New County of Waimarino divided into Ridings, &c.

(L.S.) RANFURLY, Governor.
A PROCLAMATION.

IN exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in me by "The Counties Act, 1886," and "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," I, Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby divide the new County of Waimarino, as constituted by the said Acts, into seven ridings, to be called the Huikumu Riding, the Manganui Riding, the Ruapehu Riding, the Karioi Riding, the Parapara Riding, the Rsetihi Riding, and the Ohakune Riding, and declare that the boundaries thereof shall be those set forth under the names of the said ridings respectively in the Schedule hereto.

And I do hereby declare that one member shall be elected for each of the abovenamed ridings.

And I do further declare that Thursday, the twenty-first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and three, shall be the day upon which the election of the first Council of the said County of Waimarino shall take place, and that Thursday, the twenty-eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and three, at two o'clock in the afternoon, shall be the time, and Bennett's Building, at Raetihi, shall be the place, at which the first meeting of the said Council shall be held.

SCHEDULE.
HUIKUMU RIDING.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary of the Waimarino County as described in "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," from the Wanganui River to a point in line with the western boundary-line of the Kaitieke Survey District: thence towards the east generally by a right line to the north-western corner of the said Kaitieke Survey District: thence by the said Kaitieke Survey District and the Manganui Survey District to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Waimarino No. 3 Block; thence by a right line to Pikiariki Trig. Station; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Waimarino No. 3 Block and the production of that boundary-line to Okauamo Trig. Station; thence by the south-western boundary-line of Sections Nos. 9 and 10, Block XIII., Manganui Survey District, to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and the production of its south-eastern side to the Orautaha Stream; thence by the said Orautaha Stream to Section No. 8,

Block II., Makotuku Survey District; thence by that section to the Raetihi-Ohura Road; thence across that road and by Sections Nos. 6, 13, 14, and 16, Block II., aforesaid, by Sections Nos. 6, 7, and 8, Block VI., Makotuku Survey District, and by the Township of Raetihi to the Pipiriki-Raetihi Road: thence towards the south generally by that road to the Township of Pipiriki; thence by the southern boundary-line of the Township of Pipiriki to the Wanganui River: and thence towards the west generally by the Wanganui River to the place of commencement.

MANGANUI RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary of the Waimarino County as described in "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," from a point in line with the western boundary-line of the Kaitieke Survey District to the Waimarino-Taumaranui Road: thence towards the east generally by the said Waimarino-Taumaranui Road to the Township Reserve in Block VIII., Manganui Survey District; thence by the road forming the northern boundary of that reserve to the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 19, Block VIII., aforesaid; thence by the road forming the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 19, 4, 8, and 9, Block VIII., aforesaid, to Section No. 12; thence by the northern, eastern, and south-eastern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 12 to the road forming its south-western boundary; thence by the road forming the eastern boundary of Section No. 11, Block VIII., aforesaid, and the road forming the eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 4 and 10, Block XII., Manganui Survey District, to the Mangaturu Stream; thence by that stream to the road forming the western boundary of the Urewera Block; thence by that road to the road forming the north-western boundary of the Section No. 1, Block XVI., Manganui Survey District: thence towards the south-east by the road forming the north-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 1, 6, and 7, Block XVI., aforesaid, the road intersecting the Horopito Township Reserve, and the road forming the north-western boundaries of Sections Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, Block XVI., aforesaid, and the road forming part of the south-western boundary of the last-mentioned section to the Makotuku Stream; thence by the said Makotuku Stream to the Raetihi-Ohura Road: thence towards the south-west by the said Raetihi-Ohura Road to the western boundary-line of Section No. 8, Block II., Makotuku Survey District: and thence towards the west generally by the Huikumu Riding hereinbefore described to the place of commencement.

RUAPEHU RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary of the Waimarino County as described in "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," from the Waimarino-Taumarunui Road to Tongariro Trig. Station; thence towards the south-east generally by the eastern boundary of the said Waimarino County to Ruapehu Trig. Station; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the Urewera Block to the Mangaiti Stream; thence by the Mangaiti Stream to its confluence with the Mangawhero River; thence by the Mangawhero River to its confluence with the Makaranui Stream; thence by the Makaranui Stream to the eastern boundary of Part 1 of Run No. 95 (Tawhito-ariki Block); thence by the eastern boundary-line of Part 1 of the said Run No. 95 to its southern boundary-line; thence towards the south generally by the southern boundary-line of Part 1 of the said Run No. 95 to the Mangawhero River; thence by the Mangawhero River to the north-eastern boundary-line of Ngapakihiri or Raetihi No. 1 Block; thence by that block to the Pipiriki-Ohakune Road; thence by the said Pipiriki-Ohakune Road to the Township of Raetihi; and thence by the Township of Raetihi to the eastern boundary of the Huikumu Riding hereinbefore described; thence towards the west generally by the said Huikumu Riding and the Manganui Riding hereinbefore described to the place of commencement.

KARIOI RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north by part of the northern boundary of the Waimarino County as described in "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," from Ruspehu Trig. Station to Trig. Station No. 29. Kaimanawa Survey District; thence towards the east by the eastern boundary of the said Waimarino County to Trig. Station C on Auahtotara; thence towards the south generally by the southern boundary of the said Waimarino County to the junction of the Taupo-Hunterville and Pipiriki-Waiouru Roads; thence by the said Pipiriki-Waiouru Road to the Mangahuehu Stream; thence towards the west generally by the Mangahuehu Stream to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 5, Block V., Karioi Survey District; thence by the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 5 to the road forming the eastern boundary of Section No. 4, Block I.; thence by that road to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 4; thence across that road and by Sections Nos. 4 and 1, Block I., Karioi Survey District aforesaid, and the northern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the right bank of the Mangawhero River; and thence by the Ruapehu Riding hereinbefore described to the place of commencement.

PARAPARA RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north generally by the Huikumu Riding hereinbefore described from the Wanganui River to the Township of Raetihi; thence by the Township of Raetihi to the Pipiriki-Ohakune Road; thence by the Ruapehu Riding hereinbefore described to the easternmost corner of Part 2 of Run No. 25 (Tawhito-ariki Block); thence towards the south-east generally by the south-eastern and southern boundaries of the said Part 2 of Run No. 25 to the Mangawhero River; thence towards the east generally by the Mangawhero River

to the northern boundary of the Tauakira Block; thence towards the south by the Tauakira Block to the Wanganui River; and thence towards the west and south-west generally by the Wanganui River to the place of commencement.

RAETIHI RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District, being the Township of Raetihi, bounded towards the north by the Ruapehu Riding hereinbefore described; towards the east by the said Ruapehu Riding and the Parapara Riding hereinbefore described; towards the south by the said Parapara Riding and the Huikumu Riding hereinbefore described.

OHAKUNE RIDING.

All that area in the Wellington Land District bounded towards the north-west generally by the Ruapehu Riding from the easternmost corner of Part 2 of Run No. 25 (Tawhito-ariki Block) to a point on the right bank of the Mangawhero River in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 1, Block I., Karioi Survey District; thence towards the north-east generally by the Karioi Riding hereinbefore described to the junction of the Taupo-Hunterville and Pipiriki-Waiouru Roads; thence towards the east and south-east generally by the eastern and southern boundaries of the Waimarino County as described in "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," to the northern boundary-line of the Tauakira Block; and thence towards the west generally by the Parapara Riding hereinbefore described to the place of commencement.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-ninth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three.
