ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this twenty-fourth day of
 November, 1919.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon
 him by the War Regulations Act, 1914, and of every other power
 and authority enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-
 General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice
 and consent of the Executive Council of that Dominion, doth hereby
 revoke the War Regulations restricting remittances of money from New
 Zealand made under the War Regulations Act, 1914, by an Order in
 Council dated the twenty-first day of May, one thousand nine hundred
 and eighteen, and gazetted on the twenty-eighth day of May, one thousand
 nine hundred and eighteen.

Amending Shipping Regulations under the War Regulations Act, 1914.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the eleventh day of June,
 one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, and published in the
Gazette of the same date, certain regulations, therein called the Shipping
 Regulations, 1917, were made under the War Regulations Act, 1914,
 and its amendments:

And whereas it is expedient to amend the said regulations in the manner hereinafter set forth :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of that Dominion, doth hereby, in pursuance of the authority conferred by the War Regulations Act, 1914, and its amendments, and by section thirty-five of the War Legislation Act, 1917, amend the said regulations in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

THE term "New Zealand ship" as used in clauses 6, 7, and 8 of the said Shipping Regulations, 1917, shall extend and apply not only to any British ship having its port of registry in New Zealand, but also to any British ship owned by or chartered by any company incorporated in New Zealand, or any company, firm, or person the headquarters of whose business is in New Zealand.
