RANFURLY, Governor. A PROCLAMATION.

A PROCLAMATION.

In exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in me by "The Counties Act, 1886," and "The Waimarino County Act, 1902," I. Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby divide the new County of Waimarino, as constituted by the said Acts, into seven ridings, to be called the Huikumu Riding, the Manganui Riding, the Ruapehu Riding, the Karioi Riding, and the Ohakune Riding, and declare that the boundaries thereof shall be those set forth under the names of the said ridings respectively in the Schedule hereto.

And I do hereby declare that one member shall be elected for each of the abovenamed ridings.
