

The body and hood are to be approved by the Postmaster-General. The drivers employed are also to be approved by the Department. In addition to the delivery of mail-matter at and collection from rural boxes, the driver is to undertake at all regular stopping-places the sale of stamps, issue of postal notes, registration of postal packets, and receipt from the public of telegrams. Contractors are to be responsible for the fidelity of their drivers up to £50, and they will be required to enter into a bond for this purpose.

In delivering and receiving mails at railway-stations it is understood that contractors deal with the guards of trains, and that delivery of the mails is to be made into the railway-vans if required.
