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New Electoral Districts in the North Island (Auckland and Wellington).

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the North Island Representation Commission, appointed under the provisions of "The Electoral Act, 1902" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), have made their report to me under their hands and seals, setting forth the names and boundaries of certain electoral districts for the North Island, fixed by them in accordance with the said Act and "The City Single Electorates Act, 1903":

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the eleventh section of the said Act and by "The City Single Electorates Act, 1903," I, William Lee, Baron Plunket, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the North Island, so fixed by the said Commission, to be those respectively mentioned and set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

Auckland West.

THIS district is bounded towards the north generally by high-water mark of Waitemata Harbour from the Ponsonby Wharf to Freeman's Bay: thence towards the east generally by the original high-water mark of Freeman's Bay to a point being the production of the middle of Union Street: thence towards the east generally by a line along the middle of Union Street to its junction with the middle of Napier Street; thence by a line along the middle of Napier Street to its junction with the middle of Hepburn Street; thence by a line along the middle of Hepburn Street to its junction with the middle of Ponsonby Road; thence by a line along the middle of Ponsonby Road to its junction with the middle of Crummer Road; thence by a line along the middle of Crummer Road to the intersection of the north-eastern side of Pollen Street, Borough of Grey Lynn; thence towards the south-west generally by the said Pollen Street to the north side of Rose Road, in the Borough of Grey Lynn; thence by the said Rose Road to the eastern side of McKelvie Street, in

the Borough of Grey Lynn; thence by the eastern side of the said McKelvie Street to the south-western side of Ponsonby Road; thence by the south-western side of the said Ponsonby Road to its junction with Richmond Road; and thence by the south side of Richmond Road to Cox's Creek, and by the north-eastern bank of that creek to the high-water mark of Waitemata Harbour: thence towards the west generally by high-water mark of Waitemata Harbour to the point of commencement.

This district also includes all wharves and extensions seawards, as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan accompanying report.

Auckland East.

THIS district is bounded towards the north generally by high-water mark of the Waitemata Harbour from a point being the production of the middle of Queen Street to the western boundary of the Parnell Electoral District: thence towards the south-east generally by a line, 1500 links, to the Strand; thence by the Strand, 50 links; thence to and by Suburban Section No. 96; thence by a line to and thence by the east side of Stanley Street to the Government Domain; thence by the Government Domain and the Hospital Reserve to the road known as Park Road; thence by the northern side of the said Park Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 22 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to and by said boundary-line and its production to the south side of Carlton Gore Road; thence by the south side of the said road to the western boundary-line of subdivisional Lot No. 37 of original Allotment No. 4 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by Lot No. 37 aforesaid, and by Lots Nos. 55, 56, 65, 66, 75, 76, 85, 86, 95, 96, 105, 106, 115, 116, and 13, all of the original Allotment No. 4 of the said Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland, and by the western boundary-line of Allotment No. 13, before mentioned, produced to the southern side of Kyber Pass Road; thence by the said Kyber Pass Road to the south-eastern side of Quarry Road: thence generally towards the south-east by the south-eastern side of the said road to its junction with Mount Eden Road: thence towards the south-west generally by the southern side of the Mount Eden Road to Symonds Street; thence by a line to and by Basque Road and by Sections Nos. 1, 3, 4, and 13, to the Great North Road; thence by a line across the Great North Road to the intersection of the western side of that road with the north-

eastern side of Pollen Street, Borough of Grey Lynn; thence by the north-eastern side of Pollen Street to the Auckland West Electoral District hereinbefore described: and thence towards the north-west generally by the Auckland West and Auckland Central Electoral Districts to the place of commencement.

This district also includes all wharves and extensions seawards, as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan accompanying report.

Auckland Central.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by high-water mark of Waitemata Harbour from a point being the production of the middle of Union Street to the original high-water mark of Freeman's Bay, and proceeding along the said high-water mark to a point opposite the production of the middle of Queen Street: thence towards the south-east generally by a line along the middle of Queen Street to its junction with the middle of Karangahape Road; and thence by a line along the middle of the said Karangahape Road to its junction with the production of the middle of Kent Street, Borough of Grey Lynn: thence towards the south-west by the said production, and by a line along the middle of Kent Street to the Auckland West Electoral District hereinbefore described: and thence towards the west generally by the said Auckland West Electoral District to the place of commencement.

This district includes also the Queen's Wharf and all other wharves and extensions seawards as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan accompanying report.

Wellington North.

This district is bounded towards the east generally from a point on high-water mark of Port Nicholson and Lambton Harbour being on the boundary between the Borough of Onslow and the City of Wellington, and thence proceeding along high-water mark of Port Nicholson and Lambton Harbour to a point opposite the middle of Cuba Street; thence by a line along the middle of Cuba Street to its junction with the middle of Ghuznee Street; thence towards the south by a line along the middle of Ghuznee Street to its junction with the middle of Woolcombe Street; thence again towards the east by a line along the middle of Woolcombe Street to a point opposite the south-eastern corner of Town Acre No. 431; thence again towards the south by a right line to the said corner, and thence by the southern boundary of said Town Acre No. 431 to the eastern boundary of the Plantation Reserve; thence towards the west and again towards the south by the eastern and northern boundaries of the said Plantation Reserve, and part of the southern boundary of City Reserve No. 43, to the eastern boundary of Kelburne (formerly known as Upland Farm, Section No. 23, Karori District); thence towards the west generally by the eastern boundary of Kelburne to the eastern boundary of the Botanical Gardens Reserve; thence again towards the south by the northern boundary of Kelburne to the western boundary of the Botanical Gardens Reserve, thence by the said western boundary of the Botanical Gardens Reserve to the eastern side of Karori Road; thence again towards the west generally by the eastern side of the said Karori Road, and the Tinakori Road, to a point opposite the southern side of Boundary Road, thence by a line to and by the southern side of Boundary Road and that side produced across Grant Road to the eastern boundary of the Orangi Kaupapa Native Reserve; thence again towards the west by the eastern boundary of the Orangi Kaupapa, Tinakori South, and Tinakori North Native Reserves, to the Borough of Onslow; and thence again generally towards the north by the southern boundary of the Borough of Onslow to the place of commencement.

This district also includes Somes Island, and all wharves and extensions seawards from high-water mark on the eastern boundary, as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan attached to the accompanying report.

Wellington Central.

This district is bounded towards the north by high-water mark of Lambton Harbour from a point opposite the middle of Cuba Street to a point opposite the middle of Tory Street; thence towards the east by a line along the middle of Tory Street and across Buckle Street, and thence proceeding along the middle of Banks Terrace and Tasman Street to a point opposite the southern side of Coombe Street, thence to and by the southern side of that street and its production to the eastern boundary of Town Acre 713; thence towards the west by the eastern boundary-lines of Town Acres 713, 712, and 711 to the southern boundary-line of the Mount Cook Reserve; thence generally towards the south by the said southern boundary-line of the said Mount Cook Reserve and the southern side of Hankey Street and its production to the western side of Wallace Street, thence by the western side of Wallace Street to the south-eastern side of Bidwell Street,

and thence by the south-eastern side of Bidwell Street and the western boundary-line of Town Acre 685 to the northern boundary-line of City Reserve 37; thence by the last-mentioned boundary of City Reserve 37, the western boundary of City Reserve 38, the southern boundary of City Reserve 41 to its south-west corner; thence by the western boundaries of City Reserves 41 and 42 to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 11, Ohiro, in Block X., Port Nicholson Survey District; thence by a right line to and by the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 11 to the western boundary of the City Reserves: thence towards the west by the western boundaries of the said City Reserves to the southern boundary of Kelburne; thence generally towards the north and west by the southern and eastern boundaries of Kelburne to the Wellington North Electoral District hereinbefore described; and thence again towards the north-east and west generally by the boundaries of the Wellington North Electoral District aforesaid to the place of commencement.

This district also includes all wharves and extensions seawards from the high-water boundary, as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan attached to the accompanying report.

Wellington East.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by high-water mark of Lambton Harbour from a point opposite the middle of Tory Street to a point opposite the production of the western side of the Harbour View Road; thence towards the east generally by a right line to the western side of the said Harbour View Road, thence by that road and the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 2 and 3, Block VII., Port Nicholson Survey District, to the south-western corner of the latter section; thence towards the north by part of the southern boundary-line of said Section No. 3 to the Township of Kilbirnie; thence again towards the east by the said boundary of the Township of Kilbirnie to the northern side of Mein Street: thence towards the south generally by the northern side of Mein Street to the north-eastern boundary of Town Acre No. 775; thence along the north-eastern boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 775 and 774 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned town acre; thence along the north-western boundary-line of Town Acre No. 774 to Coromandel Street; thence by the south-western boundary-line of said Town Acre No. 774 to a point opposite the northern corner of Town Acre No. 773; thence by a line to that corner across Coromandel Street, and proceeding along the north-western boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 773, 772, and 771 to the boundary of the Old Men's Home Reserve; thence along the eastern boundary of the said Old Men's Home Reserve and across Owen Street to the north-western boundary-line of Town Acre No. 770; thence along the north-western boundary-line of said Town Acre No. 770 and across Daniel Street to Town Acre No. 769 (Hospital Reserve boundary); thence westerly along the northern boundary-line of said Town Acre No. 769 to the north-eastern boundary-line of Town Acre No. 766, and thence proceeding along the north-eastern boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 766, 765, 764, 763, and 762 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned town acre; thence proceeding along the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned town acre to the eastern side of Revans Street; thence by the eastern side of Revans Street to its junction with Adelaide Road; thence across Adelaide Road, the northern side of John Street across Hanson Street, the northern side of Oliver Street, to the eastern side of Crawford Street; thence by the eastern side of Crawford Street and the eastern side of Tasman Street to a point opposite the southern side of Oxford Road; thence by a line to and by the southern side of Oxford Road and its production to the western boundary-line of Town Acre No. 721; thence by the western boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 721, 720, and 719 to the Wellington Central Electoral District boundary hereinbefore described: and thence towards the north and towards the west by the Wellington Central Electoral District boundary to the place of commencement.

This district includes all wharves and extensions seawards from the high-water boundary, as the said district and boundaries are more particularly delineated upon the plan attached to the accompanying report.

WHEREAS the South Island Representation Commission, appointed under the provisions of "The Electoral Act, 1902" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), have made their report to me under their hands and seals setting forth the names and boundaries of certain electoral districts for the South Island fixed by them in accordance with the said Act and "The City Single Electorates Act, 1903":

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the eleventh section of the said Act and "The City Single Electorates Act, 1903," I, William Lee, Baron Plunket, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the names and boundaries of the electoral districts for the South Island, so fixed by the said Commission, to be those respectively mentioned and set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

SOUTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

Christchurch North.

BOUNDED towards the east generally by the Avon Electoral District from the junction of Shirley Road with Hill's Road to Fowke Street, thence by Fowke Street to a street in continuation of Fitzgerald Avenue, thence to Bealey Avenue, thence by the said avenue to Barbadoes Street, and thence in a southerly direction by the said street to the Avon River; towards the south generally by the Avon River from Barbadoes Street to Colombo Street, thence in a southerly direction by the last-mentioned street to its intersection with Worcester Street, thence by the said Worcester Street to Antigua Street, thence in a westerly direction by a right line in prolongation of the north side of Worcester Street to the western boundary of Hagley Park; towards the west and north generally by the Riccarton Electoral District to the junction of Shirley Road with Hill's Road, the place of commencement.

Christchurch East.

Bounded towards the north generally by Christchurch North Electoral District, as described above, from Colombo Street to the junction of Fowke and Hill Streets, thence by the Avon Electoral District to the Avon River; towards the east generally by the Avon Electoral District to the Lyttelton-Christchurch railway line, and the Lyttelton Electoral District to Shakespeare Road; towards the south generally by Shakespeare Road to Waltham Road, thence southerly by the last-mentioned road to Brougham Street, and thence by the said street to Colombo Street; towards the west by Colombo Street to the Avon River at Cambridge Terrace, the place of commencement.

Christchurch South.

Bounded towards the north by the Christchurch North Electoral District from the west boundary of Hagley Park to Colombo Street; towards the east generally by Colombo Street from Worcester Street to Brougham Street, thence by the Christchurch East Electoral District to Wilson's Road, thence by the Lyttelton Electoral District to Tennyson Street; towards the south generally by the Lyttelton

and Courtenay Electoral Districts to the Lincoln Road; towards the west by the Riccarton Electoral District to the place of commencement on the west boundary of Hagley Park.

Dunedin North.

This district is bounded towards the north and towards the south-east generally by the Waikouaiti Electoral District from Swampy Hill (Trig. Station S, North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District) to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 12 of Block VIII., North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District; thence towards the east generally by the Chalmers Electoral District to Otago Harbour; thence towards the south-east by Otago Harbour; thence in a westerly direction by Frederick Street to London Street, thence along London Street to Constitution Street, thence along Constitution Street to Argyle Street, thence along Argyle Street to the Town Belt, thence in a straight line to Pacific Street, Roslyn, thence along Pacific Street to District Road; thence in a southerly direction along this District Road to Clyde Street, thence along Clyde Street to Vaile Street; thence in a southerly direction to Anderston Road, thence along Anderston Road to Helensburn Road; thence in a northerly direction along Helensburn Road to the boundary between Maori Hill and Roslyn Boroughs; thence north-west by the Roslyn Borough boundary to the south-west corner of the Borough of Maori Hill, thence by the west boundary of the Borough of Maori Hill to Swampy Hill, the place of commencement.

Dunedin Central.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Dunedin North Electoral District from the south-west corner of the Borough of Maori Hill to Dunedin Harbour; thence towards the east by Dunedin Harbour to the production of Stuart Street; thence along this line and Stuart Street to High Street; thence along High Street to Rattray Street; thence along Rattray Street in a westerly direction to York Place; thence in a south-westerly direction along York Place to Russell Street; thence through the Town Belt by a straight line to the boundary between Roslyn and Mornington Boroughs; thence along the borough-boundaries and the Taieri Electoral District to the starting-point.

Dunedin South.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Dunedin Central Electoral District from the north-west corner of the Borough of Mornington to Otago Harbour, thence by Otago Harbour to Caversham Electoral District; thence towards the south by the Caversham Electoral District to the south-west corner of the Borough of Mornington; towards the west by the Taieri Electoral District and the Dunedin Central Electoral District to the north-west corner of the Borough of Mornington, the starting-point.
