Wai-iti Survey District; thence by the north-western boundary of the said Section No. 186 to Section No. 37, Wai-iti Survey District; thence by Sections Nos. 1, 188, 7, and 27, to the southernmost corner of Section No. 126, Wai-iti Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-line of Sections Nos. 126 and 127 to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Sections Nos. 29, 19, 3, 4, 11, 157, 13, 16, 14, 151, and 15, all of Wai-iti Survey District; thence towards the west generally by Sections Nos. 13, 11, 111, 10, 6, 5, and 4, Block XIV., Motueka Survey District, and by Section No. 1, Block XV., Motueka Survey District; thence towards the north generally by Sections Nos. 21 and 73, Block XI., Motueka Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 74, 138, 141, 143, 145, 84, 82, and 81, Block XV., Motueka Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 80, 115, 1, 158, 159, 26A, 27, and 31A, Block XVI., Motueka Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Sections Nos. 29 and 28, 1 and 2, Moutere Survey District, to the southernmost point of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the western extremity of Rabbit Island; and thence again towards the north and the north-west by Tasman Bay and the seaward boundary of the Boulder Bank to a point in line with a right line drawn from the lighthouse on the Boulder Bank in the direction of the south-western corner of Section No. 1, Suburban North; and thence again towards the north-east by a right line to the said lighthouse: including Rabbit Island, Saxton's Island, Oyster Island, Pepin Island, and Fifeshire Island.

MOTUEKA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the ocean from the Ngakawhau River to the Cape Farewell Lighthouse; thence towards the east generally by Golden Bay and Tasman Bay to the City of Nelson Electoral District, hereinbefore described, at Rabbit Island; thence towards the south generally and towards the north-east by the said City of Nelson Electoral District to the summit of the watershed between the Wairau and Pelorus

Valleys; thence towards the south-east generally by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to Tophouse; thence by the summit of St. Arnaud Range to a point near the head-waters of the Motupiko River; thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of the watershed between the Rivers Motupiko and Buller and the summit of the watershed between the said Buller River and the Hope River to the confluence of the two last-named rivers; thence by the summit of the watershed between the Rivers Hope and Owen to Mount Owen; thence again towards the south-east generally by the summit of the range leading from Mount Owen to the Lyell Range, and by the summit of the said Lyell Range to Bald Hill, Block X., Lyell Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the watershed leading up to the head waters of Lyell Creek and Slaty Creek and by the summit of the leading spur to the source of the said Slaty Creek; thence by a line due west to the nearest source of the Ngakawhau River; and thence by the said Ngakawhau River to the ocean.

WAIRAU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to the summit of the watershed between the Wairau and Pelorus Valleys, and by the City of Nelson Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the French Pass; thence by the French Pass and Tasman Bay; towards the north-east and towards the south-east generally by Cook Strait and the ocean to the mouth of the Clarence River; thence towards the south-west, and again towards the south-east, and towards the south by the said Clarence River to its confluence with the Acheron River; thence towards the west generally by the said Acheron River to its confluence with the Guide River; and thence by the last-named river to its source; thence by a right line to Barefell Pass; and thence by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to Tophouse aforesaid: including D'Urville, Stephen, Arapawa, The Brothers, and adjacent islands.

BULLER.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Ngakawhau River, on the West Coast, to a point on the summit of the St. Arnaud Range near the head waters of the Motupiko River; thence towards the south-east by the summits of the St. Arnaud Range and the Spencer Range respectively to the watershed between the Grey and Inangahua Rivers; thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of that watershed to Mount Haast; thence by the summit of the western watershed of the Inangahua River over Trig. Stations G, P, O, and A, Waitahu Survey District, to the source of the Devil's Creek; thence by the watershed between Devil's Creek and Slab Hut Creek and the watershed between the Inangahua River and the Mawhera-iti River to the source of the said Mawhera-iti River; and thence by the leading spur to the summit of the range dividing the Blackwater and Inangahua Rivers; thence by the summit of that range to Mount Faraday; and thence by the summit of the Paparoa Mountains to the range between the Okari River and the Totara River, and by the summit of the last-mentioned range to the spur leading to the mouth of the Totara River; thence by that spur to the mouth of the said Totara River at the sea-coast; and thence towards the west and north-west by the ocean to the mouth of the Ngakawhau River aforesaid.

GREY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Buller Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Totara River, on the West Coast, to the summit of the Spenser Mountains; thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Spenser Mountains and the summit of the main range leading to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River; thence towards the south-west by a right line to where the Arnold River debouches from Lake Brunner; thence again towards the south-east by Lake Brunner to the mouth of the Eastern Hohouu River; thence again towards the south-west generally by that river to a point due east of the confluence of Foley's Creek with Blackwater Creek; thence by a right line in the direction of the confluence of the said creeks to the summit of the range leading northerly to the source of the Eight-mile Creek; thence by the summit of that range and by Eight-mile Creek to the New River; thence by the New River to Maori Creek Road; thence by that road to the A. K. Road; thence by the last-mentioned road to Card's Creek, and by Card's Creek to a bend in that creek about 50 chains east of Section No. 2027, Waimea Survey District; thence by a right line to the confluence of Hughes's Creek with the Taramakau River, and thence by

the said Taramakau River to the ocean; and thence towards the west by the ocean to the mouth of the Totara River aforesaid.

WESTLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Grey Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Taramakau River, on the West Coast, to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River; thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Southern Alps to Mount Aspiring; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the mouth of the Awarua River in Big Bay; and thence towards the north-west by the ocean to the Grey Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

ASHLEY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north-west generally by the Wairau Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to the mouth of the Clarence River; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the Ashley River; thence towards the south by the said Ashley River to a point due north of the north-eastern corner of Section No. 24303, Block II., Mairaki Survey District; thence towards the east generally by a right line to the north-eastern corner of that section; thence by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the said Section No. 24303, and by the road which forms the north-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 24241, 1253, and 13987 of the said Block II.; thence by the south side of the Mairaki Downs Road to Section No. 9791, Block VI., Mairaki Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 9791 and Sections Nos. 15213, 13619, 12626, 12321, 11124, 26468, and 27370, to the road which forms the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 11134, 13684, and 15467 of the said Block VI. to the Oxford and Rangiora railway-line; thence again towards the south by the Oxford and Rangiora railway-line to the Oxford and Sheffield Railway-line; and thence by that railway-line to the Waimakariri River; thence towards the south-west and west by that river to a line formerly known as the northern boundary-line of Run No. 270; thence towards the north by that boundary-line (county boundary) to the summit of the Puketirake Range; thence again towards the north-west by the summit of that range to Ashley Head; thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the range leading over Esk Head and Snowy Peak to the source of the south branch of the Hurunui River; thence by a right line to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River; thence again towards the north-west by the Grey Electoral District, hereinbefore described, the Buller Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Wairau Electoral District aforesaid at Tophouse, the place of commencement.

KAIAPOI.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the Ashley Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Waimakariri River at the crossing of the Oxford and Sheffield Railway to the mouth of the Ashley River; thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the mouth of the Waimakariri River; thence towards the south generally by the southern bank of the said Waimakariri River and the southern bank of its south branch; and again by the southern bank of the said Waimakariri River to the crossing of the Oxford and Sheffield Railway-line aforesaid.

The district is bounded towards the north-west and north generally by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 10938, Block VI., Christchurch Survey District, to the mouth of the Waimakariri River; thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the estuary of the Heathcote and the Avon Rivers; thence towards the south-west and towards the south-east by the said estuary to the south-western side of the Canal Reserve; thence towards the south-west by the south-western side of the said Canal Reserve (being the north-eastern boundary of the Borough of Woolston) to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Aldwin's Road; thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the south-eastern side of Aldwin's Road, and by the south-eastern side of that road and its production to the southern side of Ferry Road; thence again towards the south-west by the southern side of Ferry Road to Ensor's Road; thence again towards the south-east by the eastern side of Ensor's Road to the reserve for the Christchurch-Lyttelton Railway; thence again towards the south-west by that reserve to Wilson's Road on the Sydenham Borough boundary; thence towards the north-west by Wilson's Road to Ferry Road; thence again towards the south-west by Ferry Road to the East Town Belt of the City

of Christchurch; thence towards the west by the said East Town Belt to the south side of St. Asaph Street, Linwood; thence again towards the north by the said St. Asaph Street to Phillips Street, Linwood; thence again towards the west by Phillips Street to Drain Road, Linwood; thence again towards the north by Drain Road to Stanmore Road, Linwood; thence again towards the west by the said Stanmore Road to the River Avon; thence again towards the north and towards the north-west by the left bank of that river to a point in line with the southern boundary-line of a subdivision of Section No. 197, Block XI., Christchurch Survey District, containing 3 acres and 35 perches; thence towards the south by a right line to the said southern boundary-line; thence by that boundary-line to the road which forms the north-western boundary of a subdivision of the said Section No. 197, containing 5 acres 2 rods; thence by that road to a road intersecting the said Section No. 197, and by the last-mentioned road to the North Avon Road; thence by that road to Hill's Road; thence again towards the west by the said Hill's Road to Shirley's Road; thence again towards the south-west by the said Shirley's Road to Innes Road; thence again towards the south-east by the south side of Innes Road to Philpott's Road; thence again towards the south-west by the west side of Philpott's Road to McFadden's Road; thence again towards the south-east by the south side of McFadden's Road to May's Road, and by the south side of May's Road to Papanui Road; thence again towards the north-east by the east side of Papanui Road to Norman's Road; and thence again towards the south-east by the north side of Norman's Road to Rural Section No. 453, Block XI., Christchurch Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the said Section No. 453 and Rural Section No. 2382 of the said Block XI., and Rural Sections Nos. 1101 and 2200 of Block X., Christchurch Survey District, to Rural Section No. 323, Block VI.; thence again towards the north-west by the north-western boundary-line of original Rural Section No. 151 of the said Block XI. to the Papanui Road at or near its junction with the Main North Road; thence by a line across that road to the Main North Road; thence by the Main North Road to Toomes Road; thence again towards the south-west generally by the south side of the said Toomes Road to the western boundary-line of Section No. 279; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 280, 799, 1000, 982, 528, 489, 434, 490, 529, 492, 533, 961, 4827, 10907, 2486, and 10938, all of Christchurch Survey District aforesaid, to the Waimakariri River at the Kaiapoi Electoral District aforesaid.

CITY OF CHRISTCHURCH.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and east generally by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Rural Section No. 453, Block XI., Christchurch Survey District, at Norman's Road to where Wilson's Road is crossed by the Christchurch-Lyttelton Railway; thence towards the south-east by the said Wilson's Road to the road running along the Heathcote River, and known as Heathcote Terrace; thence by the said Heathcote Terrace to Tennyson Street; thence towards the south by the said Tennyson Street to Colombo Road; thence towards the west by the said Colombo Road to Strickland Street; thence towards the south-west by the said Strickland Street and its north-eastern side produced across the River Heathcote; thence again towards the south by that river to Douglas Jerrold Street, and by the last-mentioned street to the Lower Lincoln Road; thence again towards the north-west by that road to Hagley Park; thence again towards the south and west by the southern and western boundary-lines of Hagley Park to Waimairi Creek (branch of the River Avon); thence towards the north by the left bank of that creek and the River Avon to Boundary Road; thence again towards the south-west by the said Boundary Road to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of original Rural Section No. 133, Block XI., Christchurch Survey District; thence again towards the south-east by that road to the River Avon; and again towards the south-west by that river and Rural Section No. 242 of the said Block XI. to Norman's Road aforesaid.

LYTTELTON.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the City of Christchurch Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Lower Lincoln Road to where Wilson's Road is crossed by the Christchurch-Lyttelton Railway; thence towards the north-east generally by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the estuary of the Heathcote and the Avon Rivers; thence by the said estuary and Pegasus Bay to Godley Head; thence towards the south and east by Lyttelton Harbour to the Head of the Bay at the bridge near the mouth of Te Rapu Stream; thence by a line to the nearest point of the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 25401, Block VII., Halswell Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation towards Gebbie's Pass, passing Sections Nos. 344, 481, 75, 13920, 34609, and

35602, to Section No. 21471, Block XI., Halswell Survey District; thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 21471 and Section No. 6076 to the road which forms part of the southern boundary of Section No. 35602 of the said Block XI.; thence by the south side of that road and its continuation westerly, passing Sections Nos. 6260, 4190, and 1383, to the western boundary-line of Section No. 1194; thence by that section and Section No. 4621 of the said Block XI. to Section No. 1390; thence towards the west generally by the said Section No. 1390, and Sections Nos. 1196, 14334, 33951, 1132, 1060, 906, 34555, 13609, 34551, 18809, 1443, 35510, 1403, 33748, and 565, Block VII., Halswell Survey District, and Sections Nos. 485 and 33742, Block III., Halswell Survey District, to the road intersecting the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation northerly to Section No. 33746 of the said Block III.; thence by the said Section No. 33746 to the Hoon Hay Road; thence by the Hoon Hay Road to Sutherland's Road; thence by Sutherland's Road to Milne's Road; thence by Milne's Road to Lower Lincoln Road; thence by Lower Lincoln Road to the road which forms the western boundary of Rural Section No. 141, Block XIV., Christchurch Survey District; thence by that road to the stream on the western boundary of Rural Section No. 346, and thence by that stream to Middle Lincoln Road; thence towards the north-west by the Middle Lincoln Road to Junction Road; thence again towards the north-east by Junction Road to Lower Lincoln Road; and thence again towards the north-west by the last-mentioned road to the City of Christchurch Electoral District aforesaid.

RICCARTON.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the groin on the south bank of the Waimakariri River at Thompson's Road to the easternmost corner of Section No. 10938, Block VI., Christchurch Survey District; thence towards the east generally by the Avon Electoral District and the City of Christchurch and Lyttelton Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described, to Hoon Hay Road; thence towards the south-east generally by the said Hoon Hay Road to Quarry Road, and by Quarry Road to Section No. 1350, Block II., Halswell Survey District; thence by that section to the Lower Lincoln Road; thence by that road to the Halswell River; thence by the said Halswell River to the bridge on the Tramway Road; thence by the said Tramway Road to the road which forms the southern boundary of Section No. 4980 of the said Block II.; thence by the last-mentioned road to the road which forms the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 3861 and 3862 of the said Block II. to the Tancred and Halswell Road; thence by that road to the Southbridge Railway-line, and thence by the said railway-line to Springs Road; thence towards the west by Springs Road to Boundary Road; thence towards the south-west by Boundary Road to Weedon and Springs Road, and by that road to the Main South Road; thence again towards the south-east by the Main South Road to the Main Trunk Railway-line, and thence by the Main Trunk Railway-line to the Malvern Railway-line; thence again towards the south-west by the Malvern Railway-line to Sandy Knoll Road; and thence again towards the west by Sandy Knoll Road and Thompson's to the Kaiapoi Electoral District aforesaid.

ELLESMERE.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Riccarton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Springs Road to Sutherland's Road; thence towards the east generally by the Lyttelton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Head of the Bay; thence towards the north by Lyttelton Harbour and the ocean; again towards the east and towards the south by the ocean to the Rakaia River; thence towards the south-west by the Rakaia River to a point in line with the south side of Rakaia and Irwell Road; thence again towards the north-west by a right line to the south side of the said road, and by that road to the Main Dunsandel Road; thence towards the east by the Main Dunsandel Road to Drain Road; thence towards the north by Drain Road easterly, crossing Killinchy, Cooper's, Webster's, and Harman's Roads, to the Southbridge Railway-line; and thence again towards the north-west by the Southbridge Railway-line to Springs Road aforesaid at the Riccarton Electoral District aforesaid.

SELWYN.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Ashley and the Kaiapoi Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described, from the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River to Thompson's Road at the Waimakariri River; thence towards the east and again towards the north-east by the Riccarton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the

Southbridge Railway-line; thence generally towards the south-east and again towards the north-east by the Ellesmere Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean at the mouth of the Rakaia River; thence again towards the south-east by the ocean to a point in line with the north-eastern side of the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 27247 (Chertsey Boundary Road); thence towards the south-west by a right line to that road; thence by that road and its continuation northerly, passing the following sections—viz.: Sections Nos. 27248 and 26910, Block I., South Rakaia Survey District, Section No. 26909, Block VIII., Rakaia Survey District, Sections Nos. 26495, 26494, 26635, 25840, and 25770, Block XII., Ashburton Survey District, Sections Nos. 25646, 26534, 24981, and Reserve No. 1771, Block VIII., Ashburton Survey District; thence by a line being the continuation of the north-eastern boundary-line of that reserve across the Railway Reserve to the Great South Road; thence again towards the south-east by that road to Section No. 27031, Block VI., Ashburton Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section and its continuation northerly to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 27392, Block II., Ashburton Survey District; thence towards the north-west by the north-west side of the last-mentioned road to the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 27392; thence again towards the south-west by that section and Sections Nos. 27969, 27970, 27985, 28020, 31252, 30505, 30504, and 30506, Block I., Ashburton Survey District, and Sections Nos. 30509, Block VII., Corwar Survey District, and 34170, 30966, and 34169, Block XVI., Spaxton Survey District, to Lyndhurst Road; thence again towards the south-east by Lyndhurst Road to Thompson's Road; thence by Sections Nos. 25462 and 26862, Block XV., Spaxton Survey District, and Sections Nos. 25538, 20654, 19708, 15441, 34166, and 34165, Block III., Westerfield Survey District, and the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the north branch of the Ashburton River; thence again towards the south-west by the north branch of the Ashburton River to Boundary Creek, and thence by Boundary Creek to the source of the said creek near Mount Taylor; thence by a right line to the said Mount Taylor; and thence by Runs Nos. 115 and 117 to the mouth of Lake Stream, in the Rakaia River; thence by that river to its source; and thence by a line due west to the Southern Alps at the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District aforesaid to the Hurunui Saddle, the place of commencement.

ASHBURTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Selwyn Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Southern Alps to the ocean at Chertsey Boundary Road; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Rangitata River; thence towards the south-west by the Rangitata River to its confluence with Forest Creek; thence again towards the south-east by Forest Creek to Run No. 77; thence again towards the west generally by that run to The Thumbs; thence by the summit of the watershed over Alma Peak to the Southern Alps; and thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Selwyn Electoral District aforesaid.

GERALDINE.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by the Ashburton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the eastern boundary of Run No. 77, near Two-thumb Range, to the ocean at the mouth of the Rangitata River; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Opihi River; thence towards the south by the right bank of the Opihi River to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 21122, Block IV., Pareora Survey District; thence again towards the south-east generally by that section and Section No. 10454, Block IV., and Sections Nos. 12448, 16677, and 17800, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District, to the Albury Railway-line; thence by that railway-line to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 15245, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 12242, 13744, 12875, 18516, 15830, 15877, 17304, and 19165, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District, to the road at the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 17311; thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 17311, 19165, 19454, 19427, 19222, 18561, and 23283, by the road which intersects Rural Section No. 18558, and by that road continued in a south-westerly direction through Rural Sections Nos. 18559, 19552, and 19553, and passing Rural Sections Nos. 25600, 21782, 29557, 33834, 21781, and 27940, to Sutherland's Road; thence towards the west by Sutherland's Road and the north-eastern side of that road

produced across the Mackenzie Road to its northern side; thence again towards the south-east by that road to the road forming the eastern boundary of Section No. 35037 of the said Block VI., and thence again towards the south-west by the last-mentioned road to the Tengawai River; thence again towards the south-east by that river to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Section No. 5209, Block V., Pareora Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by a right line to that section, and by the said Section No. 5209, and by Sections Nos. 21990, 26284, 33833, and 2440 to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the north side of the road intersecting Section No. 16285, and by Sections Nos. 21213, 24741, 28531, 19891, and 24743, Block IX., to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the east side of the road running southerly to and intersecting Sections Nos. 21088 and 16279, and by Sections Nos. 21087, 24178, 24179, 33827, 24745, and 30445, Block XIII., of Pareora Survey District, to the Pareora River; thence towards the south generally by the said Pareora River and its main branch flowing from Mount Nimrod; thence towards the west generally by the summit of the eastern watershed of the Hakateramea River over Trig. Stations L, Block XIII., Opuha Survey District, and O, Mackenzie Survey District, to the head-waters of the Hakateramea River; thence by the summit of Dalgetty Range over Trig. Station B, Burke Survey District, to Mackenzie Pass; thence again towards the north by the Mackenzie Stream to Section No. 36463; thence by that section and Section No. 32070 to Run No. 23; thence by the said Run No. 23, Tengawai Survey District, to the road at the northern boundary-line of Section No. 31248, Block X., Tengawai Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation easterly to Section No. 18306; thence by the road which forms the northern and eastern boundaries of that section and its continuation to the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 20518; thence by part of that boundary-line to the south-eastern boundary-line of that section; thence towards the west by the said Section No. 20518, Block XI., Tengawai Survey District, to the Opihi River; thence again towards the south-west by the left bank of that river to Section No. 30438, Block III., Tengawai Survey District; thence again towards the north-west by the said Section No. 30438 and Sections Nos. 30437, 30454, 19949, 20209, and 25368 to the South Opuha River; thence again towards the south-west by the South Opuha River to its source in Two-thumb Range; thence again towards the north-west by the summit of Two-thumb Range to the source of Forest Creek; again towards the north generally by the said Forest Creek to the Ashburton Electoral District aforesaid.

TIMARU.

This district is bounded towards the south-west, towards the north-west, and towards the north generally by the Geraldine Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the western boundary-line of Section No. 30445, Block XIII., Pareora Survey District, at the Pareora River to the mouth of the Opihi River; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Pareora River; and thence towards the south-west by the Pareora River to the western boundary of Section No. 30445 aforesaid at the Geraldine Electoral District aforesaid.

WAITAKI.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Ashburton, the Geraldine, and the Timaru Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described, from the Southern Alps to the ocean at the mouth of the Pareora River; thence towards the east by the ocean to the right bank of the Waitaki River; thence towards the south by the said right bank of the Waitaki River to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Section No. 92, Block I., Awamoko Survey District; thence towards the east by a right line to the north-western corner of the said Section No. 92, and thence by that section and Sections Nos. 1, 31, 32, 73, 72, 74, and 75 of the said Block I., and by Sections Nos. 1, 39, 40, and 50, Block IV., Awamoko Survey District; thence again towards the south generally by the road intersecting Sections Nos. 22 and 21 to Section No. 28, and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 28 and 20, Block V., Awamoko Survey District, intersecting Sections Nos. 13 and 1, passing Section No. 15, and intersecting Sections Nos. 6 and 4 of the said Block V., to a road running westerly through the last-mentioned section; thence by the last-mentioned road to the western boundary-line of the said Section No. 4; thence by that section and by the south side of the road which forms the northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 47, 46, 45, 49, 44, 43, 42, and 41, Block VI., Awamoko Survey District, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the east by the said Section No. 41; thence by Blocks VII. and X. respectively, Awamoko Survey District, and Block III., Kauroo Survey District, to the south-western corner of Section

No. 23; thence again towards the north by the said Block III.; again towards the east by Block XIV., Oamaru Survey District, to the Kauroo River; thence again towards the south-east by the said Kauroo River; again towards the east by Block I., Kauroo Survey District, and Block VII., Otepopo Survey District, to Island Stream; thence again towards the south-east by that stream to the western boundary-line of Section No. 6, Block XV., Otepopo Survey District; thence again towards the east by that section and Section No. 3 to Section No. 4; thence again towards the south and east by that section and by Section No. 2, Block XIV., Otepopo Survey District, to its south-western corner; thence by a line due south to the north branch of the Waianakarua River; thence again towards the south generally by the said branch and Run No. 109, Waihemo Survey District, to the Horse Range; thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of that range and the summit of the Kakanui Mountains, through the Maruwhenua Pass, to Kyeburn Hill; thence by the summit of the main range leading to Mount Ida; and thence by the summit of the Hawkdn Mountains to a point due east of Mount St. Bathans; thence by a line drawn due west to the said Mount St. Bathans; thence by the summit of the range through the Lindis Pass to Longslip Hill; thence by the summit of the range leading to the watershed between the Rivers Ahuriri and Hunter; and thence by that watershed and the watershed between the said River Hunter and the Hopkins River to the Hunter Saddle; and thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Ashburton Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

OAMARU.

This district is bounded towards the west and north generally by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the production of the western boundary-line of Section No. 2, Block XIV., Otepopo Survey District, at the north branch of the Waianakarua River to the mouth of the Waitaki River; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Kakanui River; thence towards the south generally by the right bank of that river and the right bank of Island Stream to the Township of Maheno; thence by the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of that township; towards the east generally by the Main Trunk Railway-line to the Township of Herbert; thence by part of the northern, the whole of the western, and part of the southern boundary-lines of that township to the said railway-line; thence by the said Main Trunk Railway to the north branch of the Waianakarua River; and thence towards the south generally by the said north branch to the Waitaki Electoral District aforesaid.

WAIHEMO.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Mount St. Bathans to a point due south of the western boundary-line of Section No. 2, Block XIV., Otepopo Survey District; thence towards the north-west generally by the Oamaru Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Hawksbury; thence towards the south-west generally by the Borough of Hawksbury as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 69, 14th September, 1893, to the Main Trunk Railway; thence again towards the south-east by the Main Trunk Railway to the Waikouaiti River; thence again towards the south-west by the right bank of that river and the north branch thereof to Section No. 1 (P.R.), Block V., Hummockside Survey District; thence towards the south generally by the said Section No. 1 and Sections Nos. 26, 10, 9, and 7, Block VI., Waikouaiti Survey District, and by Runs Nos. 171A and 171B to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned run; thence again towards the south-west by the south-western boundary-line of Runs Nos. 171A and 171C to the Hummock (Trig. Station D); thence by Sections Nos. 1 and 15 (small grazing-runs) and by Run No. 121 to Nenthorn Creek; thence by Section No. 4, Block I., Hummock Survey District, to the northernmost corner of that section; thence towards the west by the western boundaries of Section No. 1, Block I., Hummock Survey District, and the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 2, 14, 15, 24, 16, 17, 19, 20, and 21, Block VI., Budle Survey District; thence again towards the south by Section No. 1, Block VII., Strath-Taieri Survey District, and Section No. 2, Block VI., Strath-Taieri Survey District, to the Taieri River; thence again towards the west by the right bank of the Taieri River to the north-eastern boundary-line of the Forest Plantation Reserve, in Block II., Strath-Taieri Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the said Plantation Reserve, again towards the south-east by Section No. 14 of the said Block II.; and again towards the south-west by Run No. 213A (educa-

tional endowment) to its north-western corner; thence again towards the south-east by the said Run No. 213A to Rock and Pillar Mountain; thence by a right line to Soutra Hill; thence by the summit of the leading ridge to Lammerlaw; thence again towards the west generally by the summit of the Lammerlaw Range and the summit of Rough Ridge to South Rough Ridge Hill; thence by a right line to North Rough Ridge Hill; thence by the summit of Rough Ridge to the north-eastern boundary of Run No. 261; thence again towards the south-west by that run and Block III., Poolburn Survey District, to Ida Burn; thence by the said Ida Burn to its confluence with the Manuherikia River; thence by that river to Lauder Creek; thence by that creek to its source; thence towards the north-west by a right line to a peak (geodesical station) between the Dunstan Pass and Dunstan Peak; and thence by a right line to Mount St. Bathans aforesaid at the Waitaki Electoral District aforesaid.

WAIKOUAITI.

This district is bounded towards the east and south generally by the ocean from the north-eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Hawksbury to a point near Lawyer's Head due south of the southernmost corner of Section No. 16, Block I., Anderson's Bay Survey District; thence towards the west by a right line to the southernmost corner of that section; thence towards the north-west by the said Section No. 16 and Section No. 13 of the said Block I., and by Sections Nos. 6 and 12, Block VII., Anderson's Bay Survey District, and Section No. 10, Block VIII.; thence towards the south-west by the said Section No. 10 and Sections Nos. 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 of the said Block VIII.; thence again towards the north-west by Section No. 21, Block I., Otago Peninsula, and the south-eastern boundary-line of that section produced to Otago Harbour; thence by a right line across Otago Harbour to the south-eastern corner of the Township of Ravensbourne; thence again towards the west by the Township of Ravensbourne and Section No. 66, Block IX., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, to the Borough of North-east Valley; thence again towards the south-west generally by the Borough of North-east Valley, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 89, 25th October, 1877, to the westernmost corner of Section No. 66, Block XI., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence again towards the north-west and towards the south by the Borough of Maori Hill, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 77, 8th August, 1878, to Swampy Hill (Trig. Station S); thence again towards the south-west by a right line to Silver Peak; and thence by Sections Nos. 2 and 1, Block V., Silver Peak Survey District, and the Otago Museum Endowment, and by the western boundary-lines of Section No. 1, Block IX., and Section No. 5, Block VIII., Silver Peak Survey District, and the western boundary-line of Run No. 171B to the north-western corner of that run at the Waihemo Electoral District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the north generally by the said Waihemo Electoral District to the ocean at the north-eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Hawksbury aforesaid.

CITY OF DUNEDIN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and east generally by the Waikouaiti Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the westernmost corner of Section No. 66, Block XI., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, to a point on the shore of North-east Harbour in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 21, Block I., Otago Peninsula Survey District; thence towards the south by the shore-line of North-east Harbour to the bridge over Anderson's Bay; thence by the said bridge and the southern shore-line of Otago Harbour to the Borough of South Dunedin, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Borough of South Dunedin and the Borough of Caversham, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877, to a point being the production of the southern boundary-line of the Town Belt of the City of Dunedin for a distance of 1000 links along that line from the middle of Anderson's Bay Road; thence by the Borough of Caversham, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877, to the westernmost corner of that borough; thence towards the north-west by the north-western boundary-line of the Borough of Mornington, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 42, 14th May, 1877, to the Borough of Roslyn at Section No. 17, Lower Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards the south-west and north-west by part of the south-western and north-western boundaries of the Borough of Roslyn, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 9, 20th February, 1890, to Section No. 129, Waikari Survey District; thence by that section and original Sections Nos. 123, 127, 126, 125, 124, 123, 122, 121, 120, 119, 118, 117, 116, 115, 114, 113, 112, 111, 110, 109, 108, 107, 106, 105, 104, 103, 102, 101, and 100 of the said Waikari Survey District to Section No. 17, Block II., Upper Kaikorai Survey District; thence again towards

the north-east by the said Section No. 17 and Sections Nos. 16, 15, and 14 of the said Block II.; thence again towards the north-west by Sections Nos. 14 and 1 of the said Block II., and by Block XI., Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and Sections Nos. 94, 92, 90, 88, 86, 84, and 82, Waikari Survey District; and thence again towards the north-west by Sections Nos. 46, 47, and 48, Block V., Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and Sections Nos. 11, 4, 3, and 1, Block VIII., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 66, Block XI., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; and thence by a right line to the south-western corner of that section at the Waikouaiti Electoral District aforesaid.

CAVERSHAM.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the City of Dunedin Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the western corner of the Borough of Mornington to the north-easternmost boundary-line of the Borough of Caversham; thence towards the north-east generally by the north-eastern boundary of the Borough of Caversham, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877, to the Borough of South Dunedin; thence towards the north-west and again towards the north-east by part of the north-western and the whole of the north-eastern boundaries of the Borough of South Dunedin, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877; thence by the southern shore of Otago Harbour to the bridge at Anderson's Bay; thence again towards the north-west by the said bridge and the shore-line of North-east Harbour to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 21, Block I., Otago Peninsula Survey District, and thence by a straight line to the easternmost corner of that section; thence towards the east generally by the Waikouaiti Electoral district, hereinbefore described, to the ocean near Lawyer's Head; thence towards the south-west by the ocean; and towards the south-west by the south-western boundary-lines of the Borough of Caversham, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 99, 13th December, 1877, to the City of Dunedin Electoral District aforesaid.

TAIERI.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east by the Waihemo Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Lammerlaw Range to the north-western corner of Run No. 171B; thence towards the north-east by the Waikouaiti Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the western corner of Section No. 66, Block XI., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence towards the south-east generally by the City of Dunedin Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the westernmost corner of the Borough of Mornington; thence again towards the north-east by the Caversham Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; again towards the south-east by the ocean to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 1 of 13, Block III., Otokia Survey District; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of that section; thence by the road which forms the northern boundary of Section No. 10 and its continuation, passing the following sections, viz.: Sections Nos. 1 of 13, 2 of 13, 14, and 15, Block III., Otokia Survey District, Sections Nos. 36, 34, 33, 32, 31, 2 of 29, and 1 of 29, to Section No. 2 of 28; thence intersecting that section and continuing northerly, passing Sections Nos. 2 of 26, 1 of 26, and 25, to Section No. 20, Block IV., Otokia Survey District; thence by the road intersecting that section to the road forming its northern boundary; thence by the latter road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 20, and thence by a line due west to the Taieri River; thence towards the west by the right bank of the Taieri River to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 12, Block V., Maungatua Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the said Section No. 12 and Sections Nos. 35, 80, and 81 of the said Block V. to Lees Stream; thence again towards the south-east by Lees Stream to the Waipori Lake; thence by the said lake to the mouth of the Waipori River; thence again towards the south-west by the Waipori River to the western boundary-line of Maungatua Survey District; thence towards the west by a line drawn due north to a point due west from Trig. Station F, Maungatua Survey District; thence towards the north by a right line to the said Trig. Station F; thence again towards the west by a line drawn due north to Lee's Stream; thence again towards the south-west by Lee's Stream to its source; thence towards the south generally by the summit of the watershed between the Waipori River and Deep Stream to Lammerlaw Range aforesaid, at the Waihemo Electoral District aforesaid.

BRUCE.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by Crook Burn from its confluence with the Clutha River to

the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 13, Block XI., Waitahuna West Survey District; thence by that road and the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 14 and 15 of the said Block XI., and by the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 10, and the southern boundaries of Sections Nos. 9 and 8, Block IX., of the said Waitahuna West Survey District, to the road which forms the north-western boundary of Section No. 15 of the said Block IX.; thence by that road to the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 15; thence towards the north-east by Section No. 1 of the said Block IX., and by Sections Nos. 1, 2, 3, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18, Block VII., of the said Waitahuna West Survey District, and the south-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the Waitahuna River; thence again towards the north-west by that river to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 6, Block VII., Waitahuna East Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by a right line to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 6; thence again towards the north-west by the said Section No. 6 and Sections Nos. 9 and 80, a road, and Sections Nos. 1, 82, and 81, all of the said Block VII., by a road fronting Section No. 2, and by Section No. 10, Block X., of the said Waitahuna East Survey District; thence again towards the north-east by the last-mentioned section and by Section No. 44 of the said Block X. to the Waitahuna River; and thence again towards the north-west by that river to Bungtown Creek; thence towards the west generally by the right bank of the said Bungtown Creek to the northern boundary of Section No. 11, Block IX., Tuapeka East Survey District; thence towards the south by that section and Section No. 10 to Block X. of the said Tuapeka East Survey District; thence again towards the west by the said Block X. and Blocks XIII. and XVI. of the said Tuapeka East Survey District to the summit of the range leading from Trig. Station T of the said survey district to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 1, Block XII., Tuapeka East Survey District; thence towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary-line of that section to the Waitahuna River; thence by the left bank of that river to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 1, Block IX., Waipori Survey District; thence by that section to Waitahuna Hill; thence by the summit of the watershed over Trig. Stations K, J, and G in Block X., Waipori Survey District, to the eastern boundary-line of Waipori Survey District; and thence towards the east by the said eastern boundary-line to the left bank of the Waipori River, at the Taieri Electoral District, hereinbefore described; thence towards the north-east generally by the said Taieri Electoral District to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Koaou Branch of the Clutha River; and thence towards the south-west generally by the said Koaou Branch and the Clutha River to the south-eastern boundary-line of the Borough of Balclutha; thence by the said Borough of Balclutha to the said Clutha River; and thence again towards the south-west by that river to the Pomahaka River; thence by the said Pomahaka River to the confluence of Back Creek with that river; thence again towards the north-west by that creek to a point due west of Trig. Station D, Rankleburn Survey District; thence towards the north by a line due east to the left bank of the Clutha River; and thence towards the east by the said left bank of the Clutha River to the mouth of the Crook Burn aforesaid.

TUAPEKA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and east by the Waihemo Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the source of Lauder Creek to Lammerlaw; thence again towards the north-east generally by the Taieri Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Waipori River; thence towards the south-east and south generally by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to a point on the left bank of the Clutha River due east of Trig. Station D, Rankleburn Survey District; thence towards the west by the Clutha River to the confluence of Blackcleugh Burn with the said Clutha River; thence by Blackcleugh Burn to a point due south of Tapanui Hill; thence by a right line to the said Tapanui Hill; thence by the summit of the range to Trig. Station L, Crookston Survey District; thence again towards the south-east by the south-eastern boundary-lines of Blocks XIV. and XI., Crookston Survey District; thence towards the south by the southern boundary-line of the said Block XI. to its south-western corner; thence by Sections Nos. 1, 12, 30, 32, and 37, Block III., Crookston Survey District, and Sections Nos. 20, 9, 11, 12, 29, and 13, Block IV., Greenvale Survey District, and Sections Nos. 2, 7, 12, 14, and 15, Block V., Greenvale Survey District, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence towards the east by the said Block V. and Block II. to the Pomahaka River; thence again towards the west generally by the said Pomahaka River to the confluence of Leithen Burn with that river;

thence by Leithen Burn to the source of its eastern branch; thence by a right line to Black Umbrella (Trig. Station K); thence towards the north-west by the summit of the Black Umbrella Mountains to a point due east of Rocky Mount; thence again towards the south by a right line to the said Rocky Mount; thence towards the west by the summit of the Garvie Mountains and the summit of the Carrick Range to Run No. 330A; thence again towards the north by the said Run No. 330A and Run No. 325A to the Clutha River; thence again towards the west by the right bank of that river to a point due west of the confluence of Leaning Rock Creek with the said Clutha River; thence again towards the north by a right line to the said confluence; and thence again towards the north-west by the said Leaning Rock Creek to its source; thence by a right line to Leaning Rock Hill; thence by the summit of the Dunstan Mountains to Run No. 238; and thence by that run and by Runs Nos. 237E and 236B to the Lauder Creek, at the boundary of the Waihemo Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

CLUTHA.

This district is bounded towards the north and east generally by the Tuapeka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Leithen Burn to a point on the left bank of the Clutha River due east of Trig. Station D, Rankleburn Survey District; thence towards the north-east generally by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean; thence towards the south-east by the ocean to Chasland's Mistake; thence towards the south-west generally by a right line to Black Horn; thence by the summit of the watershed over Bleak Hill, the Chimney, and Flowerpot to Catlin's Cone; thence by a right line to the source of the Waipahi River in Section No. 1, Block XI., Kuriwao Survey District; thence by the said Waipahi River to a point due east of the north-eastern corner of Section No. 6 (P.R.), Block VI., Slopedown Survey District; thence towards the south by a right line to the said north-eastern corner; thence by the said Section No. 6 and Run No. 162 (education endowment) to the northern boundary-line of Block VII., Slopedown Survey District; thence by the said Block VII. and Blocks VIII. and IX., Slopedown Survey District, to Block X., Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the west by the said Block X. and Blocks IX. and VIII., Tuturau Survey District, and by Section No. 6, Block VIII., Waikaka Survey District; thence again towards the south-west by the said Section No. 6 and by the north branch of the Otakaramu Stream to the Mataura River; thence towards the west by the Mataura River to its confluence with the Waikaka River, and thence by the Waikaka River to the northern boundary-line of the Township of East Gore; thence towards the south by that township to the Mataura River; thence again towards the south-west by the Mataura River to the confluence of the Okapua Stream with that River; thence towards the north-west by the said Okapua Stream to the Dunedin-Switzer's Road; thence towards the north by that road; thence towards the west by the Chatton Survey District, and Block XI., Greenvale Survey District, and Run No. 175B, to Leithen Burn, at the boundary of the Tuapeka Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

MATAURA.

The district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Clutha Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Okapua Stream to the ocean; towards the south by the ocean to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Block VII., Invercargill Hundred; thence towards the west by a right line to the said western boundary-line of Block VII., and thence by that boundary-line to Block V. of the said Invercargill Hundred; thence towards the north-west by the said Block V. and Block VI. of the said Invercargill Hundred to the eastern boundary-line of the latter block; thence towards the south-west by the said Block VI. and Blocks XI., XII., and XVIII. of the said Invercargill Hundred to the Makarewa River; thence again towards the north-west by that river to the north-western corner of Section No. 190, Forest Hill Hundred; thence towards the north by a line due east for a distance of 174 chains; thence again towards the west by a line due north for a distance of 200 chains; thence again towards the north-west by a line bearing N. 45° E. to the eastern boundary-line of the said Forest Hill Hundred; again towards the west by the Forest Hill Hundred aforesaid; again towards the south by the said Forest Hill Hundred to Lora Stream; thence again towards the north-west generally by the said Lora Stream to Section No. 798 (known as Small Grazing-run No. 21), Hokonui Survey District; thence towards the south-west by that section and by the northern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 449 and 267, Hokonui Survey District, to the Otamita Stream; thence by that stream to its confluence with the Mataura River; and thence by the left bank of the said Mataura

River to the Okapua Stream, at the boundary of the Clutha Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

WAKATIPU.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Southern Alps to Mount St. Bathans; thence towards the south-east generally by the Waihemo, the Tuapeka, and the Clutha Electoral Districts respectively, hereinbefore described; towards the south by the Mataura Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 449, Hokonui Survey District; towards the west generally by Section No. 798 (known as Small Grazing-run No. 21), Hokonui Survey District, and Sections Nos. 354 and 179 to Cowan's Creek; thence by Cowan's Creek to the Waimea Stream; thence by the Waimea Stream to Longridge Stream, and by the right bank of Longridge Stream to Section No. 512, Hokonui Survey District; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 538, 42, 48, 47, 46, 45, 197, 147, 639 (P.R.), 7, 150, 541, 567, 40, 511, and the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the Mataura River; thence again towards the west generally by the Mataura River to its source near Eyre Peak; thence by right lines over Eyre Peak and Jane Peak to Hummock Peak; thence by the summit of the watershed over Mount Lookup and the Thomson Mountains to a line drawn between Round Peak and Moffat Peak; thence towards the south by a right line to Moffat Peak; thence by a right line to Mount Eglinton; thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the Earl Mountains to a point in line with the Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass; thence again towards the south by a right line over the said Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass to Bligh Sound; and thence by the said Bligh Sound to the ocean; and thence again towards the north-west by the ocean.

WALLACE.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Wakatipu Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Bligh Sound to Section No. 798, Hokonui Survey District; thence towards the south-west generally by Section No. 798 (known as Small Grazing-run, No. 21), Hokonui Survey District, and Sections Nos. 361, 797, 796, 795, 577, 572, 575, and 576, Hokonui Survey District, to the Township of East Dipton; thence by the eastern and southern boundaries of this township to the Oreti River; thence by the right bank of the said Oreti River to the southern boundary-line of Section No. 18, Taringatura Survey District; thence towards the south by the southern boundary-line of Sections Nos. 18, 10, 66, 17, and 126, all of Taringatura Survey District, to Section No. 123; thence by the production of the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section through Section No. 123 to the southern boundary-line of Section No. 79; thence by that boundary-line and the southern boundary-line of Section No. 261, and by Sections Nos. 162B and 162A respectively to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the east generally by the said Section No. 162A, and by Run No. 164A, Sections Nos. 162C and 188, Taringatura Survey District, and by the southern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to a point due north of the north-eastern corner of Section No. 245, Taringatura Survey District; thence by a line due south to the last-mentioned section; thence by the eastern boundary-line of that section and the eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 244, 243, 242, 241, 240, 239, and 238 to Section No. 71; thence by that section and Section No. 63, Oreti Hundred, to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, Oreti Hundred; thence by Section No. 63 and the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, and that road continued through Section No. 62 of the said Oreti Hundred to the western boundary of the said Section No. 62; thence by the eastern side of that road to Section No. 108; thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 108 and Sections Nos. 107 and 44 to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the east by the said Section No. 44 and Sections Nos. 43, 80, 86, 89, 90, 91, 94, and 95, all of the said Oreti Hundred, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence again towards the south by the New River Hundred to the Waimatuku Stream; thence again towards the east by the left bank of that stream to the ocean; and thence again towards the south and towards the west by the ocean to Bligh Sound aforesaid, at the Wakatipu Electoral District aforesaid.

INVERCARGILL.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Waihopai River; towards the east by the Mataura Electoral Dis-

trict, hereinbefore described; towards the south by the Seaward Bush Railway-line; again towards the east by Sections Nos. 15 and 21, Block XXII., Invercargill Hundred, and by the production of the western boundary-line of the latter section to Campbelltown Hundred; thence towards the south by Campbelltown Hundred; and towards the west by the New River Estuary to the Waihopai River aforesaid.

AWARUA.

This district is bounded towards the west and north-east generally by the Wallace Electoral District, hereinbefore described; towards the east generally by the Maitara Electoral District and the Invercargill Electoral District respectively, hereinbefore described; and towards the south-west by Foveaux Straits to the Wallace Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement: including Stewart Island, Centre Island, Ruapuke Island, Dog Island, and all adjacent islands.
